The Round Rock Express and Albuquerque Isotopes face off in game two on Friday night at Dell Diamond. Express LHP Brock Burke is scheduled to start up against Isotopes RHP Ryan Castellani. First pitch is set for 7:05 p.m.

LET'S RECAP

The Round Rock Express earned a 7-6 win over the Albuquerque Isotopes in five innings as Thursday night's series opener at Dell Diamond was called early due to rain. Albuquerque took a 3-0 lead in the first as CF Sam Hilliard hit a three-run home run. Round Rock plated its first run in the bottom of the frame when LF Delino DeShields scored on a Jason Martin groundout. The Isotopes extended their lead to 5-1 in the second when Ruiz hit a two-run homer. The bottom of the third saw three runs for Round Rock. After drawing a walk, Martin scored on a double from CF Leody Taveras. Express 1B Curtis Terry followed with a base hit to send both C Yohel Pozo and Taveras home, trimming the deficit to 5-4. In the top of the fourth, Isotopes 2B Taylor Motter hit a solo dinger for their sixth run. Round Rock tallied a second three-run frame in the fourth as LHP Ian Clarkin walked the bases loaded. SS Rvan Dorow scored on a groundout before Pozo launched a double to send 2B Yonny Hernandez and DeShields home for the 7-6 lead.

NEXT MAN UP ON THE BUMP

Express LHP Brock Burke is set to get the start on Friday night, his 10th of the season. In the lefty's last start on July 3 versus Sugar Land, he allowed one run, a home run, and struck out seven in 4.2 innings to lower his season ERA to 8.18 (30 ER/33.0 IP).

RAIN, RAIN GO AWAY

With rain starting to fall in the fourth inning of Thursday night's contest, Round Rock and Albuquerque played through the fifth before going into a rain delay, at which point the call was made to declare the contest as an official game. Including last night's 30-minute delay, the Express have had their last four contests delayed by a total of three hours and 34 minutes due to rain. Round Rock has seen two games called early, one suspended and one postponed so far in 2021.

A DROUGHT IN THE RAIN

After hitting 69 home runs during May (42) and June (27), Round Rock has totaled only three over seven games to start the month of July. The Express have hit the ball out of the park in just three of their last 10 contests dating back to June 27 in El Paso, and has recorded consecutive home run-less games three times in that span.

PO-PO-PO-POZO

Round Rock C Yohel Pozo finished 2-3 with a double and three RBI in Thursday's contest. The catcher has started July with a .320 average (8-25) over six games, having hit two doubles and a walkoff home run. After last night, Pozo has totaled 35 RBI in 2021, which already ranks as the third most in a season over his seven-year career.

FIRST DUB OF THE SEASON

Express RHP Jason Bahr earned his first win of the 2021 campaign, throwing the final inning of Thursday's rain-shortened game. In the righty's 11th appearance, he threw for a scoreless fifth inning and recorded one strikeout, bringing his season total to 24.

IT'S BEEN A WHILE

Thursday night marked Round Rock's first win over Albuquerque at Dell Diamond since a 5-4 victory on August 6, 2017 when the Isotopes last visited the Express. In both 2018 and 2019, the E-Train earned two wins at Isotopes Park en route to 2-2 series splits during both seasons. Dating back to 2005, Round Rock has recorded a winning record in eight of 11 total series against Albuquerque at Dell Diamond.

ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE SHOW

Twenty members of the Round Rock Express have made their Triple-A debuts so far in 2021: RHP Jason Bahr, INF Jax Biggers, OF Carl Chester, INF Ryan Dorow, RHP Scott Engler, RHP Demarcus Evans, RHP Joe Gatto, C Blake Grant-Parks, INF Yonny Hernandez, INF Jake Hoover, C Jack Kruger, INF Charles Leblanc, LHP Sal Mendez, RHP Tyler Phillips, RHP Ryder Ryan, OF Leody Taveras, INF Anderson Tejeda, INF Curtis Terry, RHP Collin Wiles and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang. Interestingly enough, Evans, Taveras and Tejeda all saw action with the Texas Rangers during the shortened 2020 season despite no experience at the Triple-A level. C Jack Kruger also suited up for the Los Angeles Angels and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang pitched for the Rangers in 2021 before making their Triple-A debuts.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players on Round Rock's roster hail from 15 different states: California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Maryland, Michigan, Mississippi, Nevada, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Oregon, Texas and Virginia. Jake Lemoine is the lone Texan on the roster, hailing from Bridge City. Lemoine was a standout pitcher at the University of Houston before being drafted by the Texas Rangers in 2012.

AROUND THE WORLD

Six different nations are represented on the Express roster. In addition to the 23 players from the United States, INF Charles Leblanc is Canadian, OF Elier Hernandez and OF Leody Taveras hail from the Dominican Republic, LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang is from South Korea, RHP Jharel Cotton is a native of the U.S. Virgin Islands and C Yohel Pozo and INF Yonny Hernandez are Venezuelan.

EXPRESS MANAGER KENNY HOLMBERG

The 2021 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kenny Holmberg's 13th year in the Texas Rangers organization. In 2020, he worked with Rangers prospects at the Alternate Training Site in Arlington, as well as the Fall Developmental League in Arizona. Round Rock will be the fourth different club for which Holmberg has managed in the Rangers farm system after serving at the helm of Short-Season Spokane in 2018, the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers from 2013-2015 and the Rookie-level Dominican Summer League Rangers from 2010-2011. He has compiled a 207-172 (.546) record while leading his clubs to the postseason in four of his six managerial campaigns, including a Northwest League championship series appearance in 2018. He originally joined the Texas organization as a coach for the DSL Rangers in 2009 and



also served as a coach for the club's High-A affiliate in Myrtle Beach in 2012. In addition to his managerial post for the Express, Holmberg also serves as the Rangers' Major League Infield Coordinator.

An infielder in his playing days, Holmberg was selected by Milwaukee in the 22nd round of the 2005 MLB draft and played four seasons in the Brewers organization. He compiled a .272 average with 34 home runs and 187 RBI over 338 career minor league games. Holmberg was also selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 49th round of the 2001 MLB draft out of Dunedin High School in Florida but opted to play collegiately at St. Petersburg College from 2002-2003. He then spent two seasons at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, earning first-team NAIA All-America honors in 2005.
