NOTES AND NUGGETS

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

This season, 48 of Omaha's 63 games (76%) have been decided by 4 runs or less, including the Storm Chasers' last 21 games.

Across the last 21 games (since May 18), Omaha is just 7-14 ... 16 of these 21 games have seen a save recorded, including 5 of Omaha's 7 wins ... over the Chasers' recent 13-game, 2-week homestand, 11 games featured a save, including the first 10, between May 27 and June 6.

While the games of recent have been close, only 27 of Omaha's first 42 games (64%) were decided by a margin of 4 runs or less.

1-run games have especially been difficult for Omaha, with the Storm Chasers just 3-9 in games decided by a run ... 3 wins by 1 run is the fewest of any International League team, while 12 total 1-run games is tied for the 2nd-fewest.

In 2024, 66% of Omaha's games (97 of 148) were decided by 4 runs or less.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

Omaha has successfully stolen 99 bases this year, and only been caught 16 times ... 99 steals rank 4th both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.

99-for-115 in steal attempts is a 86.1% success rate, the highest stolen base rate at the Triple-A level an 4th-best among full-season Minor League teams (1st: San Jose Giants, 89.1%, 106-for-119).

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits near the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 608 strikeouts this season ... that is both 2nd in the league and at the Triple-A level.

Over 544.2 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 10.05 K/9, which ranks 3rd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.

With 608 strikeouts through 63 games, an average of 9.65 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,437 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

SACRIFICIAL LOVE

The Omaha Storm Chasers lead the International League lead in both sacrifices (13) and sacrifice flies (27) as well.

The Chasers led the IL in sacrifice bunts in 2024, with 38 last year ... the 13 sacrifice bunt this year are tied with Columbus for most in the league, tied 3rd at the Triple-A level, and tied 15th in the Minors ... **Tyler Tolbert**, **Harold Castro** and **John Rave** each have 3 sacrifice bunts, tied for the 2nd-most in the league.

27 sac flies are the most of any Triple-A club and tied for the 4th-most in Minor League Baseball ... **Tyler Gentry's** 6 sacrifice flies lead the IL and are tied for the most at the Triple-A level, one off the Minor League lead.

LET'S OBSERVE MERV

After a slow start at the plate in his return to Triple-A, outfielder MJ Melendez has been one of Omaha's best hitters over the last month.

With a single yesterday Melendez has a 6-game hitting streak and hits in 19 of his last 23 games, with a .315 average (28-for-89) with a .916 OPS since May 16 ... he has 6 homers and 17 RBI in this stretch, with 7 multi-hit games.

Since May 16, Melendez is tied 2nd in the International League in homers (6) and 4th in total bases (49) ... he is 2nd in steals (11) in that stretch as well.

Over his first 19 games with the Storm Chasers, Melendez hit just .156 (12-for-77) with a .468 OPS, between April 22 and May 14 ... he had hits in 10 of 19 games in that stretch.

Underrated in MJ's time with Omaha has been the exit velocities he's produced ... an average exit velocity of 94.0MPH ranks 2nd among 332 Triple-A hitters with at least 100 plate appearances this season ... Worcester's Roman Anthony (recently promoted to the Major Leagues) hits the ball hardest on average, at 95.0MPH.

DIRECT FROM DIEGO

Infielder **Diego Castillo** has been Omaha's best hitter since joining the Storm Chasers in May.

Across 14 games with Omaha, Castillo is hitting .292 (14-for-48) with 10 RBI and a .943 OPS ... he's reached base in all 14 games he's played for the Chasers, with 13 walks in addition to the 14 hits, for a .443 OBP.

Since joining Omaha, Castillo leads the Storm Chasers in OBP, walks and doubles (4), is tied for the RBI lead, while ranking 2nd in total bases (24).

Castillo has a hit in 11 of 14 games with Omaha, drawn a walk in 9 of 14 and driven in a run in 8 of 14 ... he had a hit and drove in a run over his first 6 games with the Storm Chasers, from May 24 to June 1.

TODAY'S START

- Gant is making his **4th start with Omaha** this season ... in May, the Royals purchased his contract from the independent Atlantic League's Long Island Ducks, where he began the season.
- Playing his **13th professional season this year** ... Royals are Gant's 5th MLB organization, has previously spent time with the Mets, Braves, Cardinals and Twins, as well as in Japan and Indy Ball ... has appeared in 173 Major League games from 2016 to 2021, debuting with Atlanta but pitching for St. Louis and Minnesota too.
- Originally drafted by the New York Mets out of high school in 2011, was traded twice over the span of 17 months to the Braves and then Cardinals and has spent more time with the Cardinals than any other franchise.
- Prior to signing with Omaha, Gant pitched in the Minor Leagues on June 15, 2018, making a quality start for the Memphis Redbirds on the road against the Albuquerque Isotopes ... last pitched in the Majors on October 1, 2021 for the Minnesota Twins.

In his 3rd start with Omaha, made his best start with the Storm Chasers, throwing 5.0 scoreless innings ... pitched a 1-2-3 1st inning, worked around a walk in the 2nd, worked around a pair of singles in the 3rd ... allowed a single in the 4th ... threw a 1-2-3 5th, retiring his final 6 batters going back to the 4th ... did not come out for the 5th, Iowa scored a run off reliever Sam Long to take the lead, with the Cubs winning the game 1-0.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Signed with the Long Island Ducks (independent Atlantic League) in March 2025 ... over 4 starts with the Ducks, pitched to a 1.71 ERA (4 ER in 21.0 IP) with 27 strikeouts, to just 5 walks ... last 2 starts were quality starts.
- On May 17, the Long Island Ducks announced his contract has been purchased by the Royals organization ... joined the Storm Chasers this week for the road trip in Salt Lake City.

CAREER NOTES

SINCE 2022

- Was outrighted off of the Twins' 40-man roster following the 2021 season and elected free agency ... signed with the Hokkaido Nippon-Ham Fighters of Nippon Professional Baseball in Japan on December 10, 2021.
- Dealt with injuries and did not pitch with the Fighters in 2022, but re-signed a one-year contract extension in November 2022 ... only made 3 appearances for the farm team in 2023, with 11 strikeouts in 9.2 innings.
- Released by the Japanese team on July 1, 2023 and did not pitch in a professional game again until April 2025 with the Long Island Ducks.

MAJOR LEAGUE CAREER

- After being traded from the Braves to the Mets in the summer of 2015, Made Atlanta's 2016 Opening Day roster, despite never having pitched above Double-A ... threw a scoreless inning in his MLB debut on April 6, 2016 against the Washington Nationals, in the second game of the 2016 season.
- After making his MLB debut in 2016, made just 39 Minor League appearances (36 starts) between 2016 and 2018 ... exclusively pitched in the big leagues from June 2018 through the end of the 2021 season (139 games).
- Led all MLB relief pitchers with 11 wins in 2019 ... was the most wins by a relief pitcher in the National League since Tyler Clippard had 11 for the Nationals in 2010.
- In 2019, was just the 5th pitcher in MLB history with a perfect record and at least 7 wins prior to the All-Star Break, while making all relief appearances.
- A starting pitcher coming up through the Minors, opened the 2019 season in the Cardinals' bullpen and made 81 consecutive relief appearances between 2019 and 2020, before moving back to the rotation to open 2021.
- Has 2 hits in the Major Leagues ... both were home runs and came in a 4-start span, the only pitcher in MLB to hit multiple home runs in the month of August 2018.

- July 24, 2015: Acquired by the Atlanta Braves with RHP Rob Whalen from the New York Mets in exchange for INF Juan Uribe and INF/OF Kelly Johnson.
- December 1, 2016: Acquired by the St. Louis Cardinals with RHP Chris Ellis and INF Luke Dykstra from the Atlanta Braves in exchange for LHP Jaime Garcia.
- July 30, 2021: Acquired by the Minnesota Twins with LHP Evan Sisk from the St. Louis Cardinals in exchange for LHP J.A. Happ ... Sisk was traded to Kansas City in January 2023 and has pitched 129 games for Omaha.
