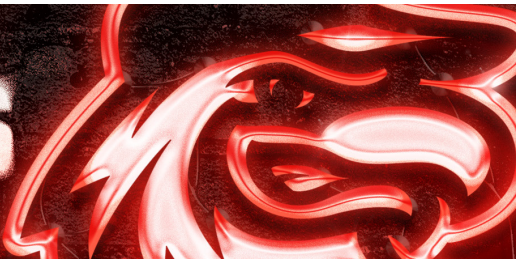

WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

Single-A Fredericksburg picked up the win in a high-scoring series opener against Delmarva (BAL), 10-8...SS **COY JAMES** launched his 16th homer of the season in the win, a two-run shot to go along with an RBI double and a walk.

FULL STEAM AHEAD: To kick off a crucial six-game set in Scranton/WB against the first-place RailRiders Tuesday night, the Rochester Red Wings fell behind early and were unable to overcome an 8-0 deficit despite a three-run eighth, falling 8-3...2B **CAYDEN WALLACE** doubled twice to pace the offense, including an RBI two-bagger in the eighth. 3B **TREY LIPSCOMB** was the only other Red Wing to log a multi-hit performance, going 2-for-5 with a double of his own and a run scored...Rochester looks to get back into the win column tonight and even the series at one apiece, sending LHP **JACKSON KENT** to the mound against RailRiders RHP Alexander Cornielle.

KENT TOUCH THIS: Making his 20th start of the season, 13th at the Triple-A level, and first of his career against Scranton/WB tonight will be southpaw **JACKSON KENT**...he picked up his seventh win as a Red Wing in his previous start on 7/28 vs. SYR, and eighth overall to hold a share of the Nationals Minor League-lead with RHP Carson Fischer...the 23-year-old allowed three earned on six hits across 5.1 innings in that outing, while striking out four and walking two...coming into tonight's contest at Scranton/WB, Kent logs a 2.57 ERA (12 ER/42.0 IP) across nine road starts between Rochester and Double-A Harrisburg this season, T-11th best among full-season MiLB pitchers with at least 40.0 innings logged away from home...he also ranks 24th with a .203 BAA (11th among AA and AAA pitchers)...

Kent is the only International League pitcher in 2026 with at least seven wins (T-3rd in IL) in fewer than 15 starts.

WALL TO WALL: 2B **CAYDEN WALLACE** picked up his first pair of Triple-A doubles at the plate last night, going 2-for-4 while adding an RBI on a two-bagger in the eighth...since making his debut with the Red Wings on the Fourth of July, the 2022 second-round pick ranks second on the team and 13th in the International League (min. 50 AB) with an average exit velocity of 91.7 MPH...his double in the eighth came off the bat at exactly 100.0 MPH, the fourth-hardest hit ball by a Red Wing against Scranton/WB this season...Wallace is the only Nationals Minor Leaguer with at least 100 hits this season (102)...he also leads the way in total bases (186), and ranks second in homers (20), XBH (41), and SLG (.522).

LIP SERVICE: 3B **TREY LIPSCOMB** picked up two more hits out of the third spot in the order last night, going 2-for-5 with a double and a run scored...he has now hit safely in 23 of his last 27 games dating back to the start of July...over that span, the Maryland native ranks 11th in the International League (min. 50 AB) with a .340 batting average (35-for-103)...his 35 total hits rank fifth, 19 RBI also ranks 11th, and 52 total bases and 18 runs scored are both T-13th most...

Lipscomb now has 63 doubles with Rochester, six shy of Jake Noll for most by any Red Wing in the Statcast era (since 2015).

DIS-GUS-TING: RHP **GUS VARLAND** took the mound in the ninth inning last night, firing 1.0 perfect inning in 15 pitches via two pop outs and a ground out...the Minnesota native has now turned in a team-leading seven consecutive appearances as a Red Wing without allowing an earned run dating back to 7/11 at WOR...he has allowed just two hits in 8.1 innings over that stretch (.074 BAA), with a 0.48 WHIP and 12 strikeouts to just two walks...additionally, Varland is 1-0 with a 1.23 ER (1 ER/7.1 IP) across six road appearances in a Red Wings uniform, with 11 strikeouts and just one walk.

THE GLASS MAN: LF **PHILLIP GLASSER** reached base twice in last night's loss at Scranton/WB, extending his on-base streak to 12 games, finishing the night 1-for-4 at the dish...since the start of July he's reached base in 18 of 21 games, slashing .328/.471/.388, in addition his .471 OBP is good for 8th among International League hitters (Min. 65 AB), while his seven strikeouts is second-fewest in that stretch...he ranks first among Nationals full-season Minor League hitters in batting average (.307) this season, and is now just three hits shy of 100 as a Red Wing...

Glasser played left field in last night's game for the third time this season...in his Minor League career, he's played seven different positions in the field.

THE HITS KEEP ADAMS-ING UP: C **RILEY ADAMS** comes into tonight's game on an eight-game hitting streak dating back to 7/26 at BUF...the righty slugger drove in two in a 1-for-4 effort at the plate in last night's series opener in Scranton, his seventh multi-RBI game of the campaign...the former Toronto Blue Jays farmhand is currently tied for the sixth-longest active hitting streak in the International League; he's slashing .481/.548/.704 during the stretch...

Since Independence Day, Adams ranks second among International League hitters with at least 60 at-bats in hard hit percentage (62.5), third in Barrel percentage (18.8), and eighth in Isolated Power (.309).

RED WINGS REWIND...

...**2012:** 14 years ago today, the Red Wings and Toledo Mud Hens combined for 43 hits in a 19-inning marathon that lasted six hours and 32 minutes at Fifth-Third Field...Rochester scored three in the 19th after both teams had been held scoreless since the 10th, surrendered a pair of runs via a two-run shot from the Mud Hens in the bottom half, but ultimately secured a 10-9 victory...six different Red Wings hitters notched at least three knocks, while the trio of RF **MATT CARSON**, LF **WILKIN RAMIREZ**, and 3B **RAY CHANG** picked up four hits apiece...SS **EDUARDO ESCOBAR** went deep in the fifth, and 1B **CHRIS PARMELEE** launched a solo shot in the ninth to tie things up and force extras...seven different Rochester pitchers saw time on the mound, and each logged at least 2.0 innings of work.

Entering his third professional season, all with the Nationals organization after he was selected in the fourth round of the 2024 MLB Draft, out of the University of Arizona...named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on 4/13/2025 with High-A Wilmington.

- Set to make his 13th start with Rochester in the second game of this six-game set at Scranton Wilkes-Barre, the lefty holds a 3.55 ERA on the road in 25.1 innings of work; in addition, he has a superb 1.50 ERA in Wednesday games.
- Began the 2026 season with Double-A Harrisburg...made seven starts with the team to start the season, logging a 2.35 ERA (8 ER/30.2 IP) with 38 strikeouts and eight walks, a 0.88 WHIP and .176 batting average against...transferred to Triple-A Rochester on 5/21 for his Triple-A debut two days later.
- At the time of his promotion to Rochester, he led the Eastern League (min. 25.0 IP) in WHIP, held a share of the league-lead in fewest runs allowed (8), and ranked fourth in batting average against, H/9 (5.58) and K/BB (4.75)...turned in at least 5.0 innings and allowed three or fewer earned runs in each of his last three starts with the team, and four of his last five.
- Split his first professional season between High-A Wilmington (18 GS), and Double-A Harrisburg in 2025...combined to log a 4.61 ERA (63 ER/123.0 IP), with 132 strikeouts, 38 walks, a 1.22 WHIP and .243 batting average against.
- Began 2025 with High-A Wilmington...set career-highs with 7.2 innings pitched and 11 strikeouts on 5/6 vs. Hudson Valley (NYY)...turned in 6.0 scoreless innings in his final start with the team on 8/5, and was transferred to Harrisburg on 8/12 for his Double-A debut.
- Turned in at least 5.0 and struck out at least five batters in five of his six starts at Double-A.
