## CRIM HOMERS AGAIN, RIDERS FALL TO DRILLERS:

The Frisco RoughRiders surrendered five runs in the first inning, a deficit too tall to overcome as they fell to the Tulsa Drillers Thursday night, 9-7. **Blaine Crim** hit his second home run in as many games for the infielder and his sixth of the season in the Riders road loss. The Drillers won their third game of the week and extended their winning streak to five games behind a five-run opening frame on Frisco starter **Justin Slaten** (0-1), who departed after recording one out in the first. Hunter Feduccia and James Outman both homered for the Drillers and finished with five of the nine RBIs for Tulsa. After 3.1 innings from **Tyler Thomas**, Riders reliever **Seth Nordlin** struck out five batters in 4.1 innings and held Tulsa scoreless in their final four innings at the plate. Frisco drew five walks from Tulsa RHP Clayton Beeter, his most allowed this season. Drillers reliever Alec Gamboa (3-0) gave up three runs in four innings to provide the third win of the week for Tulsa. Along with Crim, Frisco second baseman **Justin Foscue** rode a multi-hit night, finishing with three RBI and drew two walks in a 2-for-3 effort offensively. Foscue's average rises to a .318 at the plate on top of a 1.009 OPS. After not playing in Wednesday's game, Crim knocked his second home run of the week Thursday night to make it 11 total bases in his last two games. Facing an early five-run deficit, the Riders began their scoring with a bases-loaded walk to Foscue to bring in **David Garcia**. Frisco drove in two more on a **Trey Hair** double in the third inning to trim Tulsa's lead to 5-3. The Drillers answered with four runs in the bottom of the fourth behind Outman's two-run home run and an RBI single from Kody Hoes. A wild pitch scored Brandon Lewis from third to finish the scoring and stretch Tulsa's lead to 9-2. Frisco again began working back offensively with an RBI single from Foscue in the top of the sixth. With the bases loaded later in the inning, Outman pulled a fly ball back over the right field fence to deny **Ezequiel Duran** a grand slam, ending in a sacrifice fly and trimming Tulsa's lead to 9-5. Following Crim's home run in the top of the seventh, Foscue doubled in **Kellen Strahm** in the eighth to finish the game's scoring at 9-7.

## DURAN, DURAN: DOUBLE TROUBLE

Riders infielder **Ezequiel Duran** is riding a nine-game hitting streak and leads all of Minor League Baseball in doubles with 14. Over his hitting streak, the Dominican Republic native is hitting .447 (17-for-38)/.450/.789/1.239 with five doubles, two home runs, 10 RBIs and only six strikeouts. Duran also collected multiple hits in five-straight games until Wednesday at Tulsa.

## AYYY, IT'S THE FOSCUE

Riders infielder **Justin Foscue** has caught fire for Frisco. After starting in Extended Spring Training because of back tightness, he joined the club on April 19th. Foscue went 1-for-7 in his first two games, but in his last 16, the former Mississippi State Bulldog has hit .339 (20-for-59)/.451/.644 with 10 doubles, a triple, two home runs, 12 RBIs, 12 walks and eight runs. He is riding an 14-game on base streak, where he owns a .476 OBP and a 1.103 OPS.

## ROAD WARRIORS:

The RoughRiders have played 15 games at home and 15 games on the road so far in 2022. While they are just 7-8 at home, Frisco is 10-5 on the road this season, the best road record in all of Minor League Baseball. Pitching has been dominant away from Riders Field, owning a 4.90 ERA on the road and holding opponents to just a .240 BAA and 10 home runs over the 15 games. The Riders have the fourth-best road ERA in the Texas League and the fifth-best road OPS (.800) in the league. At home, Frisco's pitching staff has a 4.07 ERA (fourth in the Texas League) and the Riders have given up 17 home runs in 15 games while they have the sixth-best OPS in the league at home (.753). Frisco has lost its last three road games in Tulsa.

## JONNY ON THE SPOT:

Riders infielder **Jonny Ornelas** has been tearing the cover off of the baseball in recent days. Ornelas has batted .381 (37-for-97)/.423/.505/.928 in his last 24 games and .412 (28-for-68) with 1.047 OPS over his last 17 games. He has five games with at least three hits this season to lead the club. Ornelas is also the youngest player on the Riders and the 21-year-old is the 10th-youngest in the Texas League. Ornelas owns a .362 average on the season, which is fourth in Double-A and the best in the Texas Rangers organization.

## THE VIPER STRIKES AGAIN:

Known as "The Viper" since his college days at Alabama, Frisco reliever **Chase Lee** has struck quickly and often this season. Over his 11 outings, Lee has allowed just four hits (.100 BAA) while not allowing a run and going 3-for-3 in save opportunities. In his 12.1 innings, Lee has whiffed 15 while walking just six. Lee spurs a bullpen that is the best in the Texas League in ERA (3.76) and BAA (.192), which is also third in the minors.

## ALLOW ME TO REINTRODUCE MYSELF:

Riders reliever **Seth Nordlin** has been strong out of the bullpen. Ever since his first game of the season when he allowed four runs, Nordlin has gone 2-0 with a 1.25 ERA over 21.2 IP. During that span, opponents are just hitting .139 (10-for-72) against him while he has whiffed 23 and walked six. Over his last three outings, Nordlin has just surrendered one earned run over 10.2 innings with 13 strikeouts and one walk.

## REARVIEW MIRRORS:

Since the 2019 season ended and the standings reset on September 3rd, 2019, the RoughRiders have not been in second place for 982 days. From the season-opening game in 2021, the RoughRiders held first place the entire season and have now been in first place for every game in 2022 as well.

## LOOK AT ALL THAT TALENT:

While RHP **Jack Leiter** headlines the top 30 prospects talent on the squad as the No. 1 prospect, the Riders back up him with plenty of players to watch. INF **Ezequiel Duran** slots in as the No. 4 prospect in the organization after the Rangers acquired him from the Yankees as part of the **Joey Gallo** deal at the 2021 deadline. INF **Justin Foscue**, who joined the club after sustaining an injury during spring training, is the No. 5 prospect. OF **Dustin Harris** is the No. 6 prospect after his incredible 20-20 campaign a year ago. Another trade piece, Harris came to the Rangers when they dealt **Mike Minor** to the A's in 2020. LHP **Cody Bradford** is the No. 20 prospect. Bradford, a former Baylor Bear from Aledo, Texas, led all Rangers farmhands in strikeouts last season. RHP **Zak Kent** slots in as the No. 21 prospect by MLB.com. LHP **Cole Ragans** was just added to the top 30 at No. 30 during the season with the graduation of RHP **Glen Otto**.

### ABOUT CODY

-Grew up in Aledo, Texas, just an hour away from Frisco. Valedictorian at Aledo High School while helping the baseball team to the state semifinals his junior season (owning a 1.37 ERA) and earning the 2016 All-District 8-5A MVP Pitcher award.

-Grew up a Rangers fan. Derek Holland was his favorite player.

-Married Madi O'Neal (a former softball player at Baylor) on December 15, 2019.

-At Baylor, missed almost his entire final season after being diagnosed with thoracic outlet syndrome, which causes the nerves that pass between the collarbone and first rib to become compressed. He received surgery in March of 2019 before being selected by the Rangers in the June draft. Ranked as a potential second rounder before the injury.

-After FR season at Baylor, spent a lot of time adding good weight to bulk up and it paid off. Following a freshman season in which he went 5-5 with a 5.52 ERA, he turned in a 7-5 season with a 2.38 ERA to earn Big-12 Pitcher of the Year honors.

-Teammates with former Riders infielder Davis Wendzel at Baylor.

### 2022 SEASON

-Enters season as the Rangers No. 20 prospect.

-Opening Day starter for the RoughRiders (April 8th), exiting in the fifth without allowing a run before both stranded runners scored and were charged to him.

-Allowed career-highs in runs (10) and walks (4) in start on April 22nd against Northwest Arkansas. Gave up a grand slam to former Baylor teammate Nick Loftin in loss.

-Over his 16.2 innings thus far, he has allowed all of his runs in just 4.2 innings (13 H, 16 ER, 6 BB) while his other 12 innings have been scoreless.

### 2021 SEASON

-The No. 30 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com. Finished the season as a Texas Rangers Organizational All-Star by MLB.com.

-Led Texas farmhands with 128 strikeouts and was tied for second in innings pitched (96.1).

-Started the 2021 season with High-A Hickory, owning a 33.2 percent strikeout rate and a 6.5 percent walk rate.

-On July 22nd, 6.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 14 K against Asheville in a win.

-Whiffed nine over 5.1 innings in Double-A debut against Amarillo on August 5th.

-Struck out 23 before walking a batter over his first three starts with the RoughRiders.

-Seven-inning start against Arkansas on August 18th is the longest start for the RoughRiders on season and also a career-best for Bradford.
