### RIDERS EARN 3-1 WIN, EVEN SERIES WITH SOD POODLES:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Amarillo Sod Poodles 3-1 on Wednesday evening from HODGETOWN. Frisco (37-28, 81-53) started the scoring against Amarillo (27-37, 57-76) starter Yu-Min Lin on a solo homer by **Maximo Acosta**, his eighth jack of the season. In the home half of the inning **Winston Santos** (5-3) issued a walk before allowing an RBI double to Caleb Roberts, evening the game at 1-1. **Tucker Mitchell** opened the top of the third inning with a single before moving to third on a double from **Daniel Mateo**. **Josh Hatcher** gave the Riders the lead with an RBI groundout before an RBI single by Acosta pushed the Frisco advantage to 3-1. Santos finished after 5.0 innings, allowing just one run on one hit and two walks while fanning six. **Bryan Magdaleno** delivered a scoreless, one-hit inning to stretch his scoreless outing streak to 16 consecutive appearances. **Skylar Hales** tossed a pair of scoreless innings, facing one over the minimum. **Dane Acker** entered in the home half of the ninth inning, surrendering a pair of singles before striking out Christian Cerda to earn his first career save. Offensively, the RoughRiders collected eight hits as Acosta's three led the way to mark the lone multi-hit night for Frisco.

### PUSH IT TO THE MAXIMO:

Riders infielder **Max Acosta** has been en fuego at the plate, hitting .325 (53-for-163)/.390/.509/.899 over his last 42 games. Since July 10th, in those last 42 games, he is third in the league in average (.325) and fifth in OPS (.899). In his last 29 games, he is hitting .342 (39-for-114)/.412/.544/.956. He has hits in 10 of his last 11 games, batting .410/.531/.795/1.326. Acosta now has a career-best in all slashline categories and is one of five qualified players in the Texas League this year who is 21-year-old or younger.

### CHASING RECORDS:

The RoughRiders are within reach of both the franchise records for most wins (85, 2007) and best winning percentage (.607, 2007). The Riders need to finish 3-1 in their last four games to get the winning percentage record and 4-0 to tie their wins record. On the pitching side, they are on pace to allow the fewest hits in a full season (not including the 119-game 2021 season), with 1,036 and the lowest batting average against in a full season (.231).

### HATCHIN HOMERS:

**Josh Hatcher** has been one of the hotter hitters in the Texas League recently, batting .329/.390/.465/.855 over his last 39 games with nine doubles, four home runs and 21 RBIs. In his last 12 games, he is hitting .354 (17-for-48)/.404/.521/.925 with five doubles, one home run, seven RBIs, six runs scored.

### ABIME-LECTRIC ORTIZ:

**Abimelec Ortiz** has been on fire for the RoughRiders recently. Over his last 44 games, Ortiz is hitting .293/.385/.515/.900 with eight doubles, nine home runs, 30 RBIs, 29 runs scored and 24 walks. Since July 10th, in those 43 games, he is fifth in average (.293), fifth in OPS (.900), tied for fourth in RBIs (30) and fifth in home runs (nine). In his last 25 games, he is batting .323 (30-for-93)/.432/.581/1.013 with four doubles, six home runs, 22 RBIs, 17 walks, 21 strikeouts and 19 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. Since, he is hitting .283 with an .861 OPS, raising his batting average to .229 and a .705 OPS.

### HOMER HAPPY:

On August 16th, the Riders hit a season-high four home runs with **Luis Mieses** capping the night with his second for a walk-off home run. It was Mieses's third multi-home run game of his career. The RoughRiders have hit 26 home runs in the last 23 games, with those 24 home runs being second in the Texas League over the last 21 games. Frisco is still just seventh in the Texas League in home runs this season with 102 across their 134 games (on pace for 106, which would be for the 12th in the 21 seasons of the franchise).

### HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders were fantastic at home this year, going 44-24 at Riders Field this season. At home this season, Frisco had a +69 run differential, a 3.88 ERA and is averaging 5.2 runs per game with a .743 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 37-29 with a 3.43 ERA, but a +26 run differential while averaging 4.1 runs per game and owning a .660 OPS (9th in the league). **Cody Freeman** has 10 of his 14 home runs at home while **Abimelec Ortiz** has hit 10 of his 14 homers at Riders Field. Ortiz is batting .303/.392/.524/.916 at home as opposed to .149/.223/.253/.476 on the road.

### WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

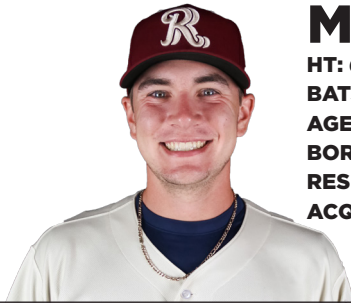

### ABOUT MITCH

-During COVID-19, finding a place to throw was difficult, so he built a bullpen in the backyard of his home in Newmarket, Ontario to keep throwing. While most Canadian schools were not able to start playing baseball in 2021, Bratt made the decision to transfer to Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Georgia (outside of near Savannah). He completed his final year of high school online while playing baseball.

-After spending two months at GPA, he played in the MLB Draft League during the summer of 2021, going 1-1 with a 2.57 ERA while playing for the West Virginia Black Bears.

-Baseball America ranked Bratt as the No. 3 Canadian prospect going into the 2021 draft.

-Committed to play baseball at Florida State.

-Made one start for Team Canada in the 2023 World Baseball Classic as a 19-year-old against Team USA, going 0-1 IP, 3 H, 6 R, 6 ER, facing MLB All-Stars Mookie Betts, Mike Trout, Paul Goldschmidt, Nolan Arenado, Kyle Tucker, Tim Anderson and JT Realmuto.

### 2024 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 21 prospect in the Rangers organization by MiLB.com.

-After tough first start of the season (3.0 IP, 8 H, 7 R, 7 ER, 0 BB, 4 K vs. JS) with Hickory, has gone 6-3 with a 2.30 ERA over his last 16 games (14 starts) with 80 strikeouts to 16 walks over 74.1 innings.

-In last 10 games in Hickory (nine starts), went 4-1 with 1.35 ERA, striking out 55 over 53.1 IP to 11 walks, holding opponents to .182 batting average.

-Dominated with Hickory while ahead in the count, allowing a .163 average and .240 slugging (as opposed to .298 average and .638 slugging when behind in the count).

-First Double-A start was 5.0 shutout innings at San Antonio on 8/1.

### 2023 SEASON

-Spent all of 2023 with High-A Hickory and was selected as an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star.

-Despite being 19 at the beginning of the season and turning 20 midway through the year, he ranked fifth in the South Atlantic League in ERA (3.54) among those with at least 15 starts.

-Was placed on the Injured List from 7/18-8/31 with lat tightness.

-Played under Carlos Cardoza in the 2023 Arizona Fall League with the Surprise Saguaros, going 1-0 with a 6.46 ERA over six games (one start).

### 2022 SEASON

-Was named an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star with Low-A Down East, entering the season as the youngest pitcher in the Carolina League at 18 years old.

-He finished the season third in ERA (2.45).

-Named the Rangers Starting Pitcher of the Month for July, going 3-1 with a 1.96 ERA.

### 2021 SEASON

-Bratt out 13 of 24 (54.2%) batters faced without issuing a walk over four appearances for the ACL Rangers in his professional debut.

-He recorded at least three strikeouts in each of his outings, all of which came in August or September, shortly after his 18th birthday.
