NOTES AND NUGGETS

PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- The Chasers won last week's series opener against Louisville 9-4 to clinch the 1st half.
- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings reset Tuesday for the start of the 2nd half, Omaha's enters today's game with the best overall record in Minor League Baseball, 23 games over .500 at 50-27 (.649).

- 50 wins are the 2nd-most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, just behind the 51-win Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Astros Triple-A).
- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .649 winning percentage overall this year is also the best, just ahead of Sugar Land (51-28 / .646).
- Omaha has held the best record in Minor League Baseball for 24 days, since June 5.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

49 of Omaha's 77 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 18 of 26 losses in 2024.

- Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 3 of its last 9 save opportunities, including the last 3.
- Omaha is 17-8 in 1-run games this season, the most wins in 1-run games of any Minor League team ... the Storm Chasers have won 10 of their last 15 games decided by just a run.
- As a team, Omaha's 23 saves are the 5th-most of any Minor League team and second in Triple-A ... **Will Klein's** 9 saves individually rank third in the International League, while six Storm Chasers players have 2 or more saves this year.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 426 to 345 this season, a +81 run differential.

- A +81 run differential is the 2nd-best the International League and is the 3rd-highest mark at the Triple-A level, just behind Syracuse (+97) and Oklahoma City (+89).
- Omaha ranks tied 8th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Modesto Nuts lead the Minors at +151 (478 to 327).

COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 27 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (54%) of this year's wins have been comeback victories.

- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as five runs to win and 10 times, have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win.
- Omaha has trailed for three innings or more in 10 of the 27 comeback wins, with four victories where the club had to overcome multiple deficits ... the team has 7 wins in games where they trailed after the 6th inning.

DAZZLING DEFENSE

Omaha's defense has had its ups and downs this season, but the team is on one of its best stretches in the field this season.

- Over Omaha's last 17 games (since June 9), a .986 fielding percentage (8 E in 592 TC) is the 2nd-best in the International League, with the 4th-fewest errors in that span.
- Early in the season, the Storm Chasers went 7 straight games without making an error, March 31 to April 7, that included all 6 games of a series at Columbus, April 3-7.

RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen has been one of the best across the entire Triple-A level in 2024.

- The Storm Chasers relievers lead all Triple-A bullpens with a 1.33 WHIP and an opposing slash line of .208/.321/.346 ... the .208 opponents' average is the 5th-best in all of the Minors ... a 3.60 ERA from the relievers ranks 2nd in Triple-A.
- Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run in 19 games this year, roughly one in every 4.05 games.
- Since June 14, Omaha's bullpen has a 2.53 ERA (15 ER in 53.1 IP), the 2nd-best in Triple-A in that 14-game stretch.
- Walter Pennington's** 73 strikeouts (in 30 games/2 starts) are the 9th-most in the International League ... his 36.3% strikeout rate is 4th in MiLB (min. 50.0 IP).

- Lynch IV is making his 12th Omaha start, 15th overall start and 17th overall appearance this season ... Lynch is on his fourth stint in Triple-A with Omaha, previously with the Storm Chasers March 29-May 4 and May 10 to 29 and May 31 to June 1.

LAST OUTING: SUNDAY, MAY 23 vs. LOUISVILLE

Retired his first 9 batters of the game and 16 of his first 17, with 1-2-3 innings in the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 5th ... worked around a leadoff double in the 4th, retired his next 7 batters into the 6th inning, including striking out the side in the 5th ... 3 singles scored a run in the 6th ... got the first two outs of the 7th inning but was removed ... was in line for the win, but got a no-decision, the Bats scored 3 in the 9th.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Daniel was optioned to Triple-A Omaha on March 20 and started Opening Day for the Storm Chasers, March 29 @ Iowa, his first of 5 Omaha starts that have been 5.0 innings.

CAREER NOTES

- Limited to just 9 starts for the Royals around a pair of stints on the Injured List ... missed the first 53 games of the season due to a rotator cuff strain suffered in Spring Training, then missed the last 66 games of the season with a left shoulder strain.

- Made 27 starts for Kansas City to tie Kris Bubic for the team lead, despite two Injured List stints with a blister on his left index finger, June 23 to July 11 and July 17 to August 1, during which he combined to miss 26 games ... made 2 rehab starts with Omaha.

- Spent April at the Alternate Training Site in Springdale, AR and was slated to start the year in Omaha ... had his contract selected on May 3 without having pitched in a game above the High-A level and went on to make 15 starts with the Royals over two stints.

- Spent much of the season with Wilmington (A+) but had stints with Surprise (R) and Burlington (R) as well on rehab assignment, combined to go 6-2 over 20 starts, with a 2.99 ERA (32 ER in 96.1 IP) with 96 strikeouts ... named a Carolina League Midseason All-Star.

- Split his first professional season between Burlington (R) and Lexington (A) and combined to go 5-1 over 12 starts with a 1.58 ERA (9 ER in 51.1 IP) with 61 strikeouts or 8 walks (7.63 K/BB) ... his ERA and 1.4 fB/g were both second-best among Royals farmhands (min. 50.0 IP).
