#### JUMBO SHRIMP TAKE SERIES FINALE

Troy Johnston homered and Jake Mangum drove in three runs on Sunday as Jacksonville bested Lehigh Valley 7-4. The IronPigs grabbed the lead on Aramis Garcia's first-inning home run. In the second, though, Santiago Chavez tied the game with an RBI single and Mangum gave the Jumbo Shrimp the advantage with a two-run base knock. Johnston cracked a two-run shot in the third to make it 5-1. A Simon Muzziotti home run drew Lehigh Valley a little closer in the sixth. Mangum doubled in a run in the eighth, and after Garcia's second long ball of the game made it 6-4, Peyton Burdick's ninth-inning RBI single set the margin at 7-4.

#### TROY MEETS WORLD

Troy Johnston has been scorching hot in his return to the Bold City. In 23 games with Jacksonville, Johnston is 34-for-94 (.362/.439/.628/1.067) with eight doubles, one triple, five home runs and 21 RBIs, Johnston has reached base at least once in every game, registering `` multi-hit contests. His 23-game on-base streak is the longest by a Jacksonville hitter since Justin Twine's 27-game run from July 19-August 19, 2018. Including Johnston's time with Pensacola in 2023, the Tacoma, Wash., native has driven in 104 runs, the most of any MiLB player, in 106 games.

Over the last two weeks, the Jumbo Shrimp have boasted a dominant bullpen. In the 12 games since August 8, Jacksonville relievers have combined to surrender only 21 runs. 17 earned, on 35 hits (7.6 H/9) in 41.1 innings for a 3.70 ERA. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to strike out 56 batters (12.2 K/9) against 27 walks (5.9 BB/9).

Jacksonville posted seven runs offensively on Sunday at Lehigh Valley, the 13th time in the last 18 games the club has tallied at least five runs. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp lead the IL in hits (185) while ranking second in both batting average (.293) and on-base percentage (.389), fifth in doubles (35), seventh in OPS (.838) and eighth in runs scored (110, 6.1 per game). The Jumbo Shrimp were hitting just .256/.341/.417/.758 with 525 runs scored in 101 games (5.2 per game) as a team prior to this run.

#### IT ALL STARTS WITH THIS

Jacksonville has won 10 out of their last 15 games, a stretch that has featured elite starting pitching. During the run, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have yielded three runs or fewer 11 times, working 68.2 innings out of the club's 123.0 innings thrown (55.8 percent). Jacksonville starters had tossed 52.2 percent of the team's innings prior to this run. Additionally, Jumbo Shrimp starters are 7-3 with a 3.93 ERA (33 R, 30 ER in 68.2 innings). They have combined for 59 strikeouts (7.7 K/9) against only 25 walks (3.3 BB/9) and 68 hits allowed (8.9 H/9).

#### X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 61 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 94-for-250 at the plate, slashing .376/.443/.504/.947 with nine doubles, one triple. seven home runs 41 RBIs and 54 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to first in MiLB in average (.359) and fourth in the IL in OBP (.439). Among the 326 players in the IL with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023, Edwards has the third-best swinging-strike rate (4.3%).

### MAYOR MANGUM

Jake Mangum went hitless in seven of the eight games he played in from May 31-June 8, going just 1-for-24 at the plate. In his 43 games since that point, Mangum is a sizzling 63-for-177, hitting .356/.401/.486/.887 with 13 doubles, two triples, two home runs, 18 RBIs and 31 runs scored. The Flowood, Miss., native has picked up 13 multi-hit games in his last 31 games, batting 51-for-137 (.372/.416/.504/.920) with 10 doubles, one triple, two homers, 14 RBIs and 25 runs scored during this stretch. On the season, among the 263 IL players with at least 150 plate appearances, Mangum has the third-highest opposite field rate (45.8 percent). His 29.3 percent line drive rate is 21st.

#### **ABOUT DANIEL**

-Castano was included by the St. Louis Cardinals along with right-handers Sandy Alcantara, and Zac Gallen and outfielder Magneuris Sierra on December 14, 2017 in a trade with the Miami Marlins for outfielder Marcell Ozuna.

-Castano was originally selected by St. Louis in the 19th round of the 2016 draft out of Baylor.

-A product of Lake Travis High School, one of Castano's teammates in high school was Baker Mayfield, formerly the quarterback of the Cleveland Browns. Castano threw a no-hitter in the District 4A playoff series against Crockett in 2013.

-Castano starred at Baylor University, earning All-Big 12 Honorable Mention in 2015, as well as a spot on the 2014 Big 12 All-Freshman Team. That 2015 season saw Castano post a 3.48 ERA, the 25th-lowest in school history. He tied for first on the team in strikeouts (45) and wins (four), while finishing second in innings pitched (77.1).

#### 2023 SEASON

-Placed on the 7-day IL on April 17 and missed 63 games before being reinstated on June 28.

#### 2022 SEASON

-Castano began the season with Miami but was optioned to Jacksonville on April 28.

#### 2021 SEASON

-In his final start of 2021, Castano no-hit Gwinnett for 7.0 innings before yielding a leadoff single to Chadwick Tromp in the eighth. He ultimately ceded two hits in 8.0 shutout frames.

-Castano made four starts with the Marlins before being optioned on May  $\boldsymbol{\theta}$  to Jacksonville.

#### 2020 SEASON

-Castano made his major league debut for the Marlins on August 8, 2020 at the New York Mets' Citi Field in Queens.

-After posting a 4.11 ERA in his first four starts (15.1 IP, 16 H, 8 BB, 8 K), Castano went 1-0 with a 1.88 ERA over his final three outings, including two starts (14.1 IP, 14 H, 3 BB, 4 K).

#### 2019 SEASON

-Castano began the season with High- $\overline{\rm A}$  Jupiter before earning a promotion on May 28 to Jacksonville.

-The left-hander worked a minimum of 6.0 innings in each of his six starts from July 15 through August 16. During that span, Castano went 5-0 with a 1.73 ERA in 41.2 innings. He whiffed 40 against three walks and 26 hits against.

-Castano matched Jacksonville's Marlins era record (2009-present) by whiffing a career-high 13 batters in a career-best 9.0 innings on August 8 against Mississippi. The outing marked Jacksonville's first nine-inning complete game since Justin Nicolino's gem on July 29, 2014 at Montgomery.

-Including his stints with Jacksonville and Beloit in 2021, Walters posted a 2-3 record with a 4.06 ERA. Walters tossed 58 innings, giving up 46 hits.
-Son of Kent and Beth Walters, has one brother, Garrett. His father Kent played baseball at Mississippi State and brother played baseball at the University of Louisiana at Monroe and was a manager on the Alabama baseball team.

-Walters attended Thompson High School and earned 2013 All-State, All-Metro and All-County honors and was a finalist for the Alabama Gatorade Baseball Player of the Year.
