**TODAY'S GAME:** The M-Braves conclude their nine-game, two-city road trip with the series finale at Tennessee. The M-Braves went 1-2 on the first leg in Chattanooga, July 14-16.

**HOW THE GRINCH STOLE CHRISTMAS...IN JULY:** The M-Braves were swept in two close games in the doubleheader and have lost all five games

The M-Braves are a lowely 1-7 on the road trip and have lost five straight, their longest losing streak since an eight-game losing streak from April 13-22.

TENNESSEE WALTZ: The M-Braves face both of Tennessee's Southern League teams on this road trip. This is the first meeting with the Smokies in 2023, after going 3-8 against the Cubs affiliate in 2022. The Smokies will visit Trustmark Park in the final homestand of the season, September 5-10.

TOP PITCHING STAFF: The M-Braves lead the Southern League, and rank 6th in Double-A, with a 4.05 ERA. The pitching staff has given up just 69 home runs, the fewest in Double-A. The M-Braves bullpen is 3rd in Double-A with a 3.50

**GRAND SALAMI TIME:** The M-Braves have a club record six grand slams, including the first-ever multi-grand slam game on June 16 at Pensacola (Cade Bunnell, Luke Waddell). Waddell's last two home runs were grand slams on June 16 at Pensacola and July 1 at Biloxi.

PROSPECTING: 8 of Atlanta's Top 30 MLB Pipeline prospects are on the active roster: RHP Victor Vodnik (10), INF Cal Conley (12), OF Jesse Franklin V (13), RHP Alan Rangel (25), RHP Tanner Gordon (27), C Tyler Tolve (28), LHP Luis De Avila (29) and INF Luke Waddell (30).

RETURN OF THE PEARL CITY BOMBERS: The M-Braves rank 3rd in the league and 8th in Double-A with 104 homers in 87 games - 67 on the road, while their opponents have just 66 total home runs. 16 Mississippi players have at least one homer, with Landon Stephens leading the way with 18, which is T-1st in the Southern

M-Braves opponents have just 15 home runs at Trustmark Park this season.

STREAKIN' TOLVE: Tyler Tolve's 20-game onbase streak from May 24 to July 2 was the longest by an M-Braves player this season. He has currently reached in 26 of 28 games

**DEAN RUNNIN' WILD:** Justin Dean set a club record with four steals in the first two innings on July 1 at Biloxi. Dean had seven steals over two games, June 30-July 2, finished the series with eight stolen bases, and has a team-leading 22 on the year, which ranks 7th in the Southern League.

WELCOME BACK MILLY: OF Cody Milligan returned from the IL on Friday after being shut down on April 25 after suffering a wrist injury. The Binger, OK is batting .329 with eight doubles, one home run, nine RBI, 21 runs, 14 walks, and .941 OPS.

WADDYYY: Luke Waddell is tied for the league lead with a .307 batting average, and ranks among the league leaders in OBP (.413, 3rd), and OPS (.875, 6th). Over his last 37 games since June 4, Luke Waddell is batting .331 with a league-most 48 hits, 27 runs, plus 30 RBI, six homers, two grand slams, 14 extra-base hits, 11 stolen bases, and .928 OPS.

RETURN OF THE SLUGBAUER: 1B Drew Lugbauer hit his 101st minor league home run on Wednesday at Tennessee, which was his 60th in three seasons for the M-Braves. Lugbauer returned Wednesday from his second IL stint. He is currently on a 13-game hitting streak, batting .452 with 4 2B, 4 HR, 9 RBI, 8 BB, .549 OBP, and 1.382 OPS. It's the longest current streak in the

On May 23, Lugbauer cranked a 117-mile-perhour home run, ranking 5th among MLB players for hardest-hit balls.

The M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader slugged his 50th career M-Braves home run on April 30 at Biloxi. Lugbauer has a club record, and Double-A franchise record 60 home runs over parts of three seasons. Lugbauer also has a club-record 173 RBI. He hit 18 homers in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022

ANOTHER WINNING MONTH: After an 8-13 April, the M-Braves posted a 13-12 record in May and June. Over the month of June, the M-Braves ranked 2nd in the league with a .250 batting average, 37 home runs, and a 4.17

DE AVILA DELIVERS IN JUNE: Luis De Avila delivered five solid starts in June, going 3-0 with a 1.61 ERA in 28.0 innings. After a team-most 16 starts, De Avila ranks among the league leaders in ERA (3.28, 3rd), opponent average (.222, 4th) and WHIP (1.32, 7th).

EVEN STEPHENS: Landon Stephens leads the Southern League, is T-2nd in Double-A, and T-4th in MiLB with 12 home runs since June 1. He homered in three straight games from June 16-18 and has homered in two-straight, on four different occasions

Stephens leads the Southern League with 21 extra-base hits since June 1, and overall this season is T-1st in home runs with 18. He ranks among the league leaders in OPS (.878, 8th), slugging (.512, 6th), extra-base hits (31, 8th), and RBI (51, 8th).

HOT VOD: Victor Vodnik has not allowed a run over his last 13 appearances since May 27, 18.0 IP, 6 H, 28 strikeouts to 13 walks. Since the start of May, Vodnik is 2-0 with four saves, a 0.64 ERA in 28.0 innings and 20 games. He is currently 3rd in the league appearances with 28.

 De Avila pitched a dazzling five no-hit innings on Sunday at Chattanooga as part of an 8-0 win. The left-hander walked three and struck out six. The M-Braves ended up carrying the no-hitter two outs into the seventh inning.
