RALLY FALLS SHORT IN SLUGFEST IN COLUMBUS

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp offense was quiet on Saturday in a 4-2 loss to the Columbus Clippers. Micah Pries led off the third with a home run to open up the scoring. Later in the inning, Jose Tena notched an RBI triple and Kyle Manzardo registered an RBI single to widen the gap to 3-0. A Tena base knock coupled with an error in the fifth made it 4-0. The Jumbo Shrimp mustered only one hit through 5.0 innings and couldn't get on the board until the eighth, when Austin Allen smacked a two-run double. However, Jacksonville could get no closer in the loss.

TROY MEETS WORLD

After struggling in Jacksonville to close the 2022 season, Troy Johnston has been scorching hot in his return to the Bold City this year. In 27 games with Jacksonville, Johnston is 41-for-110 (.373/.435/.609/1.044) with nine doubles, one triple, five home runs and 23 RBIs. Johnston has reached base at least once in every game, registering 15 multi-hit contests. His 27-game on-base streak is the longest by a Shrimp hitter since Justin Twine's 27-game run from July 19-August 19, 2018. The last Jacksonville hitter to record a longer such streak was Kenny Wilson, who reached base in 29 straight games from August 5-September 6, 2015.

'PEN PALS

Over the last two-plus weeks, the Jumbo Shrimp have boasted a dominant bullpen. In the 17 games the club has played since August 8, Jacksonville relievers have combined to surrender only 25 runs, 21 earned, on 49 hits (7.7 H/9) in 57.1 innings for a 3.30 ERA. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to strike out 79 batters (12.4 K/9) against 34 walks (5.3 BB/9).

HIGH FIVE!

Jacksonville posted just two runs offensively on Saturday at Columbus, but the club has still tallied at least five runs in 15 of the last 23 games. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp rank second in the IL in hits (229) while placing third in batting average (.286), fourth in OBP (.377), seventh in doubles (43) and eighth in both runs scored (133, 5.8 per game) and OPS (.818). Jacksonville was hitting just .256/.341/.417/.758 with 525 runs scored in 101 games (5.2 per game) as a team prior to this run.

OPPORTUNITIES WASTED

After winning the opening contest of a two-week, 12-game road trip on Tuesday 11-5 at Lehigh Valley, Jacksonville woke up in a tie for third place, only a half-game out of first. The Jumbo Shrimp have gone on to drop seven of their next 10 contests on this current trek to fall to back into 10th place in the IL second-half standings, 3.5 games out of first place. Of those seven losses, five have come by three runs or fewer, including three by one run. Following Sunday's series finale at Columbus, Jacksonville has perhaps their best remaining chance to gain ground in the standings: a six-game series against Charlotte at home. The Knights are an extraordinary 11-39 (.220) in the second half of the season.

JERARSSIC PARK

Jacksonville outfielder Jerar Encarnacion endured a terrible slump in the middle of the season. In 46 games from May 16-July 14, the native of Bayaguna in the Dominican Republic went just 23-for-163 (.141/.258/.380/.638) at the plate with just one double, one triple, 12 home runs, 19 RBIs and 24 walks (12.6 BB%). Encarnacion struck out a remarkable 80 times, a rate of 42.1 percent over his 190 plate appearances. In his last 24 games, however, the 26-year-old is 22-for-80 (.275/.404/.513/.917) with four doubles, five home runs, 17 RBIs and 18 walks (18.9 BB%). Encarnacion has trimmed his strikeout rate to 34.3 percent (34 in 99 PA) during this recent hot stretch.

MEN OF STEAL

While Jacksonville ranks just 11th in the 20-team International League in stolen bases with 106, the club has been exceptional in their efficiency at swiping bags. The Jumbo Shrimp have been successful on stealing a base at 82.2 percent of their attempts, a figure that ranks fifth in Triple-A. Over their last 11 games dating back to August 14, Jacksonville base runners have been successful on 10 of 12 stolen base attempts (83.3 percent).

SHRIMP BITES

Saturday's contest was Jacksonville's sixth game this season without issuing a walk, and their first since June 24 at Gwinnett... The Shrimp have made 11 errors over their last nine games, tied for the most in Triple-A. However, they also lead the level with 13 double plays during that span.

--Had committed to Vanderbilt University prior to signing with the Padres, who selected him with the seventh overall pick in the 2018 draft.

--Named the Tennessee Gatorade National Baseball Player of the Year in 2018 after posting a 0.09 ERA and going 11-0 with 148 strikeouts in 76 innings.

--Led MLB in pickoffs (9) in 2021, the most in a single season since Eric Lauer (10) in 2018. The Padres own three of the highest single-season pickoff totals since 2016: Clayton Richards (8, '17), Weathers (9, '21) and Lauer (10, '18).

2023 SEASON

--Traded from San Diego to Miami on August 1 in exchange for first baseman Garrett Cooper & right-handed pitcher Sean Reynolds.

2022 SEASON

--Set career high in appearances with El Paso (31) and IP (123.0).

2021 SEASON

--Posted a 6.38 ERA in 18 starts but made 12 appearances out of the bullpen, where he posted a 2.49 ERA.

2020 SEASON

--Spent the campaign at the club's alternate training site before being added to the Padres' NLDS roster.

--Made his major league debut in Game 1 of the NLDS vs. Dodgers, becoming the second pitcher and sixth player to make his debut in the postseason (Shane McClellan, Alex Kirilloff, Adalberto Mondesi, Mark Kiger and Bug Holliday).
