### SIX-RUN SOUNDS FOURTH SINKS SHRIMP

Austin Allen homered and drove in three, but a six-run Nashville fourth inning upended Jacksonville in an 8-5 contest. The game was scoreless until the bottom of the fourth, when the Sounds exploded for six runs. Allen homered in the fifth inning to get the Jumbo Shrimp on the board. Nashville, though, got the run back on a Darin Ruf RBI single in the bottom of the fifth. Allen singled in two more runs in a three-run sixth and the Jumbo Shrimp added another tally in the eighth. However, a Sounds run in the eighth set the margin at 8-5.

### THE EAGLE HAS LANDED IS STRANDED

Jacksonville has stranded 38 runners on-base in 36 offensive innings thus far in their series in Nashville, going just 9-for-38 (.237) with runners in scoring position during these four games and exacerbating a huge issue of late for the club. Over the last 25 games, the Jumbo Shrimp have stranded 180 runners, an average of 7.2 per game, mainly by hitting a woeful 42-for-201 (.209) with runners in scoring position. Jacksonville has had multiple hits with runners in scoring position in just 11 of these 25 games, with more than two hits over these situations in only seven affairs of this stretch.

### ODDS & ENDS ON 2023

After five straight losing seasons from 2015-2019, Jacksonville earned consecutive winning campaigns in 2021 and 2022. However, with three games remaining in the 2023 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are sitting at a 70-77 (.476) record, unable to record its third straight winning season. The Jumbo Shrimp also finished the 2023 home slate with a 35-39 (.473) record. The last time Jacksonville suffered a losing home record was in 2018, when they went 27-41 (.397).

### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

From Opening Day through August 15, 61 of Jacksonville's 114 games (53.5 percent) were decided by three runs or fewer. However, in the 33 games since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have played 23 affairs (69.7 percent) determined by no more three runs. Over these last 33 games, Jacksonville has posted a 9-14 (.391) record in these narrowly decided affairs. In comparison, through August 15, the Shrimp were 30-31 (.492) in contests decided by three runs or fewer.

#### PEN PAIS

Over the last month-plus, the Jumbo Shrimp have boasted a dominant bullpen. In the 39 games the club has played since August 8. Jacksonville relievers have combined to surrender only 69 runs. 58 earned. on 128 hits (8.0 H/9) in 143.2 innings for a 3.63 ERA. During this stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp relief corps has combined to strike out 163 batters (10.2 K/9) against 90 walks (5.6 BB/9).

### **BROKEN BATS**

Since beginning a series with Charlotte on August 29, the Jumbo Shrimp offense has been mired in a massive slump. Jacksonville has scored three runs or fewer in 14 of their last 22 games. Moreover, the club has mustered a meager .212/.312/.309/.621 batting line as a team, figures that respectively rank 29th, 28th, 29th and 30th in Triple-A during this stretch. Not coincidentally, the Jumbo Shrimp's 72 runs (3.3 per game) also rank last in Triple-A during this span. Despite getting outscored 86-72. Jacksonville has posted a 10-12 record during this stretch. Eight of those 10 victories have been decided by three runs or fewer

### ROAD RAGE

From 2015-19, Jacksonville failed to post a winning record on the road in any campaign, going a combined 137-210 (.395). However, upon joining the Triple-A level in 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp's road fortunes rapidly improved. In 2021 and 2022, the club posted a combined mark of 81-58 (.583) on the road. However, in 2023, Jacksonville has registered a 35-38 (.479) mark away from 121 Financial Ballpark. Interestingly, while the club has posted nearly identical OPS' at home (.749) vs. on the road (.752) in 2023, the Jumbo Shrimp have pitched much better at home. At home, Jacksonville has allowed the fifth-fewest runs (365) in the IL with a 4.56 ERA. On the road, the club has ceded the second-most runs (442) in the league with a 5.71 ERA.

### SHRIMP BITES

at Nashville

Jordan Groshans has reached base in 14 of his last 20 plate appearances, going 7-for-13 with five RBIs and seven walks over the last four games... Rvan Weathers has not allowed a run over his last three starts, a total of 17.0 innings. During this stretch he has ceded just nine hits (.155 BAA) with 17 strikeouts against nine walks.

### **ABOUT RYAN**

-Had committed to Vanderbilt University prior to signing with the Padres, who selected him with the seventh overall pick in the 2018 draft.

-Named the Tennessee Gatorade National Baseball Player of the Year in 2018 after posting a 0.09 ERA and going 11-0 with 148 strikeouts in 76 innings.

-Led MLB in pickoffs (9) in 2021, the most in a single season since Eric Lauer (10) in 2018. The Padres own three of the highest single-season pickoff totals since 2016: Clayton Richards (8, '17), Weathers (9, '21) and Lauer (10, '18).

### **2023 SEASON**

-Traded from San Diego to Miami on August 1 in exchange for first baseman Garrett Cooper & right-handed pitcher Sean Reynolds.

### **2022 SEASON**

-Set career high in appearances with El Paso (31) and IP (123.0).

### 2021 SEASON

-Posted a 6.38 ERA in 18 starts but made 12 appearances out of the bullpen, where he posted a 2.49 ERA.

### **2020 SEASON**

-Spent the campaign at the club's alternate training site before being added to the Padres' NLDS roster.

-Made his major league debut in Game 1 of the NLDS vs. Dodgers, becoming the second pitcher and sixth player to make his debut in the postseason (Shane McClanahan, Alex Kirilloff, Adalberto Mondesi, Mark Kiger and Bug Holliday).

### **2019 SEASON**

-Made 22 starts for the TinCaps, striking out 22.8% of hitters while walking just 4.6%

-He allowed two ER or less in each of his first seven starts, posting a 1.78 ERA (6 ER in 30.1 IP) from April 4 - May 26.

-Son of former MLB pitcher David Weathers.
