Tonight's Game: The Sounds and Bulls play game three of the six-game series tonight at First Horizon Park. With a 9-4 victory last night, Nashville evens the current series at one and the season series with Durham at four games each. Left-hander DL Hall will be on the bump in a rehab start for Nashville. He will up against right-hander Shane Baz for Durham.

DL Hall: The 25-year-old left-hander will make his fourth rehab start with the Sounds this season. He is 0-0 with a 4.91 ERA (3.2 IP/2 ER) and three strikeouts. In his last outing at Gwinnett on June 16, he went 2.0 innings for the first time since April 20 at St. Louis. His 28 pitches was also the most in any of his rehab starts. In four starts with the Brewers before his injury, Hall was 0-1 with a 7.71 ERA (16.1 IP/14 ER) and a 13/10 K/BB ratio. He was traded in a package along with Joey Ortiz for Corbin Burnes in the offseason. He entered the season as the fifth-best prospect in the Brewers organization according to Baseball America. He made his MLB debut on August 13, 2023 for the Orioles and was charged with the loss in a 3.2 inning, five earned run effort at Tampa Bay. He was drafted in the first round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Orioles from Valdosta High School in Valdosta, Georgia. He was selected to the Futures Game in 2019 and was a MiLB.com Organization All-Star for the Orioles in 2022.

Shane Baz: The 25-year-old right-hander will make his ninth start for the Bulls this season. He is 2-3 with a 4.60 ERA (31.1 IP/16 ER) and 31 strikeouts. In his last outing versus Charlotte on June 16, he went a season-high 6.0 innings and allowed one earned run. Baz has been great in his three starts in June, starting 2-0 with a 1.20 ERA (15.0 IP/2 ER) and 22 strikeouts. His 18 strikeouts in his last two starts is the most in a two-game span since he also had 18 total on May 22 & 28, 2021 while pitching for Montgomery. He did not pitch during the 2023 season after having Tommy John surgery. He had previously been ranked as the no. 1 prospect for the Rays according to Baseball America. The former highly regarded prospect was drafted 12th overall by the Pirates in the 2017 First-Year Player draft after previously committing to Texas Christian University. He was acquired by the Rays as the player to be named in the 2018 Chris Archer trade.

Kachow!: Nashville set a season-high with five stolen bases in last night's game. Their previous best was four which they accomplished three times with the last occurring on June 13 at Gwinnett. Garrett Mitchell's two steals also ties the most for a Sounds player in a game that has been done on five other occurrences. Nashville is fourth in the International League with 89 steals on the season with Brewer Hicklen leading the pack with 20. But the team is also tied with Worcester for the most caught stealings in the IL with 29.

In a Jam: Ryan Middendorf picked up his his third save of the season with a 1.2 inning scoreless outing last night. In six outings in June, Middendorf has a 1.13 ERA (8.0 IP/1 ER) and six strikeouts. He entered the game with the bases juiced and induced an inning-ending double play to get out of the jam. His 23 inherited runners on the season ranks third in all of Triple-A.

Franky: Francisco Mejia picked up his second three-hit game last night with his first also occurring in June versus Louisville. In June, Mejia is hitting .349 (15-for-43) with seven runs scored, two doubles, two home runs and ten RBI. His .955 OPS and 23 total bases are both good for third on the team this month.

Stretching it Out: Taylor Clarke went 4.2 innings, allowing two earned runs on 92 pitches (59 strikes) in last night's win. His previous season high in innings was 4.1 and 78 pitches on June 7 against Louisville. Clarke has seen a steady increase in pitch count from under 40 in his first four starts to averaging 70 in his last four starts. The last time he threw at least 92 pitches in a start was on July 30, 2019 versus the Yankees while pitching for the Diamondbacks (95 pitches).

Issac and Clarke: With a two-RBI triple last night, Collins extends his team lead with 113 total bases and 46 RBI. In June, Collins is hitting .354 (17-for-48) with 16 RBI and a 1.031 OPS. His 16 RBI is tied for fifth in the International League this month. With a double last night, Wes Clarke extends his hitting streak to 12 games. The only other Sounds player to have a 10-game hitting streak was Owen Miller. The longest on-base streak by a Nashville player this season was Isaac Collins from May 10-30.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 719-618 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,311-2,138 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.

LAST OUTING: Hall went two scoreless innings with just one batter reaching base at Gwinnett on June 16. It was his third rehab appearance with Nashville.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Hall pitched against Durham four times (two starts) in 2022 and 2023 while with Norfolk. His most recent outing came on August 23 where he pitched a scoreless inning with two walks and three strikeouts. In his two starts on June 22, 2022 and May 4, 2023, Hall went a combined 6.0 innings, allowing five hits, one earned run with 10 strikeouts.

2024 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Started the season of the Opening Day roster
- Went 0-1, with a 7.71 ERA (16.1 IP/14 ER) in four starts in March and April before being placed on the 15-day injured list on April 21 due to a left knee sprain
