TODAY marks game #35 of the 2023 season, the second game of a six-game roadtrip, and the second game of a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons. These two teams played 17 times during the 2022 regular season, with the Whitecaps winning the series 9-8. The Whitecaps are a Detroit Tigers affiliate in their 29th season in professional baseball, while Great Lakes is in their 16th year of affiliation with the Los Angeles Dodgers. The last playoff meeting with Great Lakes came in the 2018 Midwest League Eastern Division Quarterfinals, with the Whitecaps sweeping a two-game series.

UP NEXT: The 'Caps come back to West Michigan for a six-game series against the Lake County Captains (Cleveland Guardians affiliate from May 23-28 at LMCU Ballpark before heading to Day Air Ballpark in Dayton, Ohio for a six-game series against the Dragons (Cincinnati Reds affiliate) from May 30-June 4.

### STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

**LAST TIME OUT:** The West Michigan Whitecaps erased a five-run deficit and rallied for an 11-10 victory over the Great Lakes Loons in front of a franchise-record 6,906 fans at Dow Diamond on Tuesday afternoon. The victory vaults West Michigan into a first-place tie with Great Lakes at 21-13 while also giving manager Brayán Peña his 151st career managerial victory – passing former one-time 'Caps skipper Phil Regan for fifth place on the Whitecaps all-time wins list. As Tuesday's contest unfolded, the Whitecaps fell into a steep early hole. After an Eliezer Alfonzo RBI-single in the first inning, Great Lakes scored the subsequent six runs, highlighted by back-to-back home runs from the Loons Damon Keith and Griffin Lockwood-Powell in the third to bring the score to 6-1 after three innings. In the fourth, Austin Murr blasted his second homer of the season, a two-run home run to kickstart the Whitecaps top-ranked Midwest League offense. An inning later, Izaac Pacheco launched a solo blast for his fifth home run before a game-tying two-run double by Danny Serretti knotted the contest at six. In the sixth, Roberto Campos blasted a go-ahead two-run home run, his fourth of the 2023 campaign, before the Loons answered with three runs in the bottom of the frame. A two-run homer from Chris Alayne helped Great Lakes take another lead – this time by a score of 9-8 after six innings. In the eighth, the 'Caps pulled ahead for good thanks to a three-run outburst. Justice Bigbie, named Midwest League Player of the Week on Monday, delivered a game-tying RBI-single before Chris Meyers' broken-bat, two-run single helped West Michigan take the lead at 11-9. In the bottom of the frame, Austin Gauthier, the Midwest League hits leader, blasted a solo home run to trim the 'Caps edge to 11-10 before reliever Blake Holub retired the next three hitters to end the threat. In the ninth, a pair of two-out singles placed the potential tying run at third base before West Michigan pitcher Trevin Michael struck out Ismael Alcántara to end the ballgame and put the 'Caps in a first-place tie atop the Midwest League Eastern Division. The 'Caps and Loons each end Tuesday holding identical records of 21-13, with West Michigan currently holding the tiebreaker. Whitecaps reliever Chavez Fernandez (2-0) picks up his second win for tossing 1.2 scoreless frames out of the bullpen, while Loons pitcher Christian Suarez (0-2) suffers his second loss. Michael tossed a scoreless ninth to collect his first save in a Whitecaps uniform. Campos led the offense on Tuesday, reaching base three times with a double, home run, walk, two RBI, and three runs scored in the victory.

**JUSTICE BEING SERVED:** After going 13-for-20 in a series in Mid-May against the Lansing Lugnuts, Whitecaps OF Justice Bigbie collected his first-ever Midwest league Player of the Week award. Bigbie tallied four doubles, three home runs and nine RBI as the 'Caps took 4 out of 6 games with the 'Nuts from May 9-14 at LMCU Ballpark.

**ENTERING ELITE COMPANY:** With a 11-10 victory over the Great Lakes Loons on May 16, Whitecaps Manager Brayán Peña collected his 151st victory to pass former West Michigan and one-time Baltimore Orioles manager Phil Regan for 5th place on the all-time 'Caps wins list by a manager.

**LEADING THE PACK:** The Whitecaps enter today's game leading the Midwest League in numerous offensive categories, including team batting average (.264), slugging (.440), OPS (.788), runs scored (180), doubles (70), RBI (164), and homers (36). They also have the fewest team strikeouts at 252. On the mound, they feature the lowest team ERA (3.42) in the MWL.

**DIFFERENT STRENGTHS:** The Whitecaps have stolen just 8 bases this season, the fewest in MiLB. The next closest teams are Triple-A Albuquerque & Reno with 19.

**BRINGING THE PENA:** On May 4, Whitecaps pitcher Carlos Pena was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Month for April. The 24-year-old pitched to a 0.47 ERA in five starts, covering 19.1 innings in the first month of the season, as he allowed one earned run and held opponents to a .200 average. Pena struck out 26 batters and was unscathed upon in his first nine innings and his last nine innings of the month. Pena, 24, was signed by Detroit as an international free agent out of Santiago, DR, on March 6, 2019.

**CROUCHING TIGER, HIDDEN WHITECAP:** The Whitecaps received a boost when they received their 2022 captain from the Double-A Erie Seawolves, as catcher Josh Crouch rejoined the club on May 2. Crouch returns to West Michigan after being named a Postseason All-Star as a member of the Whitecaps in 2022. The 24-year-old was named the Best Defensive Catcher in the Midwest League in a vote among league managers for Baseball America. The Floridian hit .290-10-61 RBI in just 90 2022 games with the 'Caps.

**PROSPECTS APLENTY:** The Whitecaps hold seven of the Top 30 Detroit Tigers prospects. Players include those mentioned near the top right corner of this page.

**HEALTH REPORT:** The 'Caps IL holds four players in pitchers Jackson Jobe, Tanner Kohlhepp, and Matt Walker, and catcher Eduardo Valencia.

Hernandez is back in West Michigan for the first time in nearly four calendar years -- having last pitched for West Michigan at the end of their run as a Tigers Low-A affiliate in 2019. Hernandez then underwent Tommy John surgery in the canceled COVID-19 season in 2020 and returned to Low-A Lakeland in 2022. Hernandez was once rated the Tigers No. 20 prospect in 2018 by Baseball America.

**LAST START:** Hernandez gave up two runs and walked four hitters without walking a batter while tossing five innings as the Whitecaps fell to the Lansing Lugnuts by a score of 4-2 on May 11 at LMCU Ballpark.

**2022:** Hernandez posted a respectable 3-5 record with Lakeland and a 4.50 ERA in 14 games and 44 innings. His best month came in May when he collected a 1.23 ERA in five starts and 14.2 IP and just two walks to 23 strikeouts.

**2021:** Missed the season (injury).**2020:** COVID-19 Canceled MiLB Season

**2019:** Hernandez enjoyed his best professional season, going 9-7 with a 3.73 ERA in 21 games and 101.1 innings pitched, allowing 97 hits and walking 26 with 90 strikeouts.

**2018:** Hernandez began his 2018 campaign in Connecticut with the short-season New York-Penn League and got hit hard, taking the loss in the only two games he pitched and posting a 7.94 ERA. Despite the numbers, Hernandez struck out nearly two batters per inning with 11 punchouts in 5.2 frames. Upon his arrival in West Michigan, Hernandez stayed competitive but watched his record fall to 2-5.

**2017:** Hernandez started and relieved with the Los Angeles Angels player development staff and went 4-1 with a 2.64 ERA in 12 games (7 starts). In 44.1 innings between the Arizona Rookie-League Angels and Orem Owls (where he pitched in the same rotation as Whitecaps pitcher Elvin Rodriguez), he allowed just 25 hits in 44.1 IP and gave up 22 walks with 44 strikeouts and permitted opponents a .164 batting average against.

**2016:** At just 16 years old, Hernandez pitched well in five starts out of the Dominican Summer League, going 2-0 with a 1.20 ERA and allowed 12 hits in 15 frames on six walks and 14 strikeouts.
