SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

<u>O'RAE'S ON A RUN</u>: Entering today, **2B/OF Dylan O'Rae** leads the Shuckers with 19 stolen bases in 38 games since being promoted to Double-A on June 18... Since being promoted, O'Rae ranks 2nd in Double-A with 19 stolen bases and is 1 of 9 Double-A players with at least 15 over that span.

O'Rae is 1 stolen base away from becoming the 14th player in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015) to record 20 stolen bases in a season... 3B Tyler Black (47), OF Jackson Chourio (43) and INF/OF Isaac Collins (29) all reached the 20-steal mark during the 2023 season.

LAM IRONMAN: 3B Brock Wilken is set to appear in his 73rd consecutive game for the BLX Most Consec. Games Played (since '18)
Shuckers, having appeared in every game since he returned from the 7-Day Injured List 1. Troy Stokes Jr. (18) 79 on May 7, 2024... Wilken is the first Shuckers player to play in at least 70 consecutive 2. Brock Wilken (24) 51 games since 0F Troy Stokes Jr. appeared in 79 consecutive games between May 4 and 4. Cam Devanney (122) 49 August 3, 2018... The streak is the second-longest by a Shuckers player since 2018 and 5.2 Tied 40 the third of at least 50 games since 2018.

BOWMAN'S STAR-STUDDED YEAR: With 2.2 scoreless innings on Wednesday, RHP Kaleb Bomwan lowered his ERA to 2.44 on the season over 29 appearances, the 10th-lowest in the Southern League among pitchers with at least 25 Entering today, Bowman has a 6.0% walk rate this season, 1 of 30 Double-A pitchers with a walk-rate of 6.0% or lower with a

9 pitchers in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015) have recorded a walk-rate of 6.0% or lower while throwing at least 50.0 innings in a season... RHP James Meeker (3.2%, 2023) and RHP Jesús Castillo (3.2%, 2021) are the only 2 pitchers to accomplish the feat since 2021.

Entering today, the Shuckers are among the Double-A batting leaders in the half in runs (1st, 195), walks (2nd, 154) and on-base percentage (6th, .341)... The Shuckers are among the second-half pitching leaders in strikeouts (2nd, 356), opponent's average (4th, .217) and ERA (6th, 3.53).

FIVE'S THE MAGIC NUMBER: Entering today, the Shuckers are 36-8 when they score at least five runs in a game, an .818 winning percentage... The Shuckers have won 24 of their last 29 games since June 1 when they've scored at least five runs, including wins in 20 of their last 23... The Shuckers have scored at least five runs in 29 of their last 52 games.

<u>ODDS ARE IT'S A CLOSE ONE</u>: Entering today, 52 of the Shuckers' 102 games have been decided by 2 runs or less, including 32 one-run games... In those 52 games, the Shuckers are 27-25, a .519 win percentage... In the second half, 15 of the Shuckers' 35 games have been decided by 2 or less, with the Shuckers going 10-5.
