Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Rorik Maltrud** to the mound tonight, looking to avoid their first 3G losing streak since 6/10-6/12 at Indianapolis. The Indians will counter with RHP **Jose Urquidy**. Columbus is 40-25 (.615) versus right handers this year. Urquidy has pitched against the Clippers once in his career, picking up the win at Victory Field on 6/10 (5.0IP, 2H, 1R, 1ER, 1BB, 5K).

vs. the Indians

Columbus is 7-5 against Indianapolis this year, posting a -5 run margin (9-9, +13 in 2025; 12-5, +45 in 2024; 10-8, -23 in 2023; 12-8, +53 in 2022). Since the start of the 2022 season, the Clippers are 18-9 (.667) in games against Indianapolis that are decided by at least five. Individually, **Bo Naylor** has 4HR and 17RBI in 21G against Indy and **Cooper Ingle** is 15x52 (.288) with 3HR, 9RBI in 15G.

Outliers

The Clippers reached 50 wins last week, having done so with negative differentials in runs (-14; of eight teams with at least 48 wins, only team in the red, all others at least +28 and averaging +52), hits (-7; other seven teams average +40) and homers (-2; other seven at +22). Last Friday's victory saw Columbus allow 12 hits, marking the 16th win when the opponents reach double digits (16-17, .485, 1st in IL).

Ingle is Back

Cooper Ingle's two week stint in the Majors (.095/.208/.095 in 7G) dropped him below qualification for rate statistics in the IL this year (debuted as the leader on 6/7). Including a 4x4 (3HR) game on 6/18 vs. Scranton/WB, he has slumped to a line of .236/.317/.491 in his last 26G with Columbus. At catcher, Ingle has a 1.293OPS (11HR) in 31G (.597OPS and 2HR in 22G between DH and LF).

Martinez Rehab

Angel Martinez is joining the Clippers on rehab tonight, working his way back from a fractured left foot (out since 6/16). Martinez hit .239/.276/.442 with 11HR and 33RBI in 66G with Cleveland this season, but was just 14x78 (.179) over his last 21G before injury. This will mark his second rehab stint with Columbus (4/9-4/17/24 for a bruised right foot, fractured his left wrist during the assignment).

Angel Ascendant

Angel Genao has a 1.148OPS in the last 21G, batting .421 (32x76) while drawing 16BB in 95PA (17%) over that time (11BB in 139PA, 8%, in first 35G with Columbus). Genao has 20 runs in those 21G, collecting 13RBI and 10XBH (.632SLG). Among IL hitters with at least 35PA from the 7th inning on, Genao has the 2nd best OPS (1.204; 1st- **Travis Bazzana**, 11th- **Cooper Ingle**, 13th- **Kody Huff**).

More Ralphy

Prior to heading off for the All-Star Futures Game (1x4, RBI), **Ralphy Velazquez** extended his career best on base streak to 30G (.383OBP since 6/3; hits in 15 of last 17; .318, 21x66). His streak is the 3rd longest in the IL and, since its start, he has watched his OBP balloon by 79 points, his average jump 66 points and his SLG climb 137 points (6XBH in first 8G, 1XBH in middle 16G, 4XBH in last 6G).

Stepping Up

Alfonsin Rosario is set to make his Triple-A debut tonight (300th career game, played 99G in Double-A), bringing with him 53HR and 50SB in his minor league career. Beginning with consecutive multi-hit games to end May, Rosario hit .331/.399/.676 in his last 36G with Akron, collecting 10HR and 35RBI (led EL in SLG and RBI over that stretch). Among Cleveland minor leaguers, his 16HR ranks 2nd.

Roughing It

Since doubling twice on 6/25 at Omaha, **George Valera** is hitting .103 (5x49, all singles), while scoring twice and driving in a pair over his last 13G. He has drawn only 6BB during the slump (3BB on 7/5) against 12K in 55PA. Valera has not homered since 5/19 vs. Louisville (99AB since) and has just 2HR in his last 45G (161AB, .298SLG). Additionally, he has no multi-RBI games since 5/30 (24G).

Rare Company

Dating to the nightcap vs. Scranton/WB on 6/19, **Milan Tolentino** is 21x61 (.344) in his last 19G, collecting 11XBH (.639SLG) and 13RBI (was 5x39, .128, in 13G prior). Over his last 12G, Tolentino has drawn 12BB to only 8K (51PA; had 8BB and 42K in previous 33G, 114PA). He played in his 200th game as a Clipper last Thursday and is one of five with at least 30HR and 30SB (only two are 40-40).

This Date in Clipper History

7/17/1985

The Clippers edged out the Richmond Braves by a score of 5-4. **Henry Cotto** led the Clipper attack, going 3x3 with 3 runs and 3RBI. He homered twice and tripled in the game. The 1985 Clippers made it to the Governors' Cup Championship, despite posting a winning percentage of only .540 (75-64). They were swept by the Tidewater Tides 3-0, but would get revenge in the '87 GC Finals, beating the Tides 3-1.

First Half Wrap

Despite being eliminated from playoff contention on the penultimate Sunday of the first half, the Clippers were 41-33 and finished with their first winning record in the front half since the season was split in 2023 (averaged 32 wins from 2023-25, topping out at 34-38, .472, last season). From 4/22-6/17, they spent every day between 3.0 and 6.0 games off the lead, while occupying anywhere between 4th and 13th in the standings. A late push (15-6 from 5/16-6/9) got them to within 2.5 before derailing with a 3G losing streak at Indy to seal their fate. On the back half, Columbus has posted just one winning record, clinching a playoff berth in 2024 with a mark of 48-26 (.649).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,453 to 1,400).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 136-110 (.553) in pitch reviews, with batters going 70-71 (.496) and pitchers/catchers going 66-39 (.629). They have run out of challenges in 39G and have not challenged in 4G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 5-4 in extra innings this year, after having gone .500 in each of the last two seasons. Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 55-37 when playing past regulation (.598, best in the IL; no other team above .571), including 27-17 at home (.614; 5-7 in last 12G). Of the 92G to require extra play, 73 have been resolved after one frame (including nine DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 on 9/20/22 at Toledo).

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to top 800 again (on pace for 811, would rank as 4th most all-time; record is 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 113 through the first 92G (on pace for 183SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 30CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the 2nd most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (49; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

Crazy Eighth's

From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored an IL-best 141 runs while crafting a .915OPS (nearly 100 points better than all other teams). On the flipside, Columbus has given up 74 runs from the 8th on, resulting in a +67 run differential (Clippers are getting outscored 216-137 from innings 5-7).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 79 grand slams and 1,960RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.31 through the first 92G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 181HR (average of 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 7th in the IL this year (.980), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 50G this season (30-20, .600), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Good Baseball

CJ Kayfus bunted a runner into scoring position with a single on 7/5 vs. Louisville, with that runner kicking off a 5-run inning that led the Clippers to victory. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 90-23 (.796) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 7-2 mark this season (.778, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers have the most last at bat wins this year (14, tied with Syracuse) while playing in the most games decided in the last at bat (25). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 98G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 48-50 (.490, 14th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 436-448 (.493), 406-402 with Columbus (.502).

June Swoon:

In 5G of June (17.1IP), Maltud gave up 15ER (23.0IP, 7ER in May; 27.2IP, 8ER in March/April). Of the runs allowed, 3ER came in an inning vs. Omaha on 6/2, as a result of three infield singles.

Undecided:

Among 58 pitchers in the IL with at least 11GS, Maltud is the only one that has yet to take a loss and his troika of wins makes him one of two starters with just three decisions (had one in his first 13GS). Despite a 3.75ERA as a starter and run support of 6.1 per game, Maltud has left with the lead only six times because the offense is averaging only 2.5 runs while he is the pitcher of record, including 9G with two runs or fewer (4G with zero runs).

Efficiency is Key:

Through 80 innings started in 17G, Maltud has retired the side with fewer than 10 pitches on 12 occasions, including a 4-pitch inning on 4/3 vs. Indianapolis, while turning in 16 innings of more than 20. He has hit 30+ thrice, thanks to an 11-pitch battle vs. Iowa's **Pedro Ramirez** on 4/17 (walk, 34 in the inning) and a 14-pitch skirmish with Buffalo's **Yohendrick Pinango** on 4/23 (groundout, 30 total). He ranks 3rd in the IL with 15.3 pitches per inning.

Among the Leader Beans:

Entering today's game, Maltud is 6th in the IL with a 3.87ERA (nearly half a run better than all other Clipper starters with at least 10GS). From his quality start win on 4/11 at Worcester through his quality start on 5/25 at Toledo, he crafted the 2nd best ERA in the IL, at 2.14ERA (42.0IP, 10ER). Additionally, Maltud's 0.95WHIP in that time ranked 2nd best (1.24WHIP on the season places 4th).

Pitch to Contact:

Maltud's Triple-A debut on 3/28 at Iowa was the 44th game of his career and marked his 37th consecutive start (reached 41GS before relief appearance on 4/30 vs. Toledo, all 6G in relief have come on starter's rest and been at least 3.0IP). He did not punch out any Cubs in that game (15BF), marking his second straight game without a strikeout (37BFwith 0K from, 9/10/25-4/3/26; had at least 1K in all 42G prior). Among 115 pitchers in the IL that have at least 180BF this year, Maltud has the 21st best walk rate (7.6%; 25BB to 331BF) and the 56th best strikeout rate (21.5%, 71K; had worst rate, 11.9%, prior to 59K in last 12G).

In Relief:

Maltud has pitched twice in relief this season (previous 5G out of the bullpen came among first 7G as a pro), piggybacking **Trenton Denholm** on 4/30 vs. Toledo (3.0IP, 40 pitches) and **Daniel Espino** on 6/2 vs. Omaha (4.0IP, 81 pitches). He has registered a 5.14ERA out of the bullpen (7.0IP, 11H, 4R, 4ER, 2BB, 13K),
