LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox were walked-off for the third time this season Saturday night, as they fell to the Harrisburg Senators by a 3-2 final. Harrisburg's Jackson Cluff got the scoring started with a two-run home run in the bottom of the second inning of Bowie starter Chayce McDermott, who struggled with consistent command throughout his night. McDermott's outing was limited to four innings, but he did strand the bases loaded in the fourth to keep the Senators damage limited to just the two runs. Offensively, Bowie would answer with a Noelberth Romero solo home run in the top of the third, before Mark Kolozsvary and John Rhodes combined for back-to-back doubles in the sixth, with Rhodes driving in Kolozsvary to tie the game at two. The score would remain until the bottom of the tenth, where, with two outs, Harrisburg's Yasel Antuna hit a ground ball to third baseman Coby Mayo, who delivered a low throw to first that got by first baseman Heston Kjerstad, allowing Cluff, the courtesy runner, to score from second and win the game for the Senators.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Harrisburg Senators enter this afternoon at a record of 15-16. The Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, the Senators currently occupy 5th place in the Southwest division, but are just a game-and-a-half out of first place. Harrisburg has a .208 team average and has hit the fewest home runs (19) of any team in the Eastern League, but has also allowed the second-fewest (20) to go along with a 4.02 staff ERA. The Senators' roster is highlighted by the No. 2 Nationals prospect and No. 30 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, Robert Hassell III, who recently returned from the injured list. He is one of five Top 30 Nationals prospects on the Harrisburg roster, including right-handed pitchers Jackson Rutledge (No. 11 WSH) and Gerrardo Carrillo (No. 28 WSH), along with left-hander Mitchell Parker (No. 24 WSH) and catcher Drew Millas (No. 30 WSH). The Senators are led by first-year manager Delino DeShields, who has prior coaching and management experience through the various levels of the Reds' organization, in addition to be a former player for the Orioles' organization and playing for the Baysox in 1999

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

The Senators look to send out right-hander Jackson Rutledge for the series finale. The No. 11 prospect in the Nationals' system, Rutledge threw six, one-run innings on Tuesday night against the Baysox, allowing five hits, but striking out five as well. Rutledge has gone six innings and thrown over 80 pitches in each of his past four starts, allowing just a single run in his last 12 innings of work. Last season, Rutledge spent his time exclusively with Single-A Fredericksburg after seeing his development stymied by shoulder and blister injuries in 2021. He pitched to a 4.90 ERA through 97.1 innings as a starter, allowing 106 hits to 99 strikeouts, particularly struggling against right-handed hitters, who batted .311 against him. Rutledge was the 17th overall pick by the Nationals in the 2019 draft out of San Jacinto JC. His arsenal features a 2-seam and 4-seam fastball in the mid-90s, alongside a mid-80s slider, upper-80s changeup, in addition to a curveball.

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with his 46 hits and a .405 batting average - 76 points above the next-highest qualified average and second in all of MiLB. Prieto is currently riding a 10-game hitting streak, while registering multiple hits in his past seven starts. Prieto now has 15 multi-hit contests in his first 29 games of 2023. Prieto has shown recent pop as well, with six extra-base hits in his past six games, increasing his slugging percentage (.569) to fourth in the league and his OPS (1.017) to fifth, with an on-base percentage (.448) already second in the league. Prieto already put together an 11-game hitting streak last month, which stands as the second-longest in the Eastern League this season and is also the longest streak for any Orioles minor leaguer. Prieto's leads the Baltimore farm in both average and hits as well.

FINISHING WHAT THEY STARTED

Bowie has had its opportunities this week to drive in runs against Harrisburg. The Baysox have out hit the Senators in all five games of the series thus far (45-29 overall). However, Bowie has hit just .130 (o-for-46) with runners in scoring position this week. The Baysox sit with the fourth highest overall batting average in the Eastern League at .236, but have the third-worst average with runners in scoring position. (.214)

IF I HAD A NICKEL

The Baysox have been one of the unluckiest teams in baseball for some time now when it comes to their work on the road. Despite a leagueleading ERA in road games (2.89), Bowie sports the worst road record in the league at 4-9. Bowie has had a lengthy history of heartbreak on the road that continued with their walk-off loss last night. Including their current road trip, Bowie has suffered at least one walk-off loss in 10 of their last 11 road trips, a total of 15 walk-off losses since May 13, the most in Minor League Baseball.

COACHING STAFF

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orloles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful learns throughout the Orloles system. Moore led Class-A belianza to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebia were named MLB. Som Allantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial ecord sist at 254-216 (540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orloles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madliyn and Cameron.

Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a briet sith in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.
