JACKSONVILLE TAKES SERIES AGAINST MEMPHIS

Chi Chi González pitched 7.0 innings of one-run ball and Troy Johnston homered to lead the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp to an 11-2 win in Tuesday's series opener against the Norfolk Tides at 121 Financial Ballpark. After taking a 3-0 lead, Jacksonville added five runs in the bottom of the fourth including Johnston's three-run home run. Leading 9-0 in the sixth inning, Heston Kjerstand (8) hit an inside-the-park home run to make it an eight-run contest. Norfolk added one more in the eighth before Jacksonville tacked on two for an 11-2 win.

X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 51 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 86-for-215 at the plate, slashing .400/.448/.526/.974 with seven doubles, one triple, six home runs, 38 RBIs and 47 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to first in the International League in batting average (.374) and fourth in OBP (.442). Last week, Edwards became just the second player in the IL to tally six hits in a game, going six-for-six with a home run and four runs scored.

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 50 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 51-for-175 (.291/.371/.663/1.034) at the plate with 12 doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, 48 RBIs and 34 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season, Allen is fanning just 20.3 percent of the time in 2023.

GLORY WILL BE YOURS

Troy Johnston has been scorching hot in his return to the Bold City. In 13 games with Jacksonville, Johnston is 22-for-55 (.400/.450/.727/1.177) with seven doubles, one triple, three home runs and 12 RBIs. Johnston has had at least one hit in every game, including eight multi-hit games. Since Johnston's return on 7/25, the Shrimp are 8-5, including a four-game winning streak that began on 8/4. Over this stretch, Johnston is first on the club in total bases (40), extra base hits (11), second in OPS (1.259) and RBIs (12).

MAYOR MANGUM

Jake Mangum went hitless in seven of the eight games he played in from May 31-June 8, going just 1-for-24 at the plate. In the 40 games since that point, Mangum is a sizzling 56-for-160, hitting .350/.403/.481/.884 with 11 doubles, two triples, two home runs, 15 RBIs and 31 runs scored. The Flowood, Miss., native has picked up 16 multi-hit games in his last 26 games, batting 44-for-116 (.379/.425/.517/.942) with eight doubles, one triple, two homers, 11 RBIs and 23 runs scored during this stretch. On the season, among the 237 IL players with at least 150 plate appearances, Mangum has the third-highest opposite field rate (44.7 percent). His 29.5 percent line drive rate is 13th.

ODDS & ENDS

Jacksonville looked like world beaters in a six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9. The Jumbo Shrimp took five out of six games from the Knights - their most wins in a series since 2022 - and outscored Charlotte by a whopping 58-28 margin. However, in the other 27 games of the second half of the season, Jacksonville is 13-14, including a four-game winning streak since August 4. They have a -30 run differential against their other second-half opponents (DUR, WOR, NAS, GWN, MEM & NOR).

REWRITING HISTORY

Xavier Edwards had a historical night Saturday at Memphis. Besides Jacksonville setting team highs in hits (22), Edwards set a new record (since at least 2005) for Jacksonville with six hits in a game, passing Williams Astudillo (5, 8/10/22 vs. DUR). Edwards' four runs scored is also tied for the most in a game with six other former and current Jumbo Shrimp. While Jacksonville has never had a six hit game prior to last night, MLB has seen 108 six-hit games. However, a six-hit game is so rare, there have been almost three times as many no-hitters (321) in the history of baseball.

SHRIMP BITES

After rattling off four straight wins since last Friday, the Jumbo Shrimp are one win shy of tying their longest winning streak (5, 4/7-4/13). They lead the IL in average (.388) with the highest OPS (1.057) over this stretch, and are outscoring their opponents 38-17. The pitching staff has halted traffic on the basepaths with the second-fewest walks issued (10).

ABOUT BRYAN

-In high school, Bryan was selected as a 2014 Under Armour All-American and was rated the 131st-best prospect in the nation by Perfect Game in 2015.

-He was ranked as the fourth-best player in the state of Indiana and the third-best right-handed pitcher as a senior in high school.

-Hoeing was named to All-Tournament Teams at 2014 Perfect Game WWBA 17U National Championship and 2013 Perfect Game WWBA 16u National Championship.

2023 SEASON

-Made first appearance of the season, coming out of the bullpen against Gwinnett. He tossed three innings, allowing just one run on five hits with four punch outs.

2022 SEASON

-Made MLB debut on August 20, 2022 against the Los Angeles Dodgers.

-Hoeing was transferred to Jacksonville on May 3 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, Hoeing was leading the Southern League in both ERA (0.35) and innings pitched (25.2) while ranking second in both batting average against (.211) and WHIP (0.94), tied for fourth in wins (2) and sixth in strikeouts (26).

2021 SEASON

-Hoeing made 22 appearances (22 GS) going 7-6 with a 4.83 ERA in 121.0 innings, he allowed 65 ER and held opponents to a .267 batting average.

-After posting a 7.91 ERA in May (19.1 IP), 6.12 ERA in June (32.1 IP) and 6.29 ERA in July (24.1 IP), Hoeing closed the season strong. In August, he went 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA in four starts (27.0 IP, 16 H, 7 BB, 23 K). In three September starts, the right-hander worked to a 2-0 record and 3.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 19 H, BB, 11 K).

2019 SEASON

-After being drafted in the seventh round of the MLB draft in 2019, Hoeing was sent to the NYPL with the Batavia Muckdogs.

-In nine relief appearances, he tossed 22.1 innings and struck out 17 in his professional debut season

-He tallied his first professional strikeout on 7/18 vs. the Auburn Doubledays.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Originally drafted out of high school by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 32nd round (2015) but elected not to sign.

-Signed with Louisville but also strongly considered North Carolina, Vanderbilt, Indiana and Georgia Tech.
