TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes continue their longest road trip of the year, as they take on the Modesto Nuts (SEA), the two-time defending Cal League Champions, in the second game of a six-game set and game eight of a 12-game, 13-day road trip. The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, June 3rd to face the San Jose Giants. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE NUTS: Today's game is the second of 12 against the Nuts and the second of six at John Thurman Field. In 2024, the Quakes went just 2-10 against the Nuts, 1-5 here in Modesto. In 2023, they went 3-6, just 1-5 here in Modesto. The last time the Quakes won a series here in Modesto was in 2021, when they went 4-2.

LAST GAME: The Quakes raced to an early lead, on their way to an 11-5 victory over the Modesto Nuts on Tuesday night at John Thurman Field. Eduardo had two hits and three RBIs, while Roger Lasso and Gio Cueto each had three hits and an RBI, as Rancho's offense pounded out 14 total hits on the night. Hyun-Seok Jang was sharp over four innings, as he allowed two runs on two hits, but matched a career-best with seven strikeouts and no walks in the no-decision. Myles Caba (3-0) was credited with the win, after allowing one run over 1.1 innings. Modesto starter Harold Melenge (1-3) was saddled with the loss, allowing eight runs (seven earned) on seven hits over just 2.2 innings.

THE BIG Q: Eduardo Quintero has been playing at an MVP-caliber level all year long. He's currently tied for the league lead with eight homers, seventh in the league in both RBIs (31) and on-base percentage (.418). He also leads the league in slugging (.570) and is second in OPS at .988. MLB Pipeline rates him as the Dodgers' eighth-best prospect.

ROSTER MOVES: On Wednesday, the Quakes activated INF Mairo Martinus from the Temporary Inactive List. On Tuesday, C Gio Cueto was activated from the IL and RHP Domingo Geronimo was added from Great Lakes. RHP Michael Vilchez was placed on the Development List, RHP Jholbran Herder and LHP Octavio Becerra were both placed on the IL, while Angel Diaz was sent to the ACL.

SO LONG, MODESTO: 2025 marks the final season of professional baseball in Modesto, CA. In 2026, the franchise rights will be moved to Ontario, CA. The city of Modesto has had professional baseball and has been a member of the California League since 1946. Modesto has won 11 Cal League titles, including the last two (2023-2024). They have played at John Thurman Field since 1955 and have gone by the Nuts, the Athletics, the Red and the Colts.

KEEPING THEM IN CHECK: The two-time defending Cal League Champion Modesto Nuts entered this series with the league's best batting average, but after collecting just five hits on Tuesday, they fell from .271 to .269, second in the league behind Rancho's .272 average, up two points from .270 when they entered the series. The Quakes are still first in the league in homers (39), while San Jose is second with 31 and Modesto is fourth with just 23 in 45 games.

AIDAN FOELLER: Right-hander Aidan Foeller makes his ninth start and tenth appearance, his first appearance against Modesto. In his last outing overall, he allowed three runs on two hits over 4.1 innings, while striking out five and walking four in a no-decision at Stockton on May 22nd. Last year, Foeller got a brief taste of the Cal League, striking out four, without surrendering a hit or run over three scoreless innings for Rancho. Foeller was an 11th-round selection in last year's draft, out of Southern Illinois.

RYAN SLOAN: 19-year-old right-hander Ryan Sloan makes his eighth start of the year and his first against the Quakes. In his last outing overall, he allowed one run on four hits over four innings in a no-decision at Inland Empire on May 21st. Sloan was drafted by the Mariners in the second round, #55 overall in the 2024 draft out of York High School in Elmhurst, IL.
