FRISCO OUTLASTS MIDLAND IN EXTRA INNINGS:

The Frisco RoughRiders took down the Midland RockHounds 3-2 in 10 innings on Friday night from Momentum Bank Ballpark. Frisco (34-26) drew first blood in the top of the first inning when **Josh Hatcher** doubled in **Abimelec Ortiz** to make it 1-0. The RockHounds (35-26) then volleyed back with a Colby Halter RBI single to tie the game in the bottom of the third. With the game still knotted at 1-1 in the eighth, the RoughRiders induced four walks, including a bases-loaded walk from **Jax Biggers** to bring in the go-ahead run. Down to his final out, Henry Bolte blasted a game-tying solo home run in the bottom of the ninth off of **Gavin Collyer** (4-2) to send it into extra innings tied at 2-2. The following inning, **Sebastian Walcott** laced a sacrifice fly into center field to put the Riders up 3-2 against C.D. Pelham (1-2) and **Travis MacGregor** locked down his second save in the bottom of the 10th, securing the win.

POWER OUTAGE:

After homering 15 times in their previous 12 games, the Riders have gone four-straight games without a home run. This is the first time they have gone three-straight games without a home run since May 20th-22nd against Midland. Frisco has hit just one home run in their last five games while averaging 3.2 runs per game and slashing .196/.279/.285/.564. On the positive side, Frisco leads the Texas League with nine doubles over their last five games.

HIGH-LEVEL MATCHUP:

Over the last two seasons, the RockHounds (119) and RoughRiders (118) are the two winningest teams in the Texas League. The RockHounds have won more games than any other Double-A team while the RoughRiders are tied for the second-most wins. Midland's 3.17 ERA as a team over the last two seasons is first in the Texas League and third in Double-A. Since 2021, the RoughRiders are tied with the Arkansas Travelers for the most in the Texas League in wins (320) while Midland is third (314).

MONTHLY HONORS:

On Monday, the Texas Rangers announced that Frisco RoughRiders LHP **Mitch Bratt** earned Starting Pitcher of the Month and infielder/outfielder **Cam Cauley** secured Defender of the Month in the Rangers farm system for the month of May. Bratt went 3-0 with a Texas League-best 1.33 ERA across five starts in May. His 10.33 strikeout-to-walk ratio ranked fifth in Minor League Baseball (min. 5 starts) during the month. Bratt's May was highlighted by a career-high 10 strikeouts across six shutout innings at San Antonio on May 10th. Cauley posted a .975 fielding percentage in 26 games during May, committing two errors on 81 total chances. The versatile Houston native played 10 games at second base, nine in center field and seven at second base. Playing in the outfield for the first time professionally, Cauley recorded his first two career outfield assists in May.

CAULEY, CAULEY ANYTIME:

Over his last 30 games, **Cam Cauley** has hit .308 (33-for-107)/.372/.505/.877 with 10 doubles, three home runs and 20 runs scored. Over his last 12 games, he is batting .381 (16-for-42)/.471/.524/.995 with seven runs scored. He is fifth in the league with 17 stolen bases, but has just one stolen base in his last nine games.

SAVE TONIGHT:

The RoughRiders have had 11 different pitchers record a save in 2025. Frisco was the first team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. **Gavin Collyer** are leads the team saves (five) for the Riders, a mark that is tied for fifth in the Texas League.

OVER THE WALL-COTT:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been displaying the power as of late. In his last 26 games, he has blasted six home runs while slashing .277/.370/.535/.905 with eight doubles, 17 RBIs, 20 runs scored and 15 walks to 17 strikeouts. Three Fridays ago, he became the fifth Texas League teenager since 2005 to record a multi-homer game, joining the company of Keibert Ruiz (2018, 2x), Fernando Tatis Jr. (2018, 3x), Alex Verdugo (2016) and Mike Trout (2011). This season, his walk rate of 12.8 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 19.8 percent, a career low. His 16 doubles lead the league and his 24 extra-base hits also pace the league. While on a 14-game on-base streak, he is hitting .320 (16-for-50)/.438/.520/.958.

DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A-RON:

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .298 (42-for-141)/.419/.496/.915 over his last 40 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (42) and is third in OBP (.411) while leading the league in walk rate (19.6 percent). In his last 17 games, he is hitting .297 (19-for-64)/.384/.500/.884 with two doubles, three home runs and seven RBIs. In his Frisco career, he has earned 198 walks over four seasons, which is second in franchise history. He is just eight walks away from tying the franchise record for walks, held by **Guilder Rodriguez** with 206 from 2009-2015.



ABOUT MITCH

-During COVID-19, finding a place to throw was difficult, so he built a bullpen in the backyard of his home in Newmarket, Ontario to keep throwing. While most Canadian schools were not able to start playing baseball in 2021, Bratt made the decision to transfer to Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Georgia (outside of near Savannah). He completed his final year of high school online while playing baseball.

-After spending two months at GPA, he played in the MLB Draft League during the summer of 2021, going 1-1 with a 2.57 ERA while playing for the West Virginia Black Bears.

-Baseball America ranked Bratt as the No. 3 Canadian prospect going into the 2021 draft. Committed to play baseball at Florida State.

-Made one start for Team Canada in the 2023 World Baseball Classic as a 19-year-old against Team USA, going 0.1 IP, 3 H, 6 R, 6 ER, facing MLB All-Stars Mookie Betts, Mike Trout, Paul Goldschmidt, Nolan Arenado, Kyle Tucker, Tim Anderson and JT Realmuto.

2025 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 17 prospect in the Rangers organization by MiLB.com.

-Recorded RoughRiders first quality start of the season on 4/11 at NWA, allowing two runs over six innings with six strikeouts to no walks. He moved up a day in the rotation, pitching on five days rest.

-On May 10th at San Antonio, Bratt took a no-hitter into the sixth inning before allowing a bloop single into right. He struck out a career-high 10 batters in the game before leading after six innings. The RoughRiders fell 2-1 on a two-run walk-off home run from Romeo Sanabria.

-In May, Bratt went 3-0 over five starts, owning a 1.33 ERA, 27.0 IP, 24 H, 5 R, 4 ER, 3 BB, 31 K.

2024 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 21 prospect in the Rangers organization by MiLB.com.

-After tough first start of the season (3.0 IP, 8 H, 7 R, 7 ER, 0 BB, 4 K vs. JS) with Hickory, has gone 6-3 with a 2.30 ERA over his last 16 games (14 starts) with 80 strikeouts to 16 walks over 74.1 innings.

-In last 10 games in Hickory (nine starts), went 4-1 with 1.35 ERA, striking out 55 over 53.1 IP to 11 walks, holding opponents to .182 batting average.

-First Double-A start was 5.0 shutout innings at San Antonio on 8/1.

2023 SEASON

-Spent all of 2023 with High-A Hickory and was selected as an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star.

-Despite being 19 at the beginning of the season and turning 20 midway through the year, he ranked fifth in the South Atlantic League in ERA (3.84) among those with at least 15 starts.

-Was placed on the Injured List from 7/18-8/31 with lat tightness.

-Played under Carlos Cardoza in the 2023 Arizona Fall League with the Surprise Saguaros, going 1-0 with a 6.46 ERA over six games (one start).

2022 SEASON

-Was named an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star with Low-A Down East, entering the season as the youngest pitcher in the Carolina League at 18 years old.

-He finished the season third in ERA (2.45).

-Named the Rangers Starting Pitcher of the Month for July, going 3-1 with a 1.96 ERA.

2021 SEASON

-Bratt out 13 of 24 (54.2%) batters faced without issuing a walk over four appearances for the ACL Rangers in his professional debut.

-He recorded at least three strikeouts in each of his outings, all of which came in August or September, shortly after his 18th birthday.
