Leading Off

Reading continues a six-game series with game five tonight against Somerset. Reading has a 9-7 edge in the season series.

Reading allowed a season-high 22 runs and 23 hits in a 22-3 loss to the Patriots last night. It also marked the largest margin of defeat for the Fightin Phils in a game this season. For Reading, Jhailyn Ortiz, Cody Roberts and Herbert Iser all homered to account for the offense. Jasson Dominguez and Max Burt each had four hits for the Patriots and Eduardo Torrealba drove in seven runs for Somerset. Drew Thrope got the start for Somerset and was excellent in his second Double-A outing, tossing 6.2 innings and allowing just two runs, while striking out 12 batters. Both Herbert Iser and Jhailyn Ortiz pitched the ninth inning for Reading.

R-Phils.

Oliver Dunn homered in three-straight games to begin the series, marking the second time he's done that this season (6/20-22). It's also the third time in 2023 a Reading player has homered in three-straight. Dunn now has 20 home runs on the season along with 73 RBI, both marks are career highs. His previous career highs for homers was seven and RBI was 25. August has treated Dunn was too, as he's slashing .359/.400/.844 with a 1.244 OPS. He's also added nine home runs, 25 RBI and 15 runs over 15 games this month. Dunn's 20 home runs are second on the team and fourth in the Eastern League. His 73 RBI are second, but he holds with active lead with Hunter Goodman now in Triple-A.

New Face in Baseballtown

Tonight's starter Matt Osterberg will make his second start with Reading since being called up, but first at FirstEnergy Stadium. Osterberg did appear in one game out of the bullpen in 2022, on August 27 and pitched a scoreless 1.1 innings against Binghamton. 'Sup Somerset

Somerset enters tonight with the best-overall record in the Eastern League at 66-45, which saw them win the first half title. The Patriots are 24-19 in the second half, which currently sees them in first in the division. Somerset and Binghamton split a six-game series last week in New Jersey. Next up, Somerset returns home and welcomes Hartford. One of the Yankees' top prospects Jasson Dominguez headlines a Somerset team loaded with talent. Ben Rice has been a force since joining Somerset and both Rice and Dominguez have left strong marks on this series.

Righty Matt Sauer gets the start tonight for Somerset. He started against Reading on July 5 and earned the win, going five innings and allowing three runs with six strikeouts. Overall in 2023, Sauer is 2-3 with a 3.53 ERA over eight games/seven starts (35.2 IP, 27 H, 15 BB, 43 SO). He suffered a loss last time out on Aug. 12 against Binghamton, allowing three runs over 5.1 IP with six strikeouts. He began the season on the injured list before making two rehab starts in the FCL and one with Hudson Valley and eventually made his Somerset debut on June 23. The Yankees drafted Sauer in the second round of the 2017 draft out of Righetti High School in Santa Maria, California.
