YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Hartford Yard Goats, 7-4, at The Diamond. The Yard Goats took a 3-0 lead in the fourth inning against Richmond starter **Kai-Wei Teng** with an RBI groundout by Michael Toglia and a two-run double by Aaron Schunk. Richmond pulled within a run in the fifth with an RBI single by **Franklin Labour** and a bases-loaded walk by **Brett Auerbach**. Hartford added two runs in the seventh to stretch the lead to 6-2. **Sean Roby** hit a two-run homer in the eighth, his 10th of the season, to pull score to 6-4. In the top of the ninth, the Yard Goats pushed the lead to 7-4 with a bases-loaded walk by Ezequiel Tovar. Teng finished his start with seven strikeouts.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. This series marks the only meetings between the two clubs this season. Richmond does not travel to Hartford this year. This series is also the first of the year for the Flying Squirrels against a team from the Eastern League's Northeast Division.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have dropped seven-of-their-last-10 games. Last week, they lost four-of-six in the road series in Altoona, just their second series loss of 2022. The previous week, the Flying Squirrels won four-of-six at Harrisburg. The Flying Squirrels have won four series, lost two and split one this year. They won the season-opening set at Bowie from April 8-10, won their first home series against Altoona from April 12-17, lost a series at Erie from April 20-24, won five-of-six against the Baysox at home from April 26-May 1, split a home series against the RubberDucks from May 3-8 and won last week's road series against the Senators. Thursday's loss dropped the Flying Squirrels back to third place in the Southwest Division.

THE YARD GOATS have won eight-of-their-last-10 games. They are currently in second place in the Eastern League Northeast Division, a half-game behind first-place Somerset. Last week in Bowie, they won five-of-six, including the final two games of the series on Saturday and Sunday at Prince George's Stadium. The Yard Goats are playing the back half of a two-city, 12-game road trip, which is tied for their longest this year. They will play a second 12-game road trip to Reading and Somerset from August 2-14. Hartford's roster features seven of MLB.com's top-30 Rockies prospects, including SS Ezequiel Tovar (6), OF Brenton Doyle (7), 1B Michael Toglia (8), 3B Aaron Schunk (19), RHP Noah Davis (26), RHP Gavin Hollowell (27) and RHP Karl Kauffmann (28).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Kyle Harrison** takes the mound for his Double-A debut. He began the season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, where he went 0-1 with a 1.55 ERA in seven starts. At the time of his promotion to Richmond, Harrison ranked third in the Northwest League in ERA (1.55), second in strikeouts (59), third in BAA (.179) and tied for fifth in WHIP (1.00). He is currently tied for first in the minors (min. 20 IP) with a 50% strikeout rate and second in the minors with 18.31 K/9 IP. Harrison was selected in the third round (85th overall) of the 2020 MLB Draft by the Giants out of De La Salle High School in Concord, Calif. He is currently rated by MLB.com and *Baseball America* as the Giants' No. 2 prospect. **For more on Harrison, see page two.**

FOR HARTFORD: Left-hander Nick Bush makes his ninth start of the season. He last pitched on Saturday at Bowie and allowed three runs over six innings, his second-longest outing of the season. After going 1-2 with a 6.11 ERA in the month of April, Bush has gone 2-0 with a 2.70 ERA in four starts in May. Bush was selected in the eighth round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of LSU. He split the 2021 season between High-A Spokane and Double-A Hartford, combining to go 4-6 with a 3.71 ERA. With the Yard Goats last year, he made seven starts and went 0-4 with a 5.40 ERA.

LOPSIDED: On the year, the Flying Squirrels have the worst run differential in the Southwest Division at -29 runs. In their last 12 losses dating back to April 27, the Flying Squirrels have fallen by an average of 6.7 runs. Of those 12 losses, four have been by 10-or-more runs, including a 10-0 shutout to the Baysox on April 27, a 12-1 loss at Harrisburg on May 15, a 12-2 loss at Altoona on May 17 and a 19-8 loss on Sunday at Altoona, which tied the franchise record for runs allowed in a game. Richmond has scored two-or-less runs in six of their last 12 losses. On the other hand, the Flying Squirrels' last 14 wins in the same time frame have come by an average of 2.5 runs, including six one-run games.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,012) and total attendance (126,244). Richmond is 10th of the 120 MiLB teams in total and average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 51 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (56). **Sean Roby** is third in the league with 10 homers on the season, with eight coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 168 home runs.

MARTY PARTY: Over his last 12 games played since May 11, **Brandon Martorano** has hit .310 (13-for-42) with four homers, three doubles, two triples and 12 RBIs. On May 11 at Harrisburg, he clubbed the second grand slam of his career. He returned to the lineup two days later and lifted the Flying Squirrels to a 6-5 win in extras with a sac fly in the 10th inning. On May 14 at Harrisburg, he homered twice for the first time in his career, knocking a go-ahead, three-run homer in the sixth and a solo shot for an insurance run in the ninth inning. He added a solo homer in Sunday's series finale at Altoona. On Wednesday, he picked up a two-run triple with a ball that missed leaving the yard in dead-center by inches.

SHANE TRAIN: In the month of May, **Shane Matheny** is batting .329 (23-for-70) with five homers, four doubles, a triple and 15 RBIs. He has picked up a pair of two-homer games, one on May 1 at The Diamond against Bowie and another on May 12 at Harrisburg. They were the second and third multi-homer games of his professional career and his first since 2019. Matheny is currently riding a 10-game hitting streak dating back to May 14, during which he is batting .394 (13-for-33). On the season, he is ranked seventh in the Eastern League in OBP (.413), eighth in SLG (.538) and seventh in OPS (.951). He is also ranked seventh in wOBA (.419) and tied for eighth in wRC+ (164).

TOASTY: **Frankie Tostado** is batting .342 (38-for-111) with five homers, seven doubles and 17 RBIs over his last 28 games since April 22. From April 22-May 4, he posted a 10-game hitting streak, which was tied for the longest in the league this year at the time. On May 11, he tied a career high with four hits against the Senators. On the year, he has picked up at least one hit in 32 of his 38 games played. In the Eastern League, Tostado is ranked fourth in batting average (.322), third in hits (47) and fifth in total bases (73).

ROBY: With a two-run homer on Thursday night, **Sean Roby** moved into third in the league with 10 home runs this season. It was his eighth homer at The Diamond this season, which is tied for the third-most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history with **Johnny Monell** (2011) and **Heliot Ramos** (2021). He trails only **Ryder Jones** (9 - 2016) and **Adam Duvall** (10 - 2013). Roby hit eight homers over a 15-game stretch from April 10-29. He had hit just one homer over a 16-game stretch from April 30-May 25 prior to Thursday.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked fourth in batting average (.322), third in hits (47) and fifth in total bases (73). **Sean Roby** is third in home runs (10). **Shane Matheny** ranked seventh in OBP (.413), eighth in SLG (.538) and seventh in OPS (.951). **Mike Gigliotti** is tied for eighth in stolen bases (10). **Ryan Walker** is first in wins (6) and **Solomon Bates** is tied for second (4). **Chris Wright** is tied for fifth in saves (4).

WHERE THE GOATS RANK: In the Eastern League, Ezequiel Tovar is ranked eighth in batting average (.314), tied for third in home runs (9), tied for sixth in RBIs (27), fourth in SLG (.582), fifth in OPS (.972), tied for first in hits (47), tied for first in extra-base hits (21), first in total bases (89) and tied for third in stolen bases (14). Willie MacIver is tied for fifth in home runs (8). Michael Toglia is ninth in RBIs (25). Issac Collins is seventh in stolen bases (11). Riley Pint is tied for first in games pitched (17) and PJ Poulin is third (16). Gavin Hollowell and Nick Kennedy are tied for fifth in saves (4).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have seven players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-40 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Will Wilson** (14), **R.J. Dabovich** (17), **Tyler Fitzgerald** (34), **Diego Rincones** (36) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (40). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Dabovich (17), Wilson (22) and **Brett Auerbach** (28). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.
