DAWG DAYS

♦ The Reno Aces were victims of defeat in a 5-4 extra-inning loss to the El Paso Chihuahuas on Friday night... Despite the loss, **Sergio Alcantara** continued his blistering series after going 2-for-4 with a triple in the bottom of the third. The switch-hitting infielder has gone 7-for-15 with two extra-base hits and five RBI in the first four games of the six-game series vs El Paso... **Albert Almora** delivered his Minor League-leading 44th double of the campaign, a line shot into left field to score **Bryson Brigman** and **Jorge Barrosa**. Not only does Almora lead in doubles, but he stands atop the Pacific Coast League in hits with 145... **Jake Rice** made his Aces debut, tossing a clean of relief, allowing no hits and walking one. The southpaw posted a 3.47 ERA with 58 punchouts and 27 walks in 49 1/3 frames with the Amarillo Sod Poodles, the Double-A affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks, before his promotion to Reno... The Aces will bounce back in Saturday's matchup against the El Paso Chihuahuas, with the first pitch scheduled for 6:35 p.m. PT. ♦ Reno leads Triple-A in AVG (.287), Hits (1354), Runs (829), and RBI (793)... 2nd in 2B (289)... 3rd in Total-Bases (2238)... 2nd least amount of strikeouts (1011). ♥ This is the 11th of 12 matchups between the two clubs this season.

♦ The Aces have hit .301/.374/.483 with 38 XBH (13 HR), 72 RBI, and 40 BB in 414 PA against El Paso this season. **Tristin English**: 13-for-44 (.295), 5 XBH (2 HR), 8 RBI, 2 BB **Albert Almora**: 13-for-34 (.382), 6 2B, 1 HR, 9 RBI, 1 BB **Bryson Brigman**: 13-for-34 (.382), 2 HR, 11 RBI, 2 BB **Sergio Alcantara**: 11-for-35 (.314), 2 XBH, 6 RBI, 4 BB **ACES vs CRUZ**

♦ The Aces will take on left-hander Omar Cruz in Saturday's matchup... Cruz has made 31 appearances (6 starts) this season... He allowed four runs on five hits and one walk in just two frames in his previous matchup against the Tacoma Rainiers, striking out three... The southpaw made one appearance out of the bullpen against the Aces in their previous series, allowing two runs on four hits in 3 2/3 innings while taking the loss. However, he punched out seven... His best outing this season came on August 11 against the Sugar Land Space Cowboys when he shut them out across six innings, allowing just two hits while walking none and striking out six... Cruz owns a 3.15 ERA with 43 strikeouts and 16 walks in 34 1/3 frames this season.

♦ **Humberto Castellanos** is geared up to make his 18th start (19th appearance) in Sunday's series finale vs the El Paso Chihuahuas... Humberto was lights out in Tuesday's opener, limiting El Paso to one run across six dominant frames with two walks and four punchouts... Over his last seven starts (dating back to 6/21), the right-hander has been on top of his game, going 3-0 with a 1.95 ERA, 25 strikeouts, and 13 walks in 37 1/3 innings. He has not allowed more than two runs over that stretch... In 10 2/3 innings with the Diamondbacks, the 26-year-old posted a 5.23 ERA with a 7.4 K: BB... He owns a 3.75 ERA with an 80:36 K: BB in 86 1/3 innings this season.

SETTING THE STAGE

♦ **Konnor Pilkington** is ready to make his 19th start (31st appearance) in Saturday's matchup against El Paso... The lefty worked for only one frame in his last outing but was efficient, holding the Albuquerque Isotopes scoreless while punching out the side... Pilkington has reached five innings just once this season on July 13 against the Round Rock Express when he limited his opponent to one hit across 5 1/3 frames, walking none and punching out three... The 26-year-old owns a 6.72 ERA with 67 punchouts and 46 walks in 68 1/3 innings of work heading into the matchup.

MAJOR DEBUT

♦ Originally drafted in the third round (81 overall) by the Chicago White Sox in the 2018 MLB draft... Made his MLB Debut with the Cleveland Gaurdians on 4/15/22 against the San Francisco Giants... Pilkington allowed no runs and no hits in one inning of work... in his first and lone full season in the bigs with CLE, he went 1-2 with a 3.88 ERA in 58.0 innings pitched, he struck out 50.

♦ Made one appearance with Cleveland in 2023, working for 2.0 innings, allowing no runs one one hit and two strikeouts.

BECOMING A SNAKE

♥ Acquired by Arizona on in a trade with Cleveland for cash considerations on May 1st, 2023... He is yet to make his debut with the Diamondbacks.
