## WICHITA WIND SURGE (20-20, 57-52) vs. SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (27-13, 70-39) LHP CONNOR PRIELIPP (0-5, 3.39 ERA) vs. LHP IXAN HENDERSON (7-5, 2.50 ERA)

**SETTING THE SCENE:** The Cardinals take on Wichita (MIN) in the 2nd game of a 6-game series ... are 1-0 in the series ... tonight's game is the 20th of 24 in the season series ... are 9-10 overall and 5-2 at home against the Wind Surge.

**FIRST THINGS FIRST:** The Cardinals hold the TXL's best 2nd-half record at 27-13 ... are in 1st place in the 2nd-half North Division standings, 4.0 games up on 2nd-place Tulsa.

**HEN'S HOUSE:** LHP Ixan Henderson is making his 20th start of the season and 4th vs. WCH ... lasted 4.0 IP in his last start at San Antonio but did not allow a run ... was shortest start since going 3.1 IP at WCH on 6/25 ... ranks 2nd in TXL in ERA (2.50) and top-5 in WHIP (1.17) and strikeouts (107) ... in 3 starts vs. WCH is 1-1 with a 6.43 ERA (10ER/14.OIP).

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Newcomers C Graysen Tarlow and OF Zach Levenson drove home all 4 runs for the Cardinals in a series-opening 4-2 win over Wichita ... Levenson hit a 2-run shot in the 2nd inning to get the scoring started ... RHP Jack Ralston earned the win in relief in his return to Hammons Field and RHP Luis Gastelum picked up his team-leading 7th save.

**BEAR WITH US:** RHP Brandt Thompson left his start after 3.0 IP due to blister issues on Tuesday night ... was his 2nd start for the Cardinals and his professional debut at Hammons Field ... allowed 1 unearned run on 1 hit ... is 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA through 2 starts with Cardinals ... was promoted from Peoria (A+) on 8/5 after starting

the year with Palm Beach (A) ... combined for a 2-7 record and 3.96 ERA over 88.2 IP in his previous 2 stops ... 1st-year pro was drafted in the 17th round last year out of Missouri State ... was 1st-Team All-MVC in his junior and senior seasons (2023-24) ... becomes the 6th former Bear to play for Springfield ... list includes P Bob Zimmermann (2008), P Nick Petree (2014-15), P Cody Schumacher (2015), 1B Luke Voit (2016), and current MSU head coach IF Joey Hawkins.

**DUB STEPS:** Tuesday's win was Springfield's 70th of the season ... improved to a season-best 31 games above .500 (70-39) ... last year's record-setting 79-win club won its 70th game on 8/24 ... holds TXL best record by 13.0 games.

**HELLO, GOODBYE:** OF Zach Levenson homered in his 1st Double-A at-bat Tuesday ... last Cardinal to homer in 1st AB was OF Chase Davis on 9/7/24 vs. NWA ... Levenson hit 8 HR in 82 games with Peoria (A+) to start season.

**ANOTHER ON MAUTZ'S MANTLE:** LHP Brycen Mautz was named the TXL Pitcher of the Week for his start on 8/8 at San Antonio ... allowed just 1 hit over 6.0-shutout IP with 10 strikeouts ... was his 2nd weekly award this season ... also named the TXL Pitcher of the Month for July after going 2-0 with a 1.57 ERA over 4 starts.
