LET'S RECAP

The Albuquerque Isotopes extended their series lead over the Round Rock Express thanks to a 4-2 win on Sunday night at Dell Diamond. Round Rock starter RHP Tyler Phillips was tagged with the loss while Albuquerque starter RHP Brandon Gold got the win. Both teams tallied their first run in the first inning. 1B Connor Joe hit a two-out home run for Albuquerque to take a 1-0 lead before Round Rock tied it up as CF Delino DeShields launched a solo homer of his own in the leadoff spot. Albuquerque took over in the third inning for a 3-1 lead when Joe hit his second home run in as many at-bats, bringing RF Taylor Motter home with him after the outfielder worked a walk. After three scoreless innings, 2B Scott Burcham hit a single before scoring on a triple from CF Wynton Bernard in the top of the seventh. The Express added a run in the bottom of the frame when C Yohel Pozo hit a dinger, trimming the Albuquerque lead to 4-2. Isotopes LHP Zac Rosscup earned the save with a 1-2-3 ninth inning to secure the win for Albuquerque, increasing their series lead to 3-1.

Round Rock RHP Drew Anderson continues to hold the No. 1 spot in the Triple-A West League for strikeouts with 67 on the season. Over nine starts and 11 total appearances, the righty holds the league's second-best ERA at 3.60 (20 ER/50.0 IP).

IT'S OUTTA HERE

Express C Yohel Pozo blasted his second home run in as many games on Sunday night. Last night's solo bomb was the catcher's 11th of the season and brought his season RBI total to 38. Round Rock has now hit 77 home runs during the 2021 campaign and eight during the month of July.

AN EVEN MATCHUP

Round Rock and Albuquerque have recorded even hits in three of the first four games of the series. On Sunday, both teams tallied six hits after totaling five apiece on July 9 and seven apiece on July 8. The only contest that saw a difference in hit totals was July 10, when the Express outhit the Isotopes 10-9. Despite just a one-hit margin, Albuquerque has outscored Round Rock 20-16 during the first series of the season between the two Triple-A West League East Division foes.

STARTING 2 FALL BEHIND

Last night's defeat dropped Round Rock's record to 28-30, marking the first time that the E-Train has been two games below .500 since September 2, 2018, the last day of the 2018 season. After starting the 2019 campaign at 1-2, Round Rock never fell below the .500 mark.

OUT OF LEFT FIELD

Express INF Charles Leblanc is set to make his eighth career start, and first at the Triple-A level. in left field on Monday against the Isotopes. All seven of his previous outfield starts were in 2019 when playing with the Double-A Frisco RoughRiders. Leblanc will be the eighth different Round Rock player to make a start in left field this season after totaling 39 starts in the infield.

ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE SHOW

Twenty members of the Round Rock Express have made their Triple-A debuts so far in 2021: RHP Jason Bahr, INF Jax Biggers, OF Carl Chester, INF Ryan Dorow, RHP Scott Engler, RHP Demarcus Evans, RHP Joe Gatto, C Blake Grant-Parks, INF Yonny Hernandez, INF Jake Hoover, C Jack Kruger, INF Charles Leblanc, LHP Sal Mendez, RHP Tyler Phillips, RHP Ryder Ryan, OF Leody Taveras, INF Anderson Tejeda, INF Curtis Terry, RHP Collin Wiles and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang. Interestingly enough, Evans, Taveras and Tejeda all saw action with the Texas Rangers during the shortened 2020 season despite no experience at the Triple-A level. C Jack Kruger also suited up for the Los Angeles Angels and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang pitched for the Rangers in 2021 before making their Triple-A debuts.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players on Round Rock's roster hail from 15 different states: California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Maryland, Michigan, Mississippi, Nevada, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Oregon, Texas and Virginia. Jake Lemoine is the lone Texan on the roster, hailing from Bridge City. Lemoine was a standout pitcher at the University of Houston before being drafted by the Texas Rangers in 2012.

AROUND THE WORLD

Six different nations are represented on the Express roster. In addition to the 23 players from the United States, INF Charles Leblanc is Canadian, OF Elier Hernandez and OF Leody Taveras hail from the Dominican Republic, LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang is from South Korea, RHP Jharel Cotton is a native of the U.S. Virgin Islands and C Yohel Pozo and INF Yonny Hernandez are Venezuelan.

EXPRESS MANAGER KENNY HOLMBERG

The 2021 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kenny Holmberg's 13th year in the Texas Rangers organization. In 2020, he worked with Rangers prospects at the Alternate Training Site in Arlington, as well as the Fall Developmental League in Arizona. Round Rock will be the fourth different club for which Holmberg has managed in the Rangers farm system after serving at the helm of Short-Season Spokane in 2018, the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers from 2013-2015 and the Rookie-level Dominican Summer League Rangers from 2010-2011. He has compiled a 207-172 (.546) record while leading his clubs to the postseason in four of his six managerial campaigns, including a Northwest League championship series appearance in 2018. He originally joined the Texas organization as a coach for the DSL Rangers in 2009 and



also served as a coach for the club's High-A affiliate in Myrtle Beach in 2012. In addition to his managerial post for the Express, Holmberg also serves as the Rangers' Major League Infield Coordinator.

An infielder in his playing days, Holmberg was selected by Milwaukee in the 22nd round of the 2005 MLB draft and played four seasons in the Brewers organization. He compiled a .272 average with 34 home runs and 187 RBI over 338 career minor league games. Holmberg was also selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 49th round of the 2001 MLB draft out of Dunedin High School in Florida but opted to play collegiately at St. Petersburg College from 2002-2003. He then spent two seasons at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, earning first-team NAIA All-America honors in 2005.


