FRISCO RIDES SEVEN-RUN FIRST TO VICTORY OVER MISSIONS:

FRISCO RIDES SEVEN-RUN FIRST TO VICTORY OVER MISSIONS: The Frisco RoughRiders exploded for seven runs in the first inning and cruised to a 9-6 win over the San Antonio Missions on Wednesday night from Nelson Wolff Stadium. Frisco (4-1) started the night hot with back-to-back singles to lead off the first inning from J.P. Martinez and Jonathan Ornelas against Dwayne Matos (0-1). David Garcia and Kellen Stahm both then hit RB singles to make it 2-0. Following a Dio Arias single, Trey Hair rapped a two-run single, notching the score at 4-0. With two on, Sandro Fabian capped the inning with a three-run blast, putting the Riders in front 7-0. Frisco sent 11 men to the plate in the first. In the bottom of the first, San Antonio (2-3) fought back with an RBI single from Yorman Rodriguez and a Jorge Ona three-run home run, cutting the Friese lead to 2-4. The Missions chopped at the lead more in the bottom of the third whom Orig lared an RBI double to left Frisco lead to 7-4. The Missions chopped at the lead more in the bottom of the third when Chris Givin laced an RBI double to left, but the Riders answered back with a Hair RBI double in the fifth to put the lead back to three, 8-5. Robert Podorsky then laid a safety squeeze down for San Antonio in the sixth to score another run, pushing the score to 8-6, before Frisco added insurance in the eighth and made it 9-6 when Fabian scored on a wild pitch. **Fer Ozuna** earned his first save of the season with a 1-2-3 ninth inning.

LEAVING THEM OUT TO DRY:

Riders pitchers have been leaving a lot of runners on base through the first five games of the season. To start the year, Frisco arms have stranded 42 runners (8.4 per game), including a season-high 11 in the season-opener against Arkansas. Opponents are hitting just .196/.387/.304 with runners in scoring position against Riders pitching, while Frisco is batting an incredible .400/.436/.680 with runners in scoring position.

YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT: Over the last three games, the RoughRiders have banged out exactly 10 hits in each contest. Their 30 hits in the last three games are more than 16 teams in MiLB have all season. Overall, Frisco is hitting. 279/.348/.394 to start the season, a batting average good for fourth in the Texas League and fifth in Double-A. The Riders are also averaging 6.2 runs per game while only hitting two home runs this season. Only the Northwest Arkansas Naturals (one) have fewer home runs in the Texas League this season, while the Springfield Cardinals lead the way with eight.

Since the 2019 season ended and the standings reset on September 3rd, 2019, the RoughRiders have not been in second place for 954 days. From the season-opening game in 2021, the RoughRiders held first place the entire season and have now been in first place for every game in 2022 as well.

THE COMEBACK KIDS:

After returning from down 4-3 in the eighth inning on Tuesday against San Antonio, the RoughRiders have now had two come-frombehind wins this season in four games. On Opening Day, it was **Ezequiel Duran** with an RBI double as the go-ahead hit in the eighth, while **Jonathan Ornelas** played hero on Tuesday with an RBI single. When trailing after the seventh inning, Frisco is 2-1.

OUT OF THE GATES:

In 2021, the RoughRiders began the season 3-0 and raced to a 14-6 record through their first 20 games. After starting the year 4-1, the RoughRiders have taken the opening series of the season in back-to-back years and have not lost an opening set since 2018. The 2016 squad started 9-1 through 10 games, 17-4 through 21 games and 23-7 through 30 games. After that, they struggled, going 40-69 the rest of the way, finishing the season in third place in the Texas League South.

WELCOME TO THE LEIT SHOW:

Rangers No.1 prospect, RHP Jack Leiter was as-advertised on Saturday in his first start of his professional career. Over his three innings, Leiter whiffed seven while allowing just one run on one hit with two walks. The second-overall pick out of Vanderbilt in the 2021 draft, Leiter was a unanimous First-Team All-American in his final season with the Commodores while tying the NCAA lead in strikeouts on the year. The son of two-time All-Star and two-time World Series champ Al Leiter, Jack is ranked as the No. 17 prospect in baseball by MLB.com.

VS. THE MISSIONS:

The RoughRiders dominated the Missions in 2021, going 13-5 against them in 18 games. To open their road slate last year, Frisco went 5-1 against San Antonio at Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium and then swept them in a six-game series at home in June. The Riders owned a .711 OPS with 14 home runs against the Missions, but where they really dominated was on the mound. Frisco had a 3.58 ERA versus the Missions 4.70 ERA over the 18 games.

LOOK AT ALL THAT TALENT:

While Leiter headlines the top 30 prospects talent on the squad, the Riders back up him with plenty of players to watch. INF **Ezequiel Duran** slots in as the No. 4 prospect in the organization after the Rangers acquired him from the Yankees as part of the **Joey Gallo** deal at the 2021 deadline. OF **Dustin Harris** is the No. 6 prospect after his incredible 20-20 campaign a year ago. Another trade piece, Harris came to the Rangers when they dealt **Mike Minor** to the A's in 2020. A pair of returners from 2021's team round out the prospects in LHP **Cody Bradford** and RHP **Zak Kent**. Bradford, a former Baylor Bear from Aledo, Texas, led all Rangers farmhands in strikeouts last season while Kent finished third in the organization in strikeout rate (31.9).

ABOUT JUSTIN

-5A Hallsville High School in Hallsville, Texas (a litte over two hours from Frisco toward the Louisiana border). Thought he was going to play in junior college before owning a 1.49 ERA his senior year. He received an offer from University of New Mexico. Helped Hallsville to a 5A regional quarterfinal appearance in 2016 as a senior.

-At New Mexico, Slaten was a three-year player with two spent in the starting rotation. After owning a 7.02 ERA his sophomore season, Slaten went 5-5 with a 2.51 ERA while striking out 98 in 82.1 innings to earn 2nd-Team All-Mountain West Conference honors.

-His third-round selection (86th overall), made Slaten the highest New Mexico pitcher taken in the MLB draft since Kevin Andersh was taken in the first round (15th overall) by the Pirates in 1984.

-After being acquired in the offseason by the Rangers, catcher Mitch Garver is the only former Lobo on Texas. Garver was drafted out of New Mexico in 2013 by the Twins.

2022 SEASON

-First appearance for the Riders came out of the bullpen on Opening Night, throwing a scoreless inning with a pair of strikeouts.

2021 SEASON

-Finished the 2021 season as the No. 29 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Ended the year with the 5th-most strikeouts (110) and 10th-most innings (82.1) among Rangers minor leaguers in his 20 games (19 starts) with High-A Hickory.

-Over last 12 games, Slaten went 4-4 with a 4.14 ERA to conclude the year.

-Entered the season as the No. 15 prospect in the system by Fangraphs.

2020 SEASON

-Struck out 17 of 44 (38.6 percent) batters faced in the Fall Developmental league while allowing just two runs over 10.2 innings.

2019 SEASON

-Averaged 12.1 K/9 over his 11 games (10 starts) during first professional season.
