Entering today, **3B ANDREW FISCHER** has recorded 29 home runs between High-A Wisconsin (20) and Double-A Biloxi (9)... Fischer is currently tied for the 2nd-most home runs by a Brewers MiLB player since 2000... It marks the most home runs in a season by a Brewers MiLB player since **C LANCE BURKHART** (30) in 2001.

Fischer is **ONE** home run away from the 17th 30 home run season in Brewers Minor League history... It would mark the 3rd 30 home run season since 1990.

On Sunday, **1B BLAKE BURKE** become the 3rd player in Shuckers franchise history to record a 20/20 season, and the 1st since **OF JACKSON CHOURIO** in 2023... Burke become the 1st 20/20 player in Double-A this season and the 3rd in Minor League Baseball.

Burke is the 4th Brewers Minor League player (since 2005) with a 20/20 season.

SPEEDING TO A RECORD

On Friday night, **2B DYLAN O'RAE** became the 5th player in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015) to reach 40+ stolen bases in a season... O'Rae also broke the franchise career stolen base record of 68, set by **OF JOHNNY DAVIS** (2016-17).

O'Rae enters today needing 12 stolen bases to tie Davis' single-season record of 52, set in 2017.

HOME, SWEET, HOME

The Shuckers enter today with a 26-13 record at Keesler Federal Park this season, the best in the Southern League, 2nd-best in Double-A and 6th-best in Minor League Baseball... At home, the Shuckers have outscored opponents 241-192 (+49).

At Keesler Federal Park this season, the Shuckers own a .273/.391/.456 slash line as a team with an .847 OPS... The Shuckers are averaging 6.2 runs per game.

The Shuckers are on pace for the 2nd-best home record in franchise history and the 6th-best in the Southern League since 2005... The best home record in franchise history (since 2015) is 47-23 (.671), set in 2018.

WE GOT A BITE!

With a win on Friday, the Shuckers are 16-6 against the Blue Wahoos at Keesler Federal Park since the start of the 2025 season... The Shuckers have outscored Pensacola 117-66 over that span, a +51 run differential.

This season, the Shuckers are averaging 6.6 runs per game at home against the Blue Wahoos with an .852 OPS and 27 stolen bases.

BACK IN THE SADDLE

MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO is in his 8th season as Shuckers manager and 10th as manager of a Brewers Double-A affiliate... Guerrero needs 8 wins to reach 1,500 in his career... Guerrero's 1,492 wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP JARON DEBERRY (7-4, 4.00) makes his team-leading 17th start of the season, and his 4th against the Blue Wahoos... DeBerry enters today among the Double-A leaders in opponents average (3rd, .207), innings (T-8th, 83.1), ERA (10th, 4.00) and WHIP (10th, 1.24)... Across his last 8 starts (since May 23), DeBerry owns a 2.39 ERA (13er, 49.0ip), with 51 strikeouts and a .183 opponents average.

Last time out, DeBerry recorded his 2nd consecutive 10+ strikeout start with a career-high 11 over 7.0 innings... DeBerry is the 4th pitcher in Shuckers franchise history with 10+ strikeouts in back-to-back starts and the 1st to achieve the feat since **RHP JACOB MISIOROWSKI** in 2024.

IF DeBerry strikes out 10 batters today, he would become the 4th Southern League pitcher since 2005 with 3 consecutive 10+ strikeout starts and the 1st since **RHP ANDREW ABBOTT** (CHA) in 2024.
