# RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (26-29) Fresno Grizzlies (33-23)





RHP Cam Day (1-3, 5.24 ERA) vs. LHP Alberto Pacheco (3-2, 2.60 ERA)

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Quakes embark on a crucial six-game road trip today, with the opening game of a sixgame set against the Fresno Grizzlies (COL) at Chukchansi Park in Fresno. After this six-game set, the Qukes will return to LoanMart Field for the final three games of the first half, as part of a six-game series against the Inland Empire 66ers on Tuesday, June 18. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE GRIZZLIES: Today's game is first of 12 against the Grizzlies in 2024 and the first of six at Chukchansi Park in Fresno. Last season, the Quakes went 5-7 against the Grizzlies, just 1-5 here in Fresno.

LAST GAME: The Quakes scored twice in their final at-bat, as two in the bottom of the eighth put them ahead to stay in a 6-5 win over the Visalia Rawhide at LoanMart Field on Sunday afternoon. Samuel Munoz tied the game with an RBI single off Visalia reliever Alexis Liebano in the eighth. Liebano (1-1) then unloaded a wild pitch, scoring Logan Wagner from third with what turned out to be the game-winning run. Felix Cabrera (2-1) notched his second win of the series and Callum Wallace retired the only batter he faced to finish the game and earn his first save of the year. Jordan Thompson homered for Rancho, his team-leading eighth. River Ryan started as part of a rehab assignment, as the Dodgers' 40-man roster member retired six of the seven hitters he faced in the no-decision. The win earned a split for the Quakes in the six-game series and pulled them to within two games of first-place Lake Elsinore.

**THOMMY BOY:** Jordan Thompson had a strong offensive week against the Rawhide last week, leading the Quakes with a .348 average (8-for-23), two homers and eight RBIs. Thompson leads the team overall with eight home runs and

**SERIES WINS AND LOSSES:** Sunday's win gives them a split of the six-game set and keeps them from their third straight series loss overall, after suffering losses in five of six to Modesto followed by six straight at Lake Elsinroe. The Quakes only lost one other six-game series prior to this tough stretch that has seen Rancho drop 16 of their last 20 games overall. The last series win for the Quakes was in Visalia, back in early-May, when they took four of six. APRIL 12: On April 12, the Quakes started the day in second place in the South Division. With a win that night over Stockton, the Quakes moved into first and remained there until Friday night's game went final. That stretch came to an end last Friday in Lake Elsinore, as the Quakes were knocked from first place after their fourth straight loss to the Storm. After making up a game last week, the Quakes enter this week two games out with nine to play in the first half. Rancho's last nine games of the first half will be on the road at Fresno (6), then finishing at home with Inland Empire

**CAM DAY:** Cam Day will make his sixth start and 11th appearance of the year, his first start against Fresno. This will mark Day's first start since May 24 vs Modesto, when he gave up six runs on eight hits over just 3.1 innings in a loss. In his last outing overall, he allowed just one hit, but allowed three inherited runs to score over 4.2 innings of relief in a no-decision against Visalia on June 5. In his last outing overall, he allowed Day signed as an undrafted free agent with the Dodgers, after playing collegiately at the University of Utah.

(3). The Storm are at home against Stockton (6) and then at Visalia (3) to end the half.

**ALBERTO PACHECO:** Lefty Alberto Pachecho makes his tenth appearance and ninth start of the year, his first against Rancho. In his last outing overall, he allowed just two hits with four walks, striking out four over six scoreless innings in a win at Modesto on June 4. Pacheco made 14 starts for Fresno in 2023, going 7-4 with a 5.45 ERA over 72.2 innings of work. Pacheco was signed by the Rockies in 2019 out of the Dominican Republic.
