SWR FANS NINE BUT FISHER CATS FALL: The Fisher Cats limited the Yard Goats to just three hits on the night, but two left the yard as Hartford picked up a 5-2 victory to snap their losing skid. Simeon Woods Richardson tied his career high with nine strikeouts, but wound up picking up the loss. Reggie Pruitt delivered a two-run double in the second inning, but the Fisher Cats were held off the scoreboard in the final seven innings as batters one through four were held hitless in the loss.

THAT HITS THE SPOT: Austin Martin was hit by his 11th pitch of the season yesterday. He is tied with Justin Dean and JJ Munro for the lead across all of Double-A, and he leads the Double-A Northeast in reaching base the hard way.

THAT WAS FAST: Sean Rackoski needed just five pitches to get out of the seventh inning yesterday, recording a three-pitch strikeout and two first-pitch groundouts. Mike Ellenbest also retired the side in order in the following frame, continuing the bullpen's hot streak in recent weeks.

PRUITT DELIVERS: Reggie Pruitt took the first pitch of his first at bat into deep left field, recording a bases-loaded two run double. Prior to that at-bat, Pruitt was 0-7 when batting with the bases loaded this season.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: July 16, 2018—The first-place Fisher Cats opened a homestand with a 4-2 win over Trenton at Delta Dental Stadium. Trenton took a 2-1 lead in the top of the seventh inning, but the Fisher Cats responded with a pair in the bottom of the frame. Jon Berti tied the game with an RBI single, and Harold Ramirez, who went 4-for-4 doubled home the game-winner. Jordan Romano (6.2 IP – 2 ER), Kirby Snead (W), Dusty Isaacs, and Travis Bergen (S2) pitched.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays will be in action tonight, hosting the Texas Rangers in the first of a three-game set at Sahlen Field in Buffalo. Kevin Smith delivered a walkoff double, as the Bisons defeated Lehigh Valley 6-5. Ronny Brito homered twice, but Vancouver fell to Hillsboro 7-4. Dunedin was defeated by Clearwater 3-1 as Sem Robberse picked up his fourth loss. The FCL Jays were swept in a seven inning doubleheader by the FCL Phillies.

STARTERS:

Reilly Hovis will be on the mound for the Fisher Cats this evening. Hovis will be making his fourth start for the Fisher Cats, although the stats are not yet official for his third start as the game was suspended. The North Carolina product is coming off a four-inning outing against the Rumble Ponies in which he surrendered three runs, all earned. Hovis was signed from the Gastonia Honey Hunters of the independent Atlantic League in the last week of June.

For Hartford, Nate Harris will make just his second start of the season. A reliever for much of the year, Harris' lone start came on July 4th against Altoona; Harris went 3.2 innings giving up three home runs en route to a no decision. Opponents are hitting .308 against the Louisiana Tech product, whose only appearance against the Fisher Cats was 2.2 innings of scoreless work back on June 16th.

Johnny Barbato is expected to start the fifth game of the series on Saturday night. (bar-BAY-toh)

The Blue Jays signed Barbato, a former Major League reliever, on June 3 and he immediately moved into a starting role with the Fisher Cats.
