SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Akron RubbderDucks, 10-4, in the final home game of the 2021 season. Richmond took the lead in the second inning with a two-run single by David Villar and an RBI, ground-rule double by Frankie Tostado. In the third, Simon Whiteman brought in a run with a ground-rule double and Diego Rincones brought in two runs with a single to open the score to 6-0. Akron scored its first run in the fourth with an RBI single by George Valera. In the fifth, Villar drove in two with a double and Tostado hit a two-run homer, his 13th of the season, to extend the lead to 10-1. Akron scored two in the sixth and one in the seventh to close within six runs. Starter Michael Plassmeyer picked up his third Richmond win after allowing three runs, including two in the sixth, over 5.1 innings with six strikeouts. R.J. Dabovich and Patrick Ruotolo each tossed a scoreless inning to finish the game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. Richmond has gone 30-35 against Southeast Division opponents this season, including a 13-16 mark on the road. This series is the last set of the 2021 season. The Flying Squirrels hosted the SeaWolves at The Diamond from August 17-22 and went 5-1, winning the final five games. Today marks the latest into the calendar the Flying Squirrels have ever played a regular-season game.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 17-22 since July 21 but have won 11 of the last 16 games since August 18. They are in fourth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 12.0 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked eighth in the league with a .240 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked third in the league with a 4.00 ERA for the season.

THE SEAWOLVES have lost five of the last eight games. They went 2-3 in last week's series at Altoona. The Erie offense is ranked fourth in the league with a .253 batting average and third with 145 homers. The Erie pitching staff is ranked seventh in the league with a 4.36 ERA. Erie's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 prospects, including C Dillon Dingler (No. 4), RHP Reese Olson (No. 11), LHP Joey Wentz (No. 13), OF Daniel Cabrera (No. 16), INF Andre Lipcius (No. 22) and RHP Beau Brieske (No. 27).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Akeel Morris makes his ninth start at Double-A this season. Tonight marks his sixth start since returning to the Richmond roster from Triple-A. Last time out, Morris allowed one run over 5.0 innings in a no-decision against Akron last Wednesday. In his five starts since returning to Double-A, Morris has gone 4-0 with a 0.90 ERA (3 ER/30.0 IP) with 31 strikeouts and five walks. He made his previous five appearances, including four starts, for Triple-A Sacramento, going 1-3 with a 10.23 ERA. Morris was assigned back to Richmond on August 1. He signed with the San Francisco Giants on June 19 from the independent Long Island Ducks, where he made two starts and combined for 11.0 scoreless innings of work. Morris, a native of St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands, was drafted by the New York Mets in the 10th round in 2010 and reached the big leagues with them for the first time in 2015. He has also appeared in the majors with the Atlanta Braves and the Los Angeles Angels. After reaching free agency following the 2018 season, Morris signed with the High Point Rockers of the independent Atlantic League to begin the 2019 season, where he pitched as a reliever. He was traded to the Southern Maryland Blue Crabs and then swapped again before making an appearance to the New Britain Bees, where he finished the year going 7-4 with a 4.94 ERA in 16 outings (13 starts). FOR ERIE: Right-hander Elvin Rodriguez makes his 17th start of the season and his second against Richmond. Tonight is his first start since August 18 at The Diamond, when the Flying Squirrels plated seven runs, a season high allowed, over 4.1 innings of work. He was placed on the 7-day injured list on August 24 and reinstated today. Rodriguez was originally signed by the Los Angeles Angels in 2014. In 2017, he was the Pioneer League Pitcher of the Year before being traded to the Tigers following the season. 2021 is his first season at the Double-A level.

BIG FLIES IN BUNCHES: The Flying Squirrels have hit 38 homers in the last 22 games since August 10. In that stretch, David Villar has eight homers, Diego Rincones has six home runs, Sandro Fabian has four, Frankie Tostado, Brandon Martorano and Jacob Heyward have three, Andres Angulo, Will Wilson and Heath Quinn have two and Vince Fernandez, Shane Matheny, Mitchell Tolman, Luis Basabe and Simon Whiteman each have one. All but one active Richmond position player have homered in that span.

POWER SURGE: This season, the Flying Squirrels rank tied for fourth in the Double-A Northeast with 121 home runs. On August 24, **Andres Angulo** hit the team's 110th home run of the season, breaking the previous franchise record of 109 from 2013. This year, the team has combined for a .405 slugging percentage, which is sixth in the league but would be the highest in the franchise's history (Ahead of a .382 mark from 2013). The Flying Squirrels hit 61 homers in home games at The Diamond this year, the most in franchise history.

LEAVING THE YARD: The 2021 Flying Squirrels have seven players who have reached double-digits in home runs this season, including **David Villar** (19), **Vince Fernandez** (14), **Sandro Fabian** (13), **Frankie Tostado** (13), **Jacob Heyward** (11), **Heliot Ramos** (10) and **Diego Rincones** (10). Seven players with 10 or more homers is a new franchise record, surpassing the 2013 season, which included **Jarret Parker** (18), **Adam Duvall** (17), **Javier Herrera** (16), **Andrew Susac** (12) and **Mark Minicozzi** (10).

BACK IN THE SWING OF THINGS: On August 12 at Bowie, Villar snapped a season-high stretch of 25 games without a homer. In his last 21 games since August 12, David Villar is batting .405 (30-for-74) with eight homers, 10 doubles and 24 RBIs. Last Wednesday, he hit his 19th home run on the season, surpassing Jarrett Parker (2013) and Mario Lisson (2014) for the most home runs in a season in franchise history. He is the first Giants' Double-A player to hit 19 home runs in a season since Brett Pill in 2009 with the Connecticut Defenders. Villar is currently riding a six-game hit streak since Sept. 7, during which he is batting .429 (9-for-21) with one homer, three doubles and seven RBIs.

FABULOUS FABIAN: Over the last 22 games since August 10, **Sandro Fabian** is hitting .314 (27-for-86) with four homers and 21 RBIs. He has 13 home runs this year, which is a new career high. Fabian has picked up 17 RBIs over the last 18 games since August 14, with multiple RBIs in five of those contests. On Wednesday, he picked up three hits for the fifth time this year and the third time since August 12. He added two hits on Thursday night.

GO, DIEGO, GO!: Over his last 40 games since July 17, Diego Rincones is batting .324 (47-for-145) with 10 homers, eight doubles, one triple and 29 RBIs. Over his last 29 games since August 3, Rincones is batting .345 (38-for-110) with six homers, seven doubles and 18 RBIs. He has 12 multi-hit performances in his last 29 games played. He added a walk-off single on August 20 to cap a three-run bottom of the ninth for the Flying Squirrels in a 7-6 win over the SeaWolves. On Tuesday, he hit his 15th overall homer of the season (10 with Richmond).

TAKE A WALK: In 2019, **Jacob Heyward** set the single-season franchise record with 80 walks, surpassing the previous mark held by **Mark Minicozzi**, who walked 62 times in 2013. Heyward has walked 33 times this season. For his career with the Flying Squirrels, Heyward has worked 113 walks, which sits him in tied for first in the team's history in career walks with **Ricky Oropesa**, who walked 113 times in his four seasons with Richmond from 2013-2016.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: David Villar is ranked 10th with a .282 batting average, tied for seventh with 19 homers, fifth with a .384 OBP, fifth with a .512 SLG, fifth with an .896 OPS, fifth with 103 hits, tied for fifth with 27 doubles, tied for seventh with 46 walks, fifth with 46 extra-base hits, fourth with 187 total bases and tied for fourth with 67 runs scored. Frankie Tostado is seventh with 61 RBIs. Simon Whiteman is tied for ninth with 17 stolen bases. Trenton Toplikar is eighth with a 5.08 ERA. Toplikar and Michael Plassmeyer are tied for ninth with 84 strikeouts. Joep Marciano (37/T-3rd), Patrick Ruotolo (37/T-3rd), Frank Rubio (35/T-7th) and Matt Seelinger (34/T-10th) are in the top-10 in the league in games pitched. Patrick Ruotolo is fifth with nine saves and R.J. Dabovich is tied for 10th with six saves.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America*'s Top-30 Giants prospects: Will Wilson (10), Diego Rincones (23) and R.J. Dabovich (30). Simon Whiteman is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system and Rincones is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Wilson (15) is also ranked in MLB. com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
