Homestand Part Two

The Fightin Phils remain home for the final week of the season's first half against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. It is the 15th-of-24 matchups between the teams this season and ninth-of-12 games at FirstEnergy Stadium. Reading took the first series four to two from Apr. 7-12, then the teams split a series at Dunkin' Park from Apr. 28-May 3. Entering play today, the season-series is tied at seven.

Third Straight Defeat

The Reading Fightin Phils dropped their second straight game to the Hartford Yard Goats, falling 10-2 at FirstEnergy Stadium. Hartford jumped ahead early with back-to-back home runs from Conner Capel and Bryant Betancourt in the second inning and never looked back. Reading trimmed the deficit to 3-2 with RBI hits from Luke Ritter and Aroon Escobar in the fourth and fifth innings, but the Yard Goats pulled away with a four-run sixth inning and added three more runs in the ninth. Capel powered the Hartford offense, going 3-for-4 with three home runs and six RBI. Braydon Tucker suffered his first loss since May 19, allowing five earned runs over 5.2 innings while striking out six. Luke Ritter reached base three times in his first multi-hit game with Reading, while Bryan Rincon extended his on-base streak to 16 games. The Fightins stranded 13 runners on base and were unable to capitalize on several scoring opportunities as Hartford secured a 2-0 series lead.

Wood You Believe It

Phillies No. 2 Prospect, and top-ranked pitching prospect, makes his fifth start for the Fightin Phils and second start at FirstEnergy Stadium, on Thursday night. Through four outings, Wood has allowed five-earned runs over 14.0 IP, good for a 3.21 ERA. He has also struck out 19 batters, good for a 12.21 SO/9.0 IP ratio. Wood allowed one-earned run in each of his first-three starts before surrendering two last Thursday against Portland. He has also tossed three innings twice and four frames a pair of times. Amongst all Phillies Minor League pitchers, Wood ranks sixth with 59 total strikeouts and is second in games started with 12. Wood was promoted to Reading on May 18 from Clearwater (A), skipping High-A Jersey Shore. The 22-year old had made just nine-career starts prior to his promotion to Double-A. The Phillies selected Wood in the first round (26th overall) of the 2025 draft out of Arkansas. Tuesday was the one-year anniversary of Wood's 19-strikeout no-hitter at the 2025 College World Series with the Arkansas Razorbacks.

Going, Going, Gone

The Fightin Phils are back to hitting home runs at a torrid pace this past week, as they lifted an Eastern League-best 14 long balls through six games last week. Through 65 games, Reading has hit 79 home runs, which ranks as fourth most in the Eastern League and they are on pace for 168 this season, which comes after Reading hit 118 in 2025. The Fightin Phils were led last week by multiple home runs from Raylin Heredia (3), Caleb Ricketts (3), Alex Binelas (3) and Bryson Ware (2). Ware hit the go-ahead home run, a two-run shot, in Saturday night's 3-2 win over Portland.

Raking Raylin

Raylin Heredia has continued his steady 2026 season with another strong homestand. Over his last eight games, Heredia is slashing .387/.441/.742 (1.183 OPS), along with four runs, two doubles, three home runs and six RBI. Entering play on Thursday, Heredia leads the Eastern League with 21 doubles, while also ranking third with 70 hits, tied for second with 32 extra-base hits and third with 123 total bases.

Bring It Brito

Erick Brito's strong run with Reading continued last week as he slashed .400/.478/.700 (1.178 OPS) over six games, along with seven runs scored, three doubles, one home run, four RBI and five stolen bases. The highlight of his week was when he matched a career-high with four hits on Friday night, which featured a game-tying three-run home run in the bottom of the ninth with two outs.

Stealing Bags and Limiting Them

Since the start of June, the Fightin Phils lead the Eastern League with 25 stolen bases, leading second-place Erie by four stolen bags. Entering play on Thursday, Reading is second to Erie in the league with 105 stolen bases and is on pace for 223 this season. This came after the Fightin Phils swiped 173 bags in 2025. The last time Reading stole over 200 bags in a season was 1983, when they stole a franchise record 272 that season. On the other side of the ball, the Fightin Phils have allowed the fewest stoled bases in the Eastern League at 58 and they are second in runners caught stealing with 27.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 18, 2004: At Reading, the Phils win in their final at-bat for the third straight game as they take the first game of a double-header, 7-5. Ryan Fleming ties the game with a leadoff homer in the 7th and Ryan Howard wins it with a two-run shot three batters later. Reading completes the DH sweep with an 8-3 win in game two as Howard homers again.

Hey Hartford

The Yard Goats enter play tonight with a 37-27, which leads the Eastern League's Northeast Division by 1.5 games, in a race that will go down to the wire. Hartford had a good week against New Hampshire last week, taking five-of-seven games. Following this week, Hartford starts the second half at home against Portland. Hartford's roster features six of the Colorado Rockies Top-30 prospects: Jared Thomas (4), Griffin Herring (9), Roc Riggio (10), Jackson Cox (19), Cole Messina (21) and Konner Eaton (25).

Goats Pitcher

Righty, and Rockies' No. 19 prospect, Jackson Cox makes his second Double-A start tonight for Hartford. In his Double-A debut last Friday, Cox fired 5.1 innings, without allowing a run and striking out eight. Cox began the season with Spokane (A+), going 4-1, with a 4.23 ERA (26 ER, 55.1 IP) across 55.1 innings, with 78 strikeouts (12.69 SO/9.0 IP). He spent all of last season with Fresno (A), going 4-6, with a 3.39 ERA over 23 starts and missed all of the 2024 season. Cox began his pro career in 2023 with Fresno, making 10 appearances. The 22-year old was drafted by the Rockies in the second round of the 2022 draft out of Toutle Lake High School in Toutle, Washington, a town that is right in the middle between Seattle, Washington, and Portland, Oregon.
