CARDS DROP RUBBER MATCH IN AMARILLO 6-5: The Cardinals racked up 15 hits but could not hold on to a three-run lead as the Amarillo Sod Poodles came from behind to defeat Springfield 6-5 in the rubber match of a three-game series on Sunday evening at Hodgetown. **Jacob Buchberger** went 4-for-4, **Noah Mendlinger** had 3 hits and **Jeremy Rivas** had a pair of knocks and 2 RBIs as the bottom 3rd of the Cardinal lineup went 9-for-11 and drove in all 4 runs. Of the Cardinals' 15 hits 14 of them were singles, while Amarillo tallied 3 extra base hits, including 2 homers. The Sod Poodles with the win also took the season series 5-4.

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD



The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

HOME SWEET HOME: After struggling at home for a stretch, the Cardinals have turned things around at Hammons Field of late. Springfield has won 8 of its last 10 games at home, lifting the home record to 22-24 (.478). The recent home hot stretch follows a down period over which the Birds dropped 11 of 12 had saw their home record drop to 14-22, at that point the worst home record in the Texas League.

Away from home, the Birds are 28-16 (.636) away from Hammons Field this season, the best road winning percentage in the Texas League. Springfield's road ERA sits at 3.72 which is good for 3rd-best in the Texas League behind Frisco and Midland. The Cards' ERA at Hammons Field this season is 5.61.

HITS, HITS, HITS: The Cardinals have been the top-hitting team in the Texas League for the whole season, but the Birds have been especially base hit-happy of late. Over their last 18 games, the Cardinals are batting a league-high .299 and have less than 8 hits in just two games during that stretch while reaching double-digits 10 times. For the season, Springfield leads all of Double-A in batting average (.270) and total hits (807). The Cards have also flexed the power muscles of late, clubbing 16 homers in their last 16 games, 3rd-most in the league during that time.

CARDS LITTER LEADERBOARDS: The Cardinals have had one of the top offenses in the Texas League for the 2024 season, thanks mostly to their ability to get on base via the base hit. Entering play on Tuesday, the Cardinals boast the top 3 among qualified Texas League hitters in both batting average and OBP, as **Bryan Torres, Jimmy Crooks,** and **Jeremy Rivas** sit 1-2-3 in those two categories. **Torres** and **Nathan Church** are 1-2, respectively, in hits.

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 18 games dating back to June 23, Cardinals catcher **Jimmy Crooks** has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. The former Oklahoma Sooner is 3rd in the league among qualified hitters with a .359 average while adding 4 HR and 15 RBIs with 3 doubles and a triple. **Crooks** during that stretch is slugging .625 and has a 1.048 OPS. Among active, qualified Texas League hitters in 2024, **Crooks'** .864 OPS and .409 OBP tops in the circuit.

ANTICO NEARING MILESTONES: Cardinals OF **Mike Antico** is inching toward a pair of career milestones. **Antico's** next steal will give him 150 for his career, he is just 4 homers shy of 50 for his career sitting at 46. Over his last 10 games, **Antico** is batting .351 with 2 HR, 7 RBIs and is 3-for-3 in SB.

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: The 2024 season has been a roller coaster ride for Cardinals OF **Nathan Church**. After busting out of the gates with a red-hot April that earned him Cardinals Minor League Player of the Month batting .349 with 3 HR and a .914 OPS, the former UC Irvine Anteater slowed down from the middle of May to the end of June, batting .179 with 0 HR and a .466 OPS in 31 games from May 23-June 30.

Since the calendar flipped to July, however, **Church's** bat has heated up again to the tune of a .298 clip with 2 HR. Over his last 11 games, **Church** is batting .310 with an OPS of .846. He is currently riding a 9-game hitting streak, the longest active in the Texas League.

SPRINGFIELD'S HOME RUN KING...: With his 3-run homer in the bottom of the 5th inning on Friday night, **Chandler Redmond** etched his name atop yet another Springfield Cardinal career category. Redmond's 60th home run in a Springfield uniform moved him past Xavier Scruggs (2010-13) on the all-time franchise list, giving him the most homers in franchise history. Redmond's historic blast came off Wichita right-hander **John Stankoweicz**. For good measure, **Redmond** added another three-run shot on Saturday night off Cory Lewis, giving him home runs in back-to-back games after not leaving the yard in his past 47 contests.

Redmond also holds the Springfield franchise record for RBIs with 225.

...IS HEATING UP: After breaking the record, **Redmond** has continued swinging a hot bat. During a current 5-game hitting streak, the Cardinals slugger is 11-for-20 with 2 2B, 2 HR and 8 RBI with an 1.063 SLG and 1.651 OPS. In 10 games in July, he is batting .400 with a team-high 1.076 OPS.




