NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

The 2026 season has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha but things are trending up, with recent series wins over Toledo and St. Paul.

- After an 0-4 start to the year, the Chasers went 12-5 between April 1 and 21, then went 3-11 from April 22 to May 8 ... Omaha has won 11 of the last 20, since May 9.
- Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... last year, the Chasers had just one winning month, going 15-11 in August ... with a 13-14 record in May, the Storm Chasers were one win away from having a winning record in back-to-back months for the first time since July and August 2024.
- Prior to the win on May 24 that put the team at 25-25, the Chasers had been under .500 for 29 days, from April 24 to May 23 ... Omaha has spent 18 days at or above .500, 15 of which came consecutively in a 13-game stretch from April 10 to 24.

SERIES SPEAKING

Last week's series loss was Omaha's 3rd of the season and the team's first since dropping back-to-back series to Toledo and Louisville from April 21 to May 3.

- The Chasers have won 5 of their 9 week-long series this season - taking series against Buffalo (4-2), Iowa (3-2), Indianapolis (4-2), Toledo (4-2) and St. Paul (4-2).
- In 4 of this season's 5 series wins, Omaha won the series opener ... in 3 of the series wins - against Buffalo, Toledo and St. Paul - the clubs split the first four games before the Storm Chasers took both remaining contests to claim the series.

COMEBACK KIDS

The Storm Chasers have trailed at some point in each of their last 9 wins, with Friday's 7-6 victory representing Omaha's 16th overall comeback win this year.

- Over Omaha's last 9 wins (since May 13), the Storm Chasers have trailed for a total of 17 innings, 6.5 of those innings coming in 4 wins last week in St. Paul.
- Omaha's 16 comeback wins rank tied for the 2nd-most in the International League and tied 4th at the Triple-A level ... the Chasers' 100 comeback wins since 2024 rank 2nd-most in the International League and 3rd-most in Triple-A.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by a quartet of baserunning threats.

- Omaha's 83.6% success rate (61-for-73) ranks 4th in the IL and 6th in Triple-A.
- John Rave** leads Omaha in steals (14) ... **Gavin Cross** has 11 steals in as many tries, the 2nd-most steals in the IL without being caught ... **Kameron Misner** has swiped 9 bags, while **Tyler Tolbert** has 8 steals.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE

A constant in 2026 has been Omaha's ability to go deep in plate appearances.

- The Storm Chasers are seeing 3,999 pitches per plate appearance, 3rd-most in the International League and 6th at the Triple-A level.
- Among 199 Triple-A players with 150+ plate appearances this year, **Kameron Misner** is 5th in pitches seen/PA (4.446) while **John Rave** ranks 7th (4.395).

DON'T BRETT, SQUIRES IS HERE!

Chasers first baseman **Brett Squires** has been on fire across his first two weeks at the Triple-A level, since earning a promotion to Omaha on May 12.

- After a 1-for-15 (.067) start in his first 4 Triple-A games, Squires is 18-for-50 (.360) over his last 14 games with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 6 home runs and 15 RBI.
- Combining his Double-A and Triple-A games, Squires is hitting .293 (54-for-184) with 16 doubles, 1 triple, 13 home runs, 46 RBI and a .973 OPS ... he ranks tied 3rd among Minor Leaguers in extra-base hits (30), tied 10th in RBI, tied 12th in home runs and tied 13th in total bases (111).
- His 12 extra-base hits since May 16 are tied for 2nd-most of any player in baseball (Majors & Minors), while 43 total bases in that stretch are 4th-most in the Minors and tied 5th in baseball ... his .860 SLG since May 16 is the 3rd-best in baseball (min. 40 PA).

MAYS-TERCLASS

The Storm Chasers had one of the league's best hitters last month and a pair of strong bullpen arms.

- Luca Tresh** was one of the International League's best hitters in May, hitting .357 (25-for-70) with 9 extra-base hits and 17 RBI in 19 games, for a .953 OPS ... 21 hits in games he caught last month was tied 4th-most among MiLB catchers.
- Eric Cerantola** and **Jose Cuas** both were especially effective out of Omaha's bullpen last month ... Cerantola pitched to a 2.00 ERA (2 ER in 9.0 IP) in 8 outings while Cuas had a 2.38 ERA (3 ER in 11.1 IP) in 11 games last month.

HENRY'S HUNCH

- ROAD TO OMAHA:** Williams was assigned to Omaha on May 12 for his second stint with the Storm Chasers after making his Triple-A debut last May ... he allowed 9 ER in 8.0 innings (10.13 ERA) across 2 starts at Triple-A last year (May 27 to June 5) ... in 20 appearances (18 starts) after returning to Double-A, he posted a 4.16 ERA (45 ER in 97.1 IP) for the Naturals.
- STRENGTH AND STAMINA:** Williams got off to a hot start in 2026, allowing 2 earned runs or less while going 5.0+ innings in 4 of his last 6 starts at Double-A ... following his stretch with the Storm Chasers in 2025, Williams went back to Northwest Arkansas (AA) and pitched 5.0+ innings in 13 of his last 18 starts at Double-A.

LAST OUTING: FRIDAY, MAY 28 vs. MEMPHIS

- Made his 2nd and longest Triple-A start of the season against the Redbirds ... retired the first 8 batters he faced between the 1st and 3rd innings ... allowed a 2-out single in the 3rd inning, then immediately sat down the next hitter ... allowed a leadoff home run to **Joshua Baez** in the top of the 4th inning, then another solo home run to **Bligh Madris** with one out in the frame ... an RBI triple and throwing error allowed 2 more runs to score in the bottom of the 5th inning ... did not return for the 6th inning.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Made 7 starts for Northwest Arkansas before his promotion to Omaha ... worked a 4.72 ERA (18 ER in 34.1 IP) with a 1.37 WHIP ... 3 of his 7 starts went 5.0+ innings with 1 or less runs allowed.

CAREER NOTES

- 2025**
- Spent most of the season with Northwest Arkansas (AA), but also made a pair of starts for Omaha ... among Royals Minor League pitchers, ranked 5th in innings pitched (115.1), tied 6th in strikeouts (106) and tied 6th in starts (21).
 - Opened the year with the Naturals and threw 5 quality starts over his first 8 appearances ... made his Triple-A debut with the Storm Chasers on May 28 vs. St. Paul (MIN) ... in 2 starts for Omaha and allowed 9 ER in 8.0 IP (10.13 ERA) before returning to Northwest Arkansas on June 6 to finish his season.
 - In Northwest Arkansas, totaled 21 appearances (19 starts) and worked a 4.24 ERA (51 ER in 108.1 IP) with 100 strikeouts and a 1.37 WHIP throughout the season ... named the Texas League Pitcher of the Week for his start on July 2 @ Springfield (STL), tossing 5.0 scoreless innings with 1 hit and 7 strikeouts
- MINOR LEAGUE CAREER**
- Spent the entire 2024 season with Quad Cities (A+) ... appeared in 22 games (21 starts) with a 3.68 ERA (42 ER in 102.2 IP) and 92 strikeouts at High-A ... 7 of his 21 starts were scoreless, including his last 3 of the season, for a career-high 21.0-inning scoreless streak that stretched into April 2025.
 - Split the 2023 season between the Royals and Padres organizations ... opened the year with San Diego's Single-A affiliate, the Lake Elsinore Storm, but the Padres traded him to Kansas City at the trade deadline ... after the trade, made 5 starts for Columbia (A) and posted a 3.38 ERA (9 ER in 24.0 IP) with 23 strikeouts for the Fireflies..
