CARDS ON WRONG SIDE OF PITCHERS' DUEL, FALL 2-0: Trent Baker

and **Leonardo Taveras** combined to allow just one earned run but the Cardinals could not scratch across any runs against three Arkansas pitchers as the Birds fell 2-0 on Friday night at Dickey-Stephens Park in North Little Rock. **Baker** made his best start of the season, allowing just 1 ER on 4 H with 4 K over 5.2 IP while **Taveras** fired 2.1 hitless innings but allowed an unearned run while striking out 3. **Noah Mendlinger** had two hits for Springfield, who was shut out for the third time this season.



DPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Blas Castano** makes his 12 appearance (9th start) of the season for Arkansas...Last pitched on Sunday, June 2 against Amarillo and fired 5.0 scoreless innings allowing just 3 H while striking out a pair...Has not allowed an earned run in either of his last 2 starts, a stretch that spans 10 innings...Has only made one appearance against the Cardinals, a relief outing on April 27 in which he gave up a run on 2 H in 1.0 inning...Was ejected from the game after hitting Noah Mendlinger with a pitch...Allowed 6 ER on 3 H in just 0.1 IP at Tulsa in his first appearance of the season, but has a 1.14 ERA since over 31.2 IP (4 ER)...Spent last season split between the Yankees and Seattle...Was released by the Yankees on August 8, 2023 adn signed by the Mariners 3 days later on August 11...With New York spent time at Double-A Somerset (4-3, 4.76 ERA in 17 appearances) and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (2 appearance)...Originally signed by the Yankees in 2018 as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic...25 years old

CARDS AND TRAVS SQUARE DFF IN CRUCIAL SIX-GAME SERIES: The Cardinals make their second and final trip to North Little Rock this week for a six-game series against the Arkansas Travelers (Double-A, Seattle Mariners). Just a half game separates the two clubs coming into the series with 18 games remaining in the first half. The Cards swept a 3-game series at Dickey-Stephens Park to start the season.

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD



The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CLASSIC ROCK 106.7

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals! **ROAD WARRIORS:** The Cardinals have been more than solid on the road this season, going 19-11 away from Hammons Field. The Cards have a 3.74 ERA on the road, the 2nd best road ERA in the league behind Midland's 3.42, compared to a 5.80 mark at home.

HITS, HITS: For the greater part of the 2024 season, the Cardinals have owned the top hitting offense in Double-A with a .270 batting average, 5 points better than any other team in the level. The Cards have 6 more hits than any other Double-A team with 490 ahead of the Montgomery Biscuits with 484.

Nathan Church leads the Texas league in hits with 61, and **Bryan Torres** ranks 3rd with 56.

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats. The Cards have struck out the 3rd-fewest times in all of full-season Minor League Baseball with 392 whiffs in 55 games. The only teams with fewer strikeouts than Springfield are the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (371 K in 54 games) and Frisco RoughRiders (385 K). The Cards are averaging just 7.12 K's per game.

POWER OUTAGE: While the Cardinals have been piling up base hits, not many recently have gone over the wall. The Cards have not hit a home run in any of their last 11 games, and have hit just one longball over their last 14 contests, and 2 homers over their last 16. Springfield's last home run came on Saturday, May 25: a two-run shot by **Mike Antico** off **Orlando Ortiz-Mayr** of the Tulsa Drillers at Hammons Field. The Birds have the 2nd-fewest longballs in the Texas League with 30 on the season.

MOUND TURNAROUND: While the 2024 season has been up and down for the Cardinals pitching staff, Springfield is on a good run of late. Over their last 12 games the Cards have a team ERA of 3.03, 3rd in the Texas League during that time. During their current road trip, Springfield sports an ERA of 2.69.

FOR STARTERS: During this current 12-game roadtrip, the Cardinal starting staff has more than given the club a chance to win every time out. Since last Tuesday, Springfield starters are 3-1 with a 2.50 ERA, and only once has a Birds' starter allowed more than 2 ER (**Tink Hence** on Thursday, May 30 at Wichita). Cardinal starters are averaging 5.0 IP during that stretch, and if **Edwin Nuñez** and **Hence's** start on Wednesday (injury) are taken out of the equation, that number raises to 6.0 IP.

BIG INNINGS, LONGBALL PLAGUING CARDS STAFF: So far in

2024, home runs and the big inning have hurt the Birds. Springfield has surrendered 36 innings in which the opponent has scored 3 or more runs. In those 36 innings, the Cardinals have allowed 140 of the 277 total runs scored by the opposition, 50.5% of the runs the Birds have allowed this season. Springfield has allowed that production in just 7.7% of their innings pitched. In the other 432.2 IP Springfield has allowed 135 runs, which comes out to 2.86 runs per 9 innings. The Cardinals are 23-5 in games in which they have not allowed a "big inning". The Birds have not allowed a "big inning" in 9 of their last 10 games.

The Cardinals have also allowed 50 homers in 55 games this season, most in Double-A.

McKEITHAN BANGS UP TRAVS: Cardinals catcher **Aaron McKeithan** has saved his best for the Travelers so far in 2024. After driving in a career-high 5 runs on Thursday night, **McKeithan** is now batting .409 (9-for-22) against Arkansas this season with a home run and 8 RBIs. He's been even better at Dickey-Stephens Park going 6-for-12 with a home run and all 8 RBIs in just 3 games.

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 206.

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 23 straight games without a home run.
