



THANKS, FOG!: This week, the Cyclones and Blue Rocks are playing eight games in six days, playing a doubleheader on Wednesday and Saturday thanks to two fogged out games at Maimonides Park during the week of May 10-15. Since 2001, the Cyclones have dealt with fog outs but never in a three-day span that was experienced Thursday, Friday, and Saturday in Coney Island. In that series, Wilmington won three of the four games played, winning Tuesday, twice on Sunday, and losing Wednesday.

FIRST HALF CLOSING: The first half of the season ends next Thursday, June 23 during the six-game series with the Jersey Shore BlueClaws. The second half begins on Friday, June 24th. The first half division winners in the North and the South clinch a playoff berth against the winners of the second half. In case of a repeat winner at the top of the division, the team in that division with the best full season record is awarded the playoff spot.

BMAC ATTACK: OF Brandon McIlwain has been on base in 18 of his past 20 games. Since April 30th, McIlwain is hitting .324 with a .427 OBP in 32 games. McIlwain currently ranks first on the team with a 132 wRC+ and has already set a new career-high with 12 stolen bases. His .385 on-base percentage leads all qualified Mets Minor Leaguers and he has five triples which is tied with Low-A St. Lucie OF Alex Ramirez for the Mets MiLB lead.

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn returns to Frawley Stadium for the first time since the opening weekend of the season. In the season series, Wilmington has won six of the eight games. The Blue Rocks host five of Washington's Top 30 prospects, including No. 11 OF Yasel Antuna, No. 15 LHP Mitchell Parker, No. 24 C Israel Pineda, No. 25 OF Ricardo Mendez, and No. 27 INF Jordy Barley.

ROUGH N' ROWDEY: OF Rowdey Jordan, the Mets' 11th-round selection out of Mississippi State, has been well-rounded in his first full season. The Brooklyn outfielder leads the team with 70 total bases and 16 doubles to lead the entire Mets organization.

PEROZA PEAKING: With hits in six of his past eight games, INF Jose Peroza has increased his batting average up 26 points (.195 to .221) and his on-base percentage (.288 to .302) 14 points. In his past three games, the Venezuelan is 6-for-14 with a walk, a triple, and five RBIs.

PALMER'S POP: Brooklyn native OF Jaylen Palmer, the team's top prospect according to MLB Pipeline (No. 14), leads the club with six home runs, including a grand slam to win the game Sunday against Aberdeen. His career high is seven home runs which game during his second professional season in 2019, playing with Rookie-level Kingsport.

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs in Coney Island, Brooklyn has completely turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 21 home runs in the past 22 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

'CLONES ON THE RISE: OF Jake Mangum and INF Luke Ritter, two Cyclones from both the 2019 and 2021 clubs, are now with Triple-A Syracuse.

LAST TIME OUT: Santos pitched against Aberdeen last week, lasting a season-high six innings in a loss to the Iron-Birds.

HIGH-RANKING MEMBER: Santos ranks as the top pitching prospect on the staff, ranking No. 16 according to *MLB Pipeline* and No. 17 according to *Baseball America*.

NSYNC: Santos had been a much more dominant pitcher in May after a rocky April. In May, the 20-year-old righty had a 2.25 ERA with a 21% strikeout rate and a 12% walk rate after an 8.03 ERA in four April starts with an 18% strikeout rate and 16% walk rate. In April, Santos did not make it into the fifth inning but has lasted into the fifth inning three times in May.

BREAKOUT: The 20 year old pitched with Low-A St. Lucie in 2021, tossing 96 innings which doubles the workload he turned in in 2019 (40.2 IP) and 2018 (45). This season marks the second full season assignment for the righty.
