Nuñez's 11th long ball of the season opened the second inning to give Indy a short-lived lead, but Navarreto tied the game in the home half, scoring Miller on a groundout. Nashville busted the game open with four runs in the fourth and three more in the fifth to mount an 8-1 lead. Brian Navarreto provided the tiebreaking knock with a double off Aaron Shortridge to bring home Owen Miller. Vinny Capra, who played for Indianapolis in 2023, capped the four-run burst with a two-out, two-run single. In the ensuing frame, Miller knocked a run-scoring single before Chris Roller smacked a ground-rule double. He was named Indianapolis' July Player of the Month after he hit safely in 15 of 18 games while leading the team in doubles. His hot streak has extended into August, and since June 28 he is hitting .337 (31-for-92) with 16 runs, 11 extra-base hits and 21 RBI. Since his hit streak began on July 23, he is hitting .385 (15-for-39) with six runs, two doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI and five walks to just five strikeouts. MATT MASHED: Matt Gorski launched his 17th home run in the ninth inning last night, marking the most home runs by an Indians batter since Mason Martin in 2022. It was his first home run since July 19, the first game out of the All-Star break, when he homered in his second consecutive game. Luis Cessa: Right-hander Luis Cessa is set to make his ninth outing (eighth start) with the Indians tonight after being signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on June 10. He began the season with Omaha and went 2-2 with a 3.89 ERA (17er/39.1ip).
