YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to Chesapeake Baysox, 10-6. Chesapeake opened the scoring in the top of the second inning. Silas Ardoin hit a solo homer and Adam Retzbach added a three-run homer later in the inning to open a 4-0 lead. In the fourth, Jeremiah Jackson cleared the bases with a three-run double and scored on a single by Ardoin to stretch the Baysox lead to 8-0. Frederick Bencosme added a solo homer in the fifth to push the advantage to 9-0. The Flying Squirrels broke the shutout in the bottom of the fifth. **Aeverso Arteaga** belted a three-run homer, his first at Double-A. Later in the inning, **Jairo Pomares** hit a two-run shot, his third of the year, to cut the deficit to 9-5. Creed Willems hit Chesapeake's fourth home run of the game, a solo shot, in the top of the ninth to extend the lead to 10-5. **Carter Howell** capped the scoring with a two-out, RBI single in the bottom of the ninth.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Chesapeake Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Today celebrates the 40th anniversary of the first game at The Diamond on April 17, 1985.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 8,392 fans per home game, which leads all 120 MiLB clubs.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS went 2-4 in last week's road trip to Harrisburg, dropping four-of-five after winning the opener. Their 2-9 start is the worst in team history. In 2015, the team opened with a 3-2 record before losing their next 15 consecutive games to start the year 3-17. The 2015 team finished with a 72-68 record.

THE BAYSOX split last week's series against the SeaWolves at home after taking two-of-three at Altoona the previous weekend to begin the season. Bowie's roster includes five players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects, including OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. (No. 6), RHP Patrick Reilly (No. 16), RHP Trace Bright (No. 17), RHP Alex Pham (No. 26) and RHP Zach Fruit (No. 30). Five players are ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including Bradfield (No. 3), Reilly (No. 10), C Creed Willems (No. 12), Bright (No. 25) and Pham (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **John Michael Bertrand** makes his third start of the season and the sixth of his career against the Baysox. In his previous five starts against the Baysox, he is 2-0 with a 0.60 ERA (2 ER/30.0 IP). Bertrand started on Opening Day for the Flying Squirrels on April 4 against Akron, becoming the first pitcher to start back-to-back season openers for the Flying Squirrels. Last year, he was named the Flying Squirrels' Pitcher of the Year after going 7-9 with a 4.32 ERA in 28 outings (27 starts). Bertrand also won the team's Community Service Award. He made two starts with Triple-A Sacramento to close the year. For the year, Bertrand led all Eastern League pitchers with 10 scoreless starts, all at least five innings. He also led all MiLB pitchers defensively in assists (31) and ranked second in total chances (38). He finished the season ranked first among all MiLB pitchers in double plays induced (23), five ahead of the next closest pitcher. Bertrand was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice last year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. Entering 2025, he is rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system for the second straight year. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. **For more on Bertrand, see page two.**

FOR CHESAPEAKE: Right-hander Zach Fruit makes his third start of the year and his first in his career against the Flying Squirrels. He made his Double-A debut on April 5 at Altoona and threw 4.2 scoreless innings, striking out four. In his last outing, he pitched on Saturday in Bowie and surrendered seven runs without recording an out. In his professional debut season last year with High-A Aberdeen, he went 3-4 with a 3.03 ERA in 25 games (21 starts). Fruit is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 30 Orioles prospect. He was selected in the ninth round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Troy University. He also spent at a junior college in Lansing, Mich. and pitched two seasons at Eastern Michigan.

HOWELL AT THE MOON: **Carter Howell** was named the 2024 Flying Squirrels Player of the Year in his first Double-A season. He spent all of last year in Richmond. For the season, he led the Eastern League in doubles (30) and triples (7). He also led the Flying Squirrels in batting average (.272), on-base percentage (.347), slugging percentage (.391), OPS (.738), hits (121), walks (47), extra-base hits (40), total bases (174), runs (64) and stolen bases (15). Through his first 11 games of 2025, Howell has reached base 21 times.

BERI BOMBS: **Victor Bericoto** hit two homers on Sunday afternoon at Harrisburg, belting a three-run homer in the first and a solo home run in the seventh. It was the first two-homer game of his Double-A career and the second of his professional career. He also had a two-homer game in 2023 with High-A Eugene. The two homers on Sunday moved Bericoto into ninth place on the Flying Squirrels' career home run list with 24. His next homer will tie him with **Frankie Tostado** for eighth with 25. In his last three games dating back to Sunday, Bericoto has five extra-base hits with two homers and three doubles.

PLAY THE HITS: The Flying Squirrels have collected 84 hits through their first 11 games this season, which is the third-most in the Eastern League. The team is batting .237 (84-for-355), which is fourth-highest in the league. However, the Richmond offense is batting .168 (16-for-95) with runners in scoring position, which is last in the league.

PINCH ME!: In the second game of Saturday's doubleheader, **Jairo Pomares** hit a single while pinch-hitting in the top of the seventh inning. It was the Flying Squirrels' first pinch hit since 2023. During the 2024 season, Richmond pinch-hitters went 0-for-36 on the year with three walks and 18 strikeouts. The 36 pinch-hit at-bats ranked third in the minors on the season, trailing only Buffalo (10-for-40) and Las Vegas (13-for-38). No MiLB team in the digitized-stats era, which dates back to 2005, has more pinch-hit at-bats without a hit than last year's Richmond team.

FAMILIAR FACES: This year's season-opening Flying Squirrels roster includes 22 players who have previously played for the Flying Squirrels. There are six players who have made their team debuts, including **Aeverso Arteaga**, **Sabin Ceballos**, **Manuel Mercedes**, **Rodolfo Nolasco**, **Braxton Roxby** and **Joe Whitman**. Roxby, acquired from the Reds in a trade earlier this year, is the only newcomer with previous Double-A experience.

WHERE DID THESE GUYS COME FROM?: There are players from six different counties on the Flying Squirrels' Opening Day roster, including the United States (20 players), Venezuela (3), the Dominican Republic (2), Cuba (1), Panama (1) and Puerto Rico (1). Among the 20 American-born players, 11 different states are represented, including North Carolina (3), Florida (3), Ohio (3), California (2), Michigan (2), Pennsylvania (2), Kentucky (1), Minnesota (1), North Dakota (1), Rhode Island (1) and Texas (1). There are 11 players who joined the Giants organization out of the MLB Draft, six were signed as non-drafted free agents, six as international free agents, four who were picked up in trades and one who was claimed in the minor-league phase of the Rule 5 Draft. For 23 players, the Giants were their original affiliated organization and five have played with other major-league organizations.

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: Last season, 14 former Flying Squirrels players reached the majors for the first time. That was the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including **Joe Panik**, **Adam Duval**, **Andrew Susac**, **Matt Duffy**, **Jackson Williams**, **Edwin Escobar**, **Hunter Strickland**, **Chris Dominguez**, **Gary Brown**, **Brett Bochy** and **Chris Heston**. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors last season were **Erik Miller** (2023 Flying Squirrels), **Landen Rouppe** (2022-23), **Kai-Wei Teng** (2022-23), **Nick Avila** (2022), **Randy Rodriguez** (2022-23), **Mason Black** (2023), **Gerson Garabito** (2021), **Spencer Bivens** (2023), **Raymond Burgos** (2023), **Hayden Birdsong** (2023-24), **Parker Dunshee** (2023), **Grant McCray** (2024), **Sandro Fabian** (2021) and **Trevor McDonald** (2024). **Christian Koss** (2024) made his debut for the Giants earlier this week as the first former Flying Squirrel in the majors this year. Dating back to 2022, 23-of-the-last-26 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers), Fabian (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. The 2023 season saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Victor Bericoto** is tied for third in extra-base hits (6), tied for third in total bases (22), tied for fourth in hits (12), tied for fourth in home runs (2), ninth in SLG (.550) and ninth in OPS (.967). **Jairo Pomares** is tied for third in home runs (3), sixth in total bases (21) and 10th in SLG (.538).

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes six players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Joe Whitman** (No. 10), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 13), **Sabin Ceballos** (No. 16), **Trent Harris** (No. 26), **Aeverso Arteaga** (No. 27) and **Jack Choate** (No. 28). There are also six players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27).

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1985: The Diamond opened for its first game, welcoming a crowd of 12,435. Connie Joyce, daughter of Dr. William Parker, threw out of the ceremonial first pitch, caught by Larry Owen. Steve Shields started the game for the Richmond Braves and allowed one unearned run over eight innings in a losing decision as the R-Braves lost to the Syracuse Chiefs, 2-1. **1993:** The Richmond Braves beat the Rochester Red Wings, 6-3, at The Diamond. Facing Fernandez Valenzuela on a rehab assignment, the R-Braves posted three runs in the first inning. Ramon Caraballo brought in Keith Mitchell with a single. Chipper Jones reached on an infield single that scored a run and later scored an a single by Melvin Nieves. After Rochester tied the score, 3-3, in the fourth, Mike Kelly hit a go-ahead single for a 4-3 lead in the bottom of the inning. Jones rounded out the scoring with an RBI hit in the sixth. **2022:** In 2022, the Flying Squirrels beat the Altoona Curve, 6-2, at The Diamond. Will Wilson won the game with a walk-off grand slam in the bottom of the 10th inning.
