JACKSONVILLE WINS LOW-SCORING AFFAIR

Behind 5.0 innings of one-run ball from Morgan McSweeney and a home run and two RBIs from Deyvison **De Los Santos**, Jacksonville edged Gwinnett 3-2. A De Los Santos RBI single in the first gave the Jumbo Shrimp an early advantage. McSweeney's scoreless innings streak ended at 22.1 on Jason Delay's fifth-inning RBI single. Jacksonville regained the lead on a Victor Mesa Jr. RBI base knock in the sixth. De Los Santos went deep in the eighth, helping provide the cushion when Eddys Leonard homered for the Stripers in the ninth to make it 3-2.

FOUR SCORE AND SEVEN YEARS AGO

Heading into play on Saturday, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in 23 of their last 30 games (76.7 percent), including 19 contests with five tallies or more. Prior to this stretch, Jacksonville had plated four runs or more in just 30 of their first 63 games (47.6 percent). Perhaps the biggest reason for the increase in runs scored has been home runs; the Jumbo Shrimp rank tied for second in Triple-A with 47 home runs over the last 30 games. They swatted just 52 bombs over the first 63 games of the season, tied for 26th in Triple-A.

MARSEE-SAW

Heading into play on June 8, Jakob Marsee was hitting just .193 with a .651 OPS. Since that point, the Allen Park, Mich., native has registered hits in 23 of his 30 starts, including 11 contests with multiple hits. During this stretch, Marsee is 37-for-113 (.327/.421/.655/1.076 at the plate with six doubles, two triples, nine home runs, 21 RBIs, 19 walks and 21 runs scored. On the season, Marsee leads the IL in steals (42) and walks (60) while sharing the league lead in triples (5). He also ranks tied for 19th in home runs (12), 24th in OBP (.375) and tied for 24th in runs scored (47).

BERRY BLAST

Jacob Berry mustered just a .126 batting average and .452 OPS with 35 strikeouts through his first 30 games on the season. The former LSU Tiger has completely changed around his season since that point. Over his last 45 games Berry has drawn more walks (23) than strikeouts (22) while going 42-for-136 (.309/.417/.493/.910) at the plate with 11 doubles, one triple, four home runs, 22 RBIs and 24 runs.

AND SHE THINKS WE'RE JUST FISHIN'

Jacksonville is now 11-2 against Gwinnett this season. meaning 19.3 percent of their wins have come at the hands of the Stripers. The Jumbo Shrimp have outscored their fishy foe by an extraordinary 51-23 margin, an average of 3.9-1.8 per game, while outhitting the Stripers 92-68 and outstealing them 32-5. Meanwhile, Jacksonville pitching has held Gwinnett to a .178/.248/.277/.525 batting line through these 13 games - the Stripers have been shut out four times and scored more than three runs in a game against the Jumbo Shrimp just twice thus far in 2025.

THE MORE. THE MERRIER

In 2024, Jacksonville shattered the city's previous Double-A/ Triple-A era (1962-present) record of 20 different starting pitchers over the course of the season and used 28 different starters in 149 games. Meanwhile, through 93 games this season, the Jumbo Shrimp have already used 26 different starting pitchers. Perhaps unsurprisingly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have totaled just 363.2 innings (3.9 per start) this season, the sixth-fewest in Triple-A. That said, their 3.66 starters' ERA ranks third at the level.

MACKTION

In 30 games from May 10-June 21, Joe Mack went just 18-for-113 (.159) at the plate, totaling just a .428 OPS. The East Amherst, N.Y., native has been on an absolute tear over his last 15 games, however. During this stretch, Mack is a whopping 24-for-59 (.407/.435/.814/1.249) with six doubles, six home runs, 11 RBIs, three walks and 13 runs scored. Mack was the first Jumbo Shrimp to be selected for the MLB All-Star Futures Game since Sixto Sánchez in 2019.

SHRIMP BITES

Prior to giving up a run with two outs in the fifth inning on Friday, Morgan McSweeney's 22.1 scoreless innings streak was the longest for a Jacksonville pitcher since Sixto Sánchez's 24.0-inning run from July 23-August 10, 2019... The Jumbo Shrimp have committed just two errors in their last eight games, tied for the second-fewest in Triple-A. Their 78 errors in the first 85 games of the season were the second-most in Triple-A... At 57-36 (.613), Jacksonville is off to its best start since the 2007 Jacksonville Suns started the campaign 58-35 (.624).

ABOUT PATRICK

-Monteverde is the youngest child from a massive family. He is the youngest of 27 grandchildren on his dad's side and the youngest of 18 grandchildren on his mom's side. Both of Monteverde's parents are the youngest of twelve.

-A native of Pittsburgh, Monteverde started his collegiate baseball career at Divison III Virginia Wesleyan (Norfolk, Va.) for a season, posting a 1.96 ERA in 82 2/3 innings. In 2018, he moved up a rung, transferring to Division II Seton Hill in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, about 45 minutes from Monteverde's home. He had a solid first year there in 2018 (3.04 ERA), but three starts into his second season with the Griffins, he heard a pop in his elbow and underwent Tommy John surgery. Monteverde made just one more start for Seton Hill in 2020 before the COVID pandemic then shut down the season for him.

-Monteverde completed his collegiate career by transferring to Texas Tech University for the 2021 season. He went 7-4 with a 3.75 ERA, leading the Red Raiders in wins, starts (16), innings pitched (86.1) and strikeouts (101).

2025 SEASON

--Monteverde made his major league debut on April 19 for the Marlins in a game at the Philadelphia Phillies. He pitched 3.2 innings, striking out four.

2024 SEASON

-Held left-handed batters to a .247/.286/.425/.711 line in 158 plate appearances. However, right-handed hitters slashed .264/.340/.508/.848 against him in 335 plate

-With the bases empty, opponents had a .227/.288/.433/.721 batting line against Monteverde. However, with runners on, that swelled to .314/.383/.566/.949.

2023 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Jacksonville on July 25 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, he led the Southern League in wins (8), ERA (2.44) and WHIP (1.11) while ranking second in both innings pitched (84.2) and batting average against (.207), tied for eighth in strikeouts (90) and tied for 14th in games

-Made 21 total starts with Pensacola in 2022. Led team in wins (10), innings pitched (114.0), strikeouts (114), double plays (T-1st, 11).

-Monteverde's favorite pitcher growing up was Clayton Kershaw.

-His favorite book is "To Kill a Mockingbird" and favorite movie is "American Pie."
