**Scouting Report:** The Patriots have taken the first two games of their six-game set against the Reading Fightin Phils. Reading owns the league's worst record (4-22) and ERA (6.64). As a team the Fightin Phils are hitting just .195, second-worst in all of Double-A.

**Answer That:** The Somerset Patriots scored five unanswered runs from the seventh inning on to come from behind and beat the Reading Fightin Phils 5-4 in ten innings last night. The five-run comeback is the largest come from behind victory for the Patriots this season. Diego Castillo tied the game with a two-run home run with two outs in the ninth. After Greg Weissert pitched a scoreless top of the tenth, Isiah Gilliam hit a walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the tenth.

On Assignment: New York Yankees left-handed relief pitcher Zack Britton gave up a tworun home run in his one inning of work on Wednesday evening. It was the lefty's second major league rehab appearance after pitching a scoreless frame against New Hampshire in game one of a doubleheader on Saturday 5/29. The two-time all-star is expected to pitch one more time for the Patriots before returning to the Bronx.

**Gil Turn:** Luis Gil makes his sixth start for the Patriots tonight. Gil, who turned 23 yesterday, owns a 1.69 ERA and is coming off of a six inning outing, his longest of the season. Last time out against New Hampshire Gil allowed just two hits and a run en route to his first win of the 2021 season.

**Belly to Belly:** The Patriots hit back-to-back home runs on two separate occasions Tuesday night. Diego Castillo and Donny Sands did it in the first inning, while Sands and Dermis Garcia followed up in the third inning. It marked the second and third times the Patriots have hit back-to-back home runs in their last five games, respectively, and the fourth overall time this season.

Digging the Long-Ball: Somerset set a new single-game high with five home runs in Tuesday night's game, including a pair of multi-home run games for Donny Sands and Dermis Garcia. The team now has 34 home runs collectively on the season, tied for the most in the Double-A Northeast League (34, Bowie) and tied for third-most in all of Double-A (38, Birmingham). Garcia leads the team and is tied for second in the league with nine home runs, and is also tied for fifth in the league in RBI (19).

Hits and Misses: The Patriots pitching staff owns the second-lowest ERA (2.75) and has struck out the most batters (312) in all of Double-A baseball. The team also boasts the lowest WHIP (1.05) and the second-lowest batting average against (.188) amongst all Double-A teams. The team's 1.05 WHIP is the lowest across all levels of Minor League Baseball. The pitchers have struck out double digit batters in 20 of 25 contests this season, including in 11 of their last 13 games.
