LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn dropped Sunday afternoon's series finale to Hudson Valley, 7-1...SS Jett Williams led off the game with a solo home run to left...The 19-year-old went 2-for-3 with a walk...Cyclones were limited to just 4 hits...CF Spencer Jones tied the game for the Renegades with a solo home run in the 3rd...He was 3-for-4 with a walk and 2 runs scored...DH Christopher Familia provided a go-ahead 2-run single later in the frame...LF Jared Wegner added a solo home run in the 4th...It Jesús Rodríguez tallied a pair of knocks — including a double — and an RBI...RHP Brendan Beck (4.2 IP), LHP Clay Aguilar (1.0), RHP Luis Velasquez (2.1), and RHP Cole Ayers (1.0) united on the 4-hitter...Renegades also stole 6 bases, including 3 from 3B Ben Cowles.

THE JETT AND JACOB SHOW: INFs Jett Williams and Jacob Reimer made their Cyclones debuts on August 1 and have been stellar all summer long...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing .327, 485f.615 with a 1100 OPS, 20 runs scored, 11 doubles, 2 triples, 5 home runs, 10 RBI, 31 walks, and 13 stolen bases in 31 games between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie...On the season, Williams is 8th in Minor League Baseball in walks (85)... Among teenagers, Williams ranks 2nd in Milk...Since making his SAL debut, the Rockwall, Texas, native leads the circuit (min. 75 PA) in batting average (.311), on-base percentage (.462), and OPS (1.036)...He is also 1st in doubles (7), tied for 2nd in stolen bases (7), 3rd in walks (16), 5th in total bases (35), and tied for 5th in hist (19)...Since June 1, Reimer has recorded a .2871.4271.433 slash line with a .860 OPS, 38 runs scored, 8 doubles, 6 home runs, 33 RBI, 36 walks, and 9 hit-bypitches in 54 games between 3 levels in the Mets' system.

WELCOME BACK: C Kevin Parada and INF Chase Estep were reinstated from the Cyclones' 7-day injured list prior to Tuesday's series opener...Parada landed on the injured list on July 28, while Estep was placed there on August 3...Parada started a rehab assignment with Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...The 22-year-old went 1-for-13 with an RBI and 2 walks in 4 games...Prior to landing on the injured list, Parada was slashing .301/.361/.525 with an .885 OPS, 7 home runs, and 22 RBI in his last 37 games with the club...Estep was equally hot, posting a .296/.377/.341 slash line with a .718 OPS, 2 doubles, and 7 RBI in his previous 14 games before landing on the IL.

DOWN THE STRETCH THEY COME: Brooklyn's looking to manufacture a second-straight playoff appearance and has dropped just 2 of their last 9 series since Greenville won 4-of-6 on Coney Island from June 6-11...The Cyclones are 6-2-2 in their last 10 sets...The Cyclones are 28-20 in the second half and are tied for the lead in the North Division of the SAL with Jersey Shore (28-20) with 18 games left to play...The BlueClaws hold the tiebreaker over Brooklyn as a result of winning the season series (15-11).

**LUGO LAND:** INF **William Lugo** collected a pair of extra-base hits — a double and a triple — in addition to 4 RBI in Saturday night's win over Hudson Valley...Over the last 3 games against the Renegades, the 21-year-old is 6-for-14 (429) at the plate with a run scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 6 RBI, and a walk...Over the course of Brooklyn's 2-week homestand, Lugo slashed .325/.413/.450 with a .863 OPS in 12 games...The Dominican native has scored 2 runs, picked up 3 doubles, a triple, 6 RBI, and 5 walks during that span...Entering play on Tuesday, Lugo's batting average is 85 points higher at home than on the road (.266 to .181) and his OPS is 257 points higher (.810 to .553).

SUPER STANLEY: OF Stanley Consuegra fancied himself another multi-home run game in Brooklyn's win over Hudson Valley on Friday night...The 22-year-old blasted a solo home run off RHP Leonardo Pestana in the bottom of the 2nd and added a go-ahead, 3-run clout off LHP Joel Valdez in the bottom of the 5th...The multi-home run night marked the second of the season for Consuegra...Stanley tallied a pair of solo blasts in a 6-4 loss at Hudson Valley on July 19...He and C Kevin Parada (6/23 vs. HV & 7/15 vs. GBO) are the only two players to post multi-homer contests for Brooklyn in 2023...Since the Minor League stat portal began in 2005, Consuegra and Parada are just 2-of-3 Cyclones to post multiple 2-plus home run games...INF Nick Evans accomplished the feat in 2005 on July 22 vs. Jamestown and again on August 24 at Williamsport...Entering Sunday, Consuegra (21) is one home run behind C Francisco Álvarez (22) for Brooklyn's all-time home run record...He is tied for 7th in the SAL in home runs (16) and 9th in slugging percentage (.457).

BIG RED DAWG: OF Ryan Clifford was added to Brooklyn's roster on August 3...The 20-year-old was acquired by the New York Mets with OF **Drew Gilbert** from the Houston Astros in exchange for RHP **Justin Verlander** on August 1...The 2022 11th-round pick enters Tuesday ranked 3rd in the South Atlantic League in slugging percentage (.500)...Greenville's INF **Blaze Jordan** (.533) is 1st...He is also 5th in OPS (.839) and tied for 4th in home runs (18)...Clifford is also 1st in isolated power (.250), and 8th in wOBA (.371) and wRC+ (124).

THE RHY-T STUFF: In 31 games since July 4 at Wilmington, OF Rhylan Thomas has put up bonkers numbers...He is slashing .358/410/.462 with a .872 OPS at the dish and a 141 wRC+... Thomas has added 13 runs scored, 5 doubles, 2 home runs, 13 RBI, and 10 walks to only 7 strikeouts (6.0 K%)...Since July 18 at Hudson Valley, the left-handed swinger is slashing .368/.415/.494 with a .909 OPS and 150 wRC+ in 25 games...Since the start of July, Thomas leads the South Atlantic League in batting average (.349) and has 5 fewer strikeouts (8) than any other batter (min. 120 PA).

REIM TIME: INF Jacob Reimer collected 4 hits — all singles — a run scored and an RBI in Brooklyn's loss to Hudson Valley on Friday night...The 4 knocks were a career-high...Reimer became the first teenager to record 4-or-more hits for the Cyclones in a single game since INF Gavin Cecchini accomplished the feat twice on August 17, 2013, vs. Vermont and on August 3 at Jamestown...1B Nick Evans is the only other teenager to accomplish the feat since 2005...He went 4-for-4 vs. Staten Island on September 1, 2005...Reimer is the youngest of the three to accrue a 4-hit night.

**BEST IN SHOW:** Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball... Entering Tuesday, Brooklyn has posted a Mil.B-low 3.22 ERA (257 ER in 718.0 IP) over their last 82 games, holding a 45-37 record in that span...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (3.33) is 2nd in the minors...The Cyclones have hurled 9 shutouts — which is tied for 3rd in Mil.B — in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 27.6% and a walk rate of 10.7%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 2nd lowest opposing OPS (631), in addition to the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (7.04) and batting average against (.213) in that period.

**BULLPEN BOOM:** The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at finishing off games in 2023... Entering Tuesday, Brooklyn holds the best bullpen ERA (3.46) in the entire South Atlantic League and the 3rd-lowest throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (3.16) leads Mil.B and Jersey Shore (3.56) is 2nd in the SAL...5 of the top 20 SAL relievers in ERA (min.

vs. ASHEVILLE: Brooklyn begins a 2-week road trip with 6 games against the Astros' High-A affiliate...The Tourists possess 4 of Houston's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: OF Jacob Melton (1), RHP Miguel Ullola (13), OF Zach Cole (18), RHP Nolan DeVos (24)...Brooklyn and Asheville are meeting for the second time in each franchise's history...Both squads met at McCormick Field to open the 2021 season...The Tourists took 3-of-5 games in the series from May 4-9...The final game of that series was canceled due to weather.

20.0 IP) have pitched for the Cyclones this year...RHP **Benito García** (1.00, 1st), RHP **Dylan Tebrake** (1.17; 3rd), RHP **Brendan Hardy** (1.61, 6th), RHP **Paul Gervase** (1.72, 8th), and LHP **Eli Ankeney** (1.85; 11th).

THE AMAZING ALEX: OF Alex Ramírez is shooting for the number top spot like a hole in one and is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4... Entering Tuesday, the Dominican native is 2nd in franchise history in RBI and is 8 (83) behind INF José Peroza (91) for the all-time mark...He surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (36), is 2nd in total bases (229), hits (156), and walks (69), and 3rd in runs scored (82)...Ramírez is 6 hits behind Peroza (162) for the franchise record.

THE ANK-OR: Between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie, LHP Eli Ankeney has left batters thirsting for knocks and has accrued a 1.51 ERA (6 ER in 35.2 IP) in 23 appearances (1 start)...Among Minor League pitchers with 35.0-plus innings pitched and 1-or-fewer starts, Ankeney is 10th in ERA (1.51)... Ankeney is also tied for 1st in fewest hits allowed (17)...Since making his Brooklyn debut on June 3 at Jersey Shore, the Phoenix, Ariz. native is 2nd among South Atlantic League relievers with 25.0-plus IP in hits allowed (15), 3rd in ERA (2.03), and 4th in batting average against (167).

YO-JOANDER: RHP Joander Suárez continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...With his 7 strikeouts vs. Hudson Valley on Friday night, the Cumaná, Venezuela native is now tied with RHP Blade Tidwell for the franchise single-season record in strikeouts with 112...Tidwell set the mark earlier this season...The 23-year-old set a new career-high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 innings in a shutout victory vs. Aberdeen last Friday night...Over his last 11 appearances (10 starts) since June 14 at Aberdeen, Suárez holds only a 3-5 record, but a 3.73 ERA (21 ER in 50.2 IP), 15 walks (7.1 BB%), and 73 strikeouts (34.4 K%)...Narrowed down to his last 7 starts, the Cumaná, Venezuela native is 1-4, yet holds a 3.16 ERA (13 ER in 37.0 IP) with 8 walks (5.2 BB%) and 54 strikeouts (35.1 K%)...Since the start of July, Suárez ranks 2nd among SAL pitchers in strikeouts (57) trailing only Greensboro's RHP Thomas Harrington (59).

GRAB A SEAT: RHP Joander Suárez put hitters to shame and became the 5th different Cyclone pitcher to strike out 10 or more batters in a game in 2023 when he whiffed 11 IronBirds on August 11...RHP Jordany Ventura punched out 10 vs. Aberdeen on August 9, RHP Cameron Foster K'd 12 vs. Wilmington on July 29, RHP Tyler Stuart struck out 11 vs. Hudson Valley on June 22, and RHP Blade Tidwell accomplished the feat on 4 separate occasions...Only Greenville has had more pitchers (6) strike out 10-plus hitters in a game this year...Since 2005, only one other Brooklyn squad had 5 different arms punch out 10 or more in a single game during a season...In 2013, LHP Dario Álvarez (12; 7/24 @ LOW), RHP Miller Díaz (11; 8/23 @ VER), RHP Robert Gsellman (13; 8/24 @ VER), RHP Dawrin Frías (11; 8/27 vs. TRI), and RHP John Gant (7/26 @ ABD).

SHUCKED: RHP Joshua Cornielly has hit his stride for the Cyclones' bullpen...Since allowing 5 runs in 0.1 innings on April 15 at Winston-Salem, the 22-year-old has been as consistent as any relief arm on the staff...Dating back to April 21 vs. Wilmington, Cornielly holds a 2-2 record with a 2.18 ERA (10 ER in 41.1 IP) and 1 save in 23 appearances (1 start)...The Caraças, Venezuela native has permitted 33 hits, walked 11 (6.5 BB%), and struck out 49 (29.2 K%)...Since July 30 vs. Wilmington, Cornielly has made 5-straight scoreless appearances...The right-hander has not allowed a run on 3 hits over his last 9.1 innings without issuing a walk and striking out 10 (32.3 K%).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Baseball America released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects last Wednesday...10 members of the 2023 squad are featured...OF Ryan Clifford (No. 3), SS Jett Williams (4), C Kevin Parada (7), RHP Blade Tidwell (9), RHP Christian Scott (10), OF Alex Ramírez (12), 3B Jacob Reimer (14), RHP Tyler Stuart (22), RHP Raimon Gómez (24), and RHP Jordany Ventura (29)...Williams (No. 98) and Clifford (99) also appear on the publication's list of Top 100 prospects...Former Cyclones listed include INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 6), RHP Mike Vasii (8), RHP Dominic Hamel (19), OF Matt Rudick (20), and RHP Junior Santos (27)... all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island...MLB Pipeline released their updated list last Thursday evening...8 members of the 2023 team are recognized...SS Jett Williams (No. 3), C Kevin Parada (5), OF Ryan Clifford (6), RHP Blade Tidwell (10), OF Alex Ramírez (11), RHP Christian Scott (12), IF Jacob Reimer (13), RHP Tyler Stuart (17), and RHP Raimon Gómez (25)...Former Brooklyn stars featured are: IF Ronny Mauricio (No. 4), RHP Mike Vasii (9), RHP Dominic Hamel (16), and OF Matt Rudick (27)...Williams (No. 84), Mauricio (93), and Parada (96) are recognized in the Top 100.

DE RECORD SETTER: OF Omar De Los Santos entered as a pinch-runner and caught Hudson Valley napping to steal second base on July 21, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 36 swipes breaks INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Pena League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 105 stolen bases in that span, which is 7th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (118), Mariners farmhand OF Jonatan Clasé (116), D'Backs prospect OF Wilderd Patin (115), Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (114), Marlins farmhand INF Masim Núñez (111), and Cardinals prospect OF Mike Antico (110) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 57 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 49.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his first loss with Brooklyn last Wednesday vs. Hudson Valley...Permitted 4 runs on 4 hits over 4.0-plus innings...Walked 5 and struck out 4...Tossed 70 pitches and 36 strikes (51.4%)...Relieved by RHP Brendan Hardy with runners at 2nd and 3rd and nobody out in the top of the 5th and Brooklyn trailing 4-0...Bequeathed runners did not score...Renegades went on to defeat the Cyclones, 7-1.

VICIOUS VENTURA: Ventura set new career highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (9), earning the win and tossing a quality start in August 2's win at Jersey Shore...He then set a new career-high with 10 strikeouts in his next start on August 9 vs. Aberdeen, allowing 1 run and 1 hit over 6.2 innings...Ventura tossed a career and team-season-high 101 pitches and 66 strikes...The 101 pitches were the most thrown by a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP Briam Campusano tossed 103 pitches (57 strikes) over 5.2 innings in a 5-2 loss at West Virginia on July 28, 2018... In 6 starts with Brooklyn, the Mets' No. 29 prospect per Baseball America is 3-1 with a 3.56 ERA (12 ER in 30.1 IP), 18 walks (14.8 BB%), and 31 strikeouts (25.4 K%)...Narrowed down to his last 4 starts, Ventura is 3-1 with a 3.52 ERA (9 ER in 23.0 IP) and 13 walks (14.3 BB%) to 31 strikeouts (34.1 K%) with only 10 hits allowed (.132 BAA)...Brooklyn is 5-1 in starts made by the 23-year-old.

AIR JORDANY: Ventura joined Brooklyn from Single-A St. Lucie on July 14...In 15 appearances (13 starts) in the Florida State League, the 23-yearold registered a 4-3 record with a 5.67 ERA (34 ER in 54.0 IP)...Issued 50 walks and struck out 60...Has struggled in a starting role in 2023...In 13 starts, holds a 3-3 mark with a 6.70 ERA (33 ER in 44.1 IP)...Is 1-0 with a 0.93 ERA (1 ER in 9.2 IP) in a pair of relief outings...Tossed his first career complete game in a 5-inning loss at Palm Beach on June 16...Yielded 1 run on 3 hits over 4.0 innings.

TOP PROSPECT: Ventura is ranked as the Mets' No. 29 prospect by Baseball America...The right-hander was deemed the organization's No. 19 farmhand entering 2022 and No. 20 before 2021 by Baseball Amer-

ON THE MEND: Ventura is in the midst of his first full professional season since 2019...The Dominican native missed the entire 2021 season and most of 2022 while recovering from Tommy John surgery.

2022: Started the campaign on St. Lucie's 60-day injured list...Joined the Florida Complex League Mets on a rehab assignment on June 5... Tossed a pair of perfect innings on June 6 vs. the FCL Astros Orange, striking out 3...Reinstated from the IL on June 12...Made 3 starts in the Florida State League...Did not receive a decision and posted a 5.40 ERA (4 ER in 6.2 IP) with 2 walks and 10 strikeouts...Placed on the 7-day injured list for the remainder of the season on June 29.
