JACKSONVILLE DROPS SERIES FINALE

Jonah Bride reached base four times on Sunday, but the Charlotte Knights plated six runs in the fifth inning to beat Jacksonville 9-4. After the Knights scored a run in the second, a **Troy Johnston** RBI double and **Dane Myers** RBI ground out gave the Jumbo Shrimp the lead in the third. Charlotte scored twice in the fourth, but again, Jacksonville battled back to take the advantage on consecutive RBI doubles from **Marty Costes** and **Otto López**. However, the Knights scored six times in the fifth to gain control. The Jumbo Shrimp mustered only one more hit from there.

GRAY'S ANATOMY

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Tristan Gray**, who played 331 games with the Durham Bulls from 2021-23, has been on a tear since returning to the Bull City for a series that began on April 2. The Missouri City, Texas native homered in five consecutive games from April 2-6, the longest such streak for a Jacksonville hitter since **Peter O'Brien** went yard in six straight games from June 6-11, 2018. Over the last 11 games, six of which came against Durham, Gray is a combined 11-for-42 (.262/.354/.714/1.068) with a double, six home runs, 10 RBIs, five walks and nine runs scored. He carries an 11-game on-base streak into play on Tuesday.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 10 of Jacksonville's 15 games (66.7 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have gone 8-2 in those closely-decided affairs thus far. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

SEVENTH HEAVEN

Jacksonville began the season by losing two of three games against Gwinnett, but since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have won seven of their last 12 games. All seven of those victories have come by three runs or fewer, with opponents actually outscoring Jacksonville by a 59-49 margin. Relatedly, those 49 runs scored rank second-fewest in Triple-A during this stretch. The Jumbo Shrimp's 4.42 ERA ranks eighth in Triple-A over this run.

OCEAN'S ELEVEN

Heading into play on Tuesday, three different Jumbo Shrimp boast 11-game on-base streaks, which is tied for the sixth-longest active run in the International League. **Tristan Gray** has posted the best numbers over this stretch, going 11-for-42 to bat .262/.354/.714/1.068 with one double, six home runs, 10 RBIs, five walks and nine runs scored. **José Devers** has also been hot at the plate, batting 12-for-38 (.316/.366/.605/.971) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, six RBIs, two walks and eight runs scored. **Dane Myers** has reached base multiple times just twice during his 11-game on-base streak. He is just 8-for-40 (.200/.319/.275/.594) with one home run, three RBIs, five walks and six runs scored.

SCORING IN BUNCHES

Jacksonville has scored a run in 32 of their 133 offensive innings thus far in 2024. Over those 32 innings, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored multiple runs in nearly half of those, a total of 15 frames. The club's biggest inning came during a five-run ninth inning on April 5 at Durham. Outside of that, the Jumbo Shrimp have logged five frames of three runs and nine two-run innings. They have yet to score exactly four runs in a frame.

SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through 15 games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 55 runs (3.7 per game), in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 22for-124 (.177/.309/.306/.615, ranking 30th, 29th, 29th and 30th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position, stranding a total of 96 runners. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

SHRIMP BITES

The Marlins optioned **Max Meyer** to Jacksonville on Monday. Meyer was 2-0 with a 2.12 ERA in three starts in the majors (17.0 IP, 11 H, 3 BB, 14 K)... **Tristan Gray** ranks tied for second in in the IL in home runs (6), tied for 10th in extra-base hits (8) and 13th in slugging (.630)... **Jonathan Davis** is tied for 13th in steals (5).

ABOUT PATRICK

-Monteverde is the youngest child from a massive family. He is the youngest of 27 grandchildren on his dad's side and the youngest of 18 grandchildren on his mom's side Both of Monteverde's parents are the youngest of twelve.

-A native of Pittsburgh, Monteverde started his collegiate baseball career at Divison II Virginia Wesleyan (Norfolk, Va.) for a season, posting a 1.96 ERA in 82 2/3 innings. In 2018, he moved up a rung, transferring to Division II Seton Hill in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, about 45 minutes from Monteverde's home. He had a solid first year there in 2018 (3.04 ERA), but three starts into his second season with the Griffins, he heard a pop in his elbow and underwent Tommy John surgery. Monteverde made just one more start for Seton Hill in 2020 before the COVID pandemic then shut down the season for him.

-Monteverde completed his collegiate career by transferring to Texas Tech University for the 2021 season. He went 7-4 with a 3.75 ERA, leading the Red Raiders in wins, starts (16), innings pitched (86.1) and strikeouts (101).

2024 SEASON

2023 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Jacksonville on July 25 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, he led the Southern League in wins (8), ERA (2.44) and WHIP (1.11) while ranking second in both innings pitched (84.2) and batting average against (.207), tied for eighth in strikeouts (90) and tied for 14th in games started (14).

-Made 21 total starts with Pensacola in 2022. Led team in wins (10), innings pitched (114.0), strikeouts (114), double plays (T-1st, 11).

-Led qualified pitchers in ERA (3.32),

TRIPLE-A TOTALS

-Among the 119 Southern League pitchers with at least 30 IP, Monteverde ranked 40th in stranded runners (71.3%).

2022 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Double-A Pensacola on August 2 from High-A Beloit.

-Over his final 13 starts in High-A, Monteverde went 3-4 with a 2.30 ERA. He pitched 70.1 innings, yielding only 54 hits (.211 batting average against) and striking out 75 against 21 walks.

2021 SEASON

-Six of his seven outings were in a relief role. Prior to that, he had not pitched in relief since 2017, his freshman year at Virginia Wesleyan. Even during that 2017 campaign, 11 of his 15 appearances were starts.

-Monteverde's favorite pitcher growing up was Clayton Kershaw

-His favorite book is "To Kill a Mockingbird" and favorite movie is "American Pie."
