SATURDAY NIGHT FUN: The Fresno Grizzlies (25-18) conquered the Visalia Rawhide (17-26) 6-3 Saturday evening from Chukchansi Park. The Grizzlies relished their third victory in 12 tries at home when the opponent scores first and enjoyed their first 2024 Saturday win at Chukchansi Park (1-2). Tomorrow, Fresno can win their first home series since August 22-27, 2023 versus the Stockton Ports. Fresno took a 4-2 advantage in the bottom of the third after eight batters came to the dish. Darius Perry started the fun with a double and waltzed home on a Rawhide fielding error. Then, Caleb Hobson and Tevin Tucker executed a double steal, with the latter scoring on the play. Finally, Andy Perez roped a double to center, adding Hobson and GJ Hill. In the bottom of the seventh, Perez lengthened the Fresno lead to 6-3 after launching a two-run ground-rule double down the left field line. Perez finished the night with two doubles and four RBI. Hobson concluded his evening by reaching base four times, which included three singles (one bunt), two stolen bases and a pair of runs scored. Overall, the Grizzlies lineup recorded 10 hits with four of them landing for doubles (most by Fresno in a game this year). Hill lined the other double and yielded two runs. Jason Hinchman was awarded two walks and Felix Tena expanded his hit streak to six games. Hinchman and Hill both extended their on-base streaks to 18 and 12 games, respectively. Fresno southpaw Isaiah Coupet (4-1, win) hurled a career-high six innings, permitting three runs (two earned), on five hits and two walks while punching out four. A trio of Grizzlies relievers combined for three hitless and scoreless frames to wrap up the triumph. Welinton Herrera and Cade Denton picked up their first holds of 2024 while Bryson Hammer secured his third save of the season.

HIGHWAY 99: The Fresno Grizzlies and Visalia Rawhide (Arizona Diamondbacks Single-A affiliate) conclude their six-game series today at Chukchansi Park. This is the first of two regular season series between the clubs in 2024 and the only meeting in Fresno. The Grizzlies are 25-4 at home (three sweeps) and 46-13 all-time against the Rawhide. The Grizzlies have also won 24 of their last 30 contests against their Highway 99 rivals. On the other side, four of the Rawhide's 13 wins have come via one-run walk-offs. The two cities are 39.26 miles from one another, or if you drive non-stop, 43 minutes or so. From Fresno to Visalia, you would drive in a southeast direction, following the CA 99 route.

FARM GROWN: Today, the Grizzlies hand the ball to RHP Jace Kaminska. Kaminska was selected by the Rockies in the 10th round (Pick 292) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Nebraska. Kaminska made 14 starts for the Cornhuskers in 2023, going 7-3 with a 4.13 ERA and 1.14 WHIP. Prior to Nebraska, Kaminska pitched for Wichita State and Caney Valley High School in Caney, Kansas.

AN ACE IN JACE: Grizzlies' RHP Jace Kaminska has been lights out over seven starts this season. Kaminska is 3-1 with a 1.26 ERA and 0.87 WHIP, with the latter two ranking first among qualified pitchers in the California League. In 35.2 innings, he has allowed five runs (all earned), on 24 hits, seven walks and two hit-by-pitches while punching out 39. Kaminska has started two of Fresno's five shutout wins this season. He has tossed 18 straight scoreless innings (spanning three starts), allowing 12 hits and four walks while striking out

HERRERA IS NOT HORSING AROUND: Grizzlies' LHP Welinton Herrera has been unbelievable out of the bullpen this season. Over 14 games, Herrera is 4-1 with a 2.18 ERA and 0.77 WHIP, while opponents are batting .164 against him (.074 against lefties; 2-for-27, 14 strikeouts). In 20.2 frames, Herrera has permitted five runs (earned), on 12 hits, four walks and three hit-by-pitches while fanning 38 batters. The southpaw has 12 consecutive scoreless outings from April 12-May 25. Herrera has tossed 18 innings, allowing six hits, four walks and one hit-by-pitch while punching out 33 in that stretch. The 20-year-old is in his second season stateside and grew up on a ranch with horses in the Dominican Republic.

RISP IS A RISK: In the month of May, the Grizzlies hold a 12-11 record with 77 total runs scored (3.35 runs a game). A big reason for the lack of offense is the Grizzlies' inability to score with runners in scoring position (RISP). Over the 23 games in the month, Fresno is 46-for-201 (.229) with five different instances where the team went 0-fer with runners in scoring position. They have also left 181 runners on base in May.

A+ FROM ANDY PEREZ: Grizzlies INF Andy Perez has had an outstanding season (41 games), going 46-for-164 (.280 AVG/.330 OBP/.439 SLG/.769 OPS) with four homers (one grand slam), three triples, eight doubles, 26 RBI, 17 runs, 12 walks and two stolen bases. Perez had hit safely in his first 18 games and 23 of first 24 games to start the season, his longest hit streak while in a Fresno uniform. It was the second longest hit streak in the Grizzlies/Rockies affiliation since Drew Romo in 2021 (21 games, July 6-August 15) and it was the longest active streak in Minor League Baseball at the time. Perez went 26-for-76 (.342 AVG/.383 OBP/.579 SLG/.962 OPS) with three homers (one grand slam), three triples, three doubles, 18 RBI, 12 runs, five walks and two stolen bases in that hit streak stretch. Perez's triple on April 24th against San Jose was his 10th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him three triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

HITMAN HINCHMAN AND HILL: Grizzlies' OF/1B Jason Hinchman has reached base safely in 18 straight games and 26 of 27 contests this season (April 26-May 25 for the streak). In those 18 games, Hinchman is 15-for-54 (278) with 15 walks. Grizzlies' OF/2B GJ Hill has reached base safely in 12 straight games and 14 of 15 contests since joining Fresno (April 30-May 25 for the streak). In those 12 games, Hill is 7-for-40 (175) with 11 walks.
