LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox dropped the series finale to the Binghamton Rumble Ponies on Sunday in a 5-3 loss at Mirabito Stadium. Jaylen Palmer hit a go-ahead two run homer off Nick Richmond in the eighth to secure the victory for the Rumble Ponies. Bowie came from behind twice to tie the game, including in the fifth when Dylan Beavers launched a solo homer. Cameron Weston took the loss but did not allow a run through his first four innings thrown and struck out five on the afternoon.

STARTING OUT RIGHT

Bowie starting pitching was superb at Binghamton this past week. Starters **Ryan Long**, **Trace Bright**, **Brandon Young**, **Seth Johnson**, and **Alex Pham** combined to give up just four earned runs over 23.1 innings thrown (1.54 ERA). The Baysox staff ERA in the series was just 1.38, the lowest in all of MiLB for the week of May 14 - May 21.

BURNS BABY BURNS

Over his last five games, IF **Collin Burns** is batting .438 (7-for-16) with a homer, a double and five RBI. The 23-year-old brought home the go-ahead runs in two games in the series at Binghamton with a solo homer in the eighth on Wednesday and a two-run double in the seventh on Saturday. Burns has reached base in six consecutive games, which is tied for the longest active on-base streak on the team.

BEAVS HITS BOMBS

OF **Dylan Beavers** hit his second homer in three games on Sunday with a game-tying solo homer in the fifth. The Orioles No. 7 prospect collected three hits on the day, his second three-hit game of the series and his third multi-hit game of the week. The 22-year-old is fourth in the Eastern League in on-base percentage (.399) and sixth in batting average (.302).

RELIEVERS STAY READY

After five more innings and six more strikeouts from Baysox relievers yesterday, Bowie's bullpen continues to lead the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings thrown (182.2) and strikeouts (226). 20 of the 21 wins accumulated by Baysox pitchers have been credited to the relievers. Bowie's bullpen also has a 1.14 WHIP, which is tied for the third-lowest in all of Double-A.

UP THE BRIGHT-NESS

RHP **Trace Bright** makes his eighth start of the season and his second against Richmond. Bright is coming off his second straight scoreless start after dealing 4.1 innings against Binghamton on Wednesday. The Orioles No. 16 prospect has not allowed a run over his last 8.2 innings pitched. In his last start against Richmond on April 26, Bright threw five innings of one-run ball with six strikeouts in a loss. The 23-year-old is looking for his first five inning start of the month after dealing three of them in April.

SIZING UP THE SQUIRRELS

Entering this week, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are fifth in the Southwest Division at 17-22 but most recently took five of six against Reading at home. The Double-A affiliate of the Giants took four of six against Bowie in the first meeting of the season at The Diamond. Seven of the Giants' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), OF Grant McCray (OF), OF Vaun Brown (No. 15), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19), C Adrian Sugastey (No. 23), OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26), and RHP Carson Ragsdale (No. 30).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Ryan Murphy makes his ninth start of the season and his second against Bowie. In his most recent start on Wednesday against Reading, Murphy threw 4.0 innings and gave up two runs on four hits with one walk and four strikeouts in a no decision. Murphy owns an ERA of just 2.81 over 32 innings pitched and a WHIP of just 1.16. In his last start against Bowie on April 24, the 24-year-old threw 5.0 innings and gave up two runs (one earned) on five hits over one walk and two strikeouts in a no decision. This will be Murphy's seventh career outing against the Baysox.

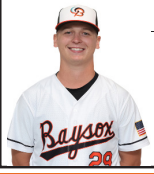

2024: Named to Bowie Opening Day roster. **Delivered 4.1 scoreless innings and struck out two in most recent start on 5/15 @ BNG in a no-decision. Has not allowed in a run in 8.2 consecutive innings. Has punched out five or more batters in five of seven starts. Looking to reach fifth inning for first time in three starts.** Finished month of April with a 2.41 ERA over 18.2 innings pitched with 23 strikeouts. Went five innings each in three straight starts from 4/14 - 4/26.

2023: Began first full season in minors in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 IP. Led IronBirds in strikeouts. Finished 4th in South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 10 batters in just 3.1 innings in 2023 season debut against Wilmington. Posted a 5.04 ERA in the first half but pitched better in second half of season, posting a 3.55 ERA with 62 strikeouts over 38 innings. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Made Double-A debut on August 26 at Erie. Struck out five over four scoreless innings on the road. Went at least four innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.

2022: Debuted professionally with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27. Struck out three over three shutout innings in Delmarva debut against Lynchburg. Finished first professional season with a 1.86 ERA in 9.2 innings.

College: Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were fourth most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

Personal: Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with third round pick Nolan McLean. Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

The “Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake” are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of MiLB’s “Copa de la Diversión™” or “Fun Cup™”. During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmayer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebbly joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebbly was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles’ organization in 2022. Sebbly played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

Facteau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022.
