LaViolette hit a grand slam to cap a nine-run second inning for Akron, but Richmond rallied back over the final six innings to beat the Ducks in the series opener. **Aaron Walton** homered in the loss for Akron.

Today's starter: **Braylon Doughty** makes his 23rd start of the season and ninth with Akron. The right-hander is coming off a loss last week in Somerset after allowing seven runs (six earned) over 3.2 innings while striking out three. Doughty is making his first start against Richmond and the Giants organization in his career. He has struck out 109 batters this season between Akron and Lake County, which is seventh most in the Guardians organization.

Power of Schubart: **Nolan Schubart** crossed the 30 home run mark in the 2026 season with his two-homer game against Somerset on August 27. After another two-homer game against the Patriots on August 30, the RubberDucks outfielder/first baseman has 12 homers in Akron and 32 overall between High-A and Double-A. All three of Schubart's professional multi-homer games have come with Akron. Schubart has also added in 16 doubles and two triples to give him 50 extra-base hits this season. His 30 homer season is the first by a hitter in the Guardians organization since **Jhonkensy Noel** hit 32 homers between Lake County, Akron and Columbus in 2022. Schubart enters Tuesday's series opener with 99 RBI between Akron and Lake County, which is one away from becoming the first member of the Guardians organization to drive in 100 in a season since **Will Brennan** drove in 107 between Akron and Columbus in 2022.

Speed of Chourio: **Jaison Chourio** stole 15 bases in the month of August while being caught just three times. His 28 steals on the season are tied with **Alex Mooney** for the team lead.

Summer swings: The Akron offense has been on fire since June 1. The RubberDucks have scored 446 runs in the last 73 games (6.1 runs per games), which is second best in the Eastern League. In that time the Akron offense is batting .257 (second best in EL) with 125 doubles, 17 triples (second most in EL), 100 home runs (58 coming since July 17) and 410 RBI (second most in EL). Akron is third in the Eastern League with 127 stolen bases since June 1. Akron has hit 60 home runs at home overall this season, which is tied for the most by an Akron club since 2016 (60 in 2017).

Walk this way: RubberDucks batters are once again showing impressive patience in 2026. Akron's 576 walks rank first in Eastern League and fifth in Double-A this season. **Dean Curley** is fifth in all of Minor League Baseball with 102 walks drawn this year between Akron and Lake County. **Nolan Schubart** is seventh with 97 walks.

RubberDucks and Flying Squirrels: Akron is facing Richmond for the fourth of four series this season and the second of two at 7 17 Credit Union Park. Akron is 5-14 against Richmond and 3-4 in downtown Akron this year. Akron is 110-113 all-time against Richmond. Top prospects in the series includes:

Boys of August: **Ryan Cesarini** ranked fourth in all of full season MiLB with 11 home runs in the month of August. The RubberDucks outfielder led the Eastern League during the month with 25 RBI, .805 slugging, 1.211 OPS, 17 extra-base hits and 70 total bases. **Nolan Schubart** finished second in the EL and tenth in full season MiLB with 10 homers during the month. **Jaison Chourio** led the league in August stolen bases.

HR leaders: Six of the top 10 home run hitters in the Guardians organization have played with the RubberDucks at some point this season. The current Akron roster features four of those six with leader **Nolan Schubart** (12 with Akron, 32 on season), third **Jace LaViolette** (five with Akron, 24 on season), fourth **Aaron Walton** (six with Akron, 21 on season) and fifth **Ryan Cesarini** (12 with Akron, 19 on season). 11 Ducks have hit five or more homers in 2026.

Bases loaded: **Jace LaViolette** launched his first professional grand slam on September 1. He became the seventh different Akron batter to hit a grand slam in 2026 joining **Alex Mooney**, **Ralph Velazquez** (two slams), **Alfonso Rosario**, **Bennett Thompson**, **Nolan Schubart** and **Aaron Walton**. Overall on the season, Akron has hit eight grand slams, which is second most in the Eastern League behind Somerset who leads with nine (Somerset is tied with Springfield for the lead in Double-A). Akron as a team is batting .297 with seven doubles, three triples and 150 RBI with the bases loaded in 2026. Between Akron and Lake County, Schubart is batting .563/1.863 with three doubles, three grand slams and 30 RBI in 20 plate appearances with the bases loaded.

Playing close: Akron is 19-22 this season in one-run games. Since the start of the second half, Akron is 8-14 in one-run contests. Akron is 8-14 in two-run games in 2026. Dating back to the start of the Altoona series at the end of July, Akron has played 24 games decided by two or fewer runs (17 of those being one-run games).

Opened the season ranked as the Guardians #6 prospect and #2 pitching prospect according to Baseball America.

Picked up his first professional win on April 23 at West Michigan (5.0IP, 5H, 1R, 8SO).

Started the season with High-A Lake County making 14 starts going 3-3 with a 3.02 ERA and 74 strikeouts over 59.2 innings.

His 74 strikeouts against 11 walks with the Captains at the time of his promotion made him one of just four pitchers in MiLB to strike out 74+ and walk 11 or fewer.

Named Midwest League Pitcher of the Month honors in June after going 2-0 with a 1.64 ERA and 24 strikeouts over 22 innings pitched in four starts.

Transferred to Akron on June 30.

- Opened the season Single-A Lynchburg making 22 starts going 0-7 with a 3.48 ERA and 99 strikeouts over 85.1 innings pitched.
 - 99 strikeouts ranked second on the team.
 - Did not pitch after Aug. 15 due to right shoulder inflammation.

- Drafted by Cleveland in CB-A round (36 overall pick) in the 2024 MLB Draft out of Chaparral High School in Temecula, CA.
 - Same High School as former MLB outfielder Alan Craig and former MLB catcher Rob Brantly.
 - As a senior in 2024, he went 4-3 with a 1.11 ERA (8ER/50.1IP), 85 strikeouts and a .155 opponent batting average, allowing just 28 hits and walking just 10.
 - Fastball in high school touched 97 mph and curveball spin rates topped 3,000 rpm.
 - Committed to Oklahoma State before being drafted by Cleveland.

2026 RUBBERDUCKS FIELD STAFF

#26 Manager Greg DiCenzo enters his sixth season with the Guardians organization. The 2025 season will be DiCenzo's third as RubberDucks manager, and fifth as a manager in Cleveland's organization. He's led the RubberDucks to a 157-118 record in two seasons as Akron's manager including an Eastern League playoff appearance in 2024.

Prior to becoming Triple-A Columbus' bench coach in 2023, DiCenzo spent the 2021 and 2022 seasons as the manager in High-A Lake County. He guided the Captains to a 141-108 record in his two seasons including a Midwest League finals appearance in 2022.

A native of Duxbury, MA, DiCenzo was the head baseball coach at Holy Cross for 12 seasons prior to joining the Cleveland organization. The Crusaders went 137-109 in Patriot League play during his tenure, including a 2017 Patriot League Championship, and posted 20-win seasons in 10 of those 12 years.

#48 Hitting Coach Jordan Becker enters his seventh season with the Guardians organization and third with the RubberDucks. In 2023, Becker served as the hitting coach for Lake County.

Becker joined the Cleveland organization in 2019 after a collegiate coaching career that saw stops at Riverside Community College and New Mexico State University.

#43 Hitting Coach Cole Nieto enters his fifth season in the Guardians organization and first season in Akron. Nieto joins the RubberDucks after serving as the hitting coach for the Lynchburg Hillcats in 2024 and their Carolina League championship season in 2025.

A graduate of St. Ignatius High School in Cleveland, Nieto played four years at Baldwin Wallace University in Berea. While at Baldwin Wallace, he hit .341 with 17 home runs and 109 RBI in 137 career games.

#55 Pitching Coach Angus Adams enters his first season in the Guardians organization and first season in Akron. Prior to joining the RubberDucks, Adams served as a performance coach for Tread Athletics and was a pitching coach at Elmira College.

#54 Pitching Coach Michael Poole enters his fourth season in the Guardians organization and third season with the RubberDucks. He will be a pitching coach in 2025 after spending 2024 as Akron's assistant pitching coach. Prior to joining the RubberDucks, Poole was the pitching development coach on the Arizona Complex Academy staff.

A native of [Akron](#), Poole played at Cuyahoga Community College and Lake Erie College before starting his coaching career at Inspiration Academy (FL) in 2019. Poole was an assistant coach at LSU-Eunice for the Bengals D2 JUCO World Series Championship season in 2021.

#33 Bench Coach Yan Rivera enters his fifth season in the Guardians organization and first season in Akron. Prior to coming to Akron, Rivera spent 2025 as the bench coach for Lake County and 2024 as the manager for the ACL Guardians.

Rivera is the son of former Cleveland minor league manager and Toronto Blue Jays coach Luis Rivera.

#47 Development Coach Gustavo Nava enters his second season with the Guardians organization and first season with the RubberDucks. Prior to coming to Akron, Nava served as the Development coach for Lynchburg in their 2025 Carolina League championship season.

Athletic Trainer Derrik Diaz enters his ninth season in the Guardians organization and third season with the RubberDucks. Diaz was the Eastern League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2024. Prior to coming to Akron, Diaz served as the head athletic trainer for the Dominican Republic Complex in 2023.

Assistant Athletic Trainer Laura Gutiérrez-Sogel enters her third season in the Guardians organization and first season in Akron. Prior to coming to the RubberDucks, Gutiérrez-Sogel spent the 2025 season as the Assistant Athletic Trainer in Lake County.

Strength and Conditioning Coach Jack Baldwin enters his third season with the Guardians organization and first season in Akron. Prior to joining the RubberDucks, Baldwin served as the Strength and Conditioning coach for Lynchburg in 2025.

Mental Performance Coach Andie McGregor enters her third season with the Guardians. She previously worked as a Mental Performance Coach at IMG Academy, supporting middle school, high school and post-grad student athletes in the baseball program. Also served as a Mental Performance intern with the New York Mets, working with the FCL Mets during the 2021 season. Has a Master of Science in Educational Psychology – Sport Psychology at Florida State University and a Bachelor of Science in Exercise Science at Georgia College & State University.

Baseball Technology Fellow Ryan Chambliss enters his first season in Akron. He spent the 2025 season with the Guardians ACL affiliate.

We Are the RubberDucks

On October 29, 2013, then team owner **Ken Babby** and general manager **Jim Pfander** stood before a capacity audience at the Akron Civic Theater and announced that the team would be known henceforth as the **Akron RubberDucks**. In addition to being symbolic of the fun, family-friendly brand of entertainment offered by minor league baseball, the name also honors Akron's long history as the "**Rubber Capital of the World**." Brandiose Marketing of San Diego, California designed the team logo, colors, and various marks and insignias. Please note that for print coverage, *RubberDucks* is spelled as one word with a capital "D." In broadcast coverage, referring to the team as "*the 'Ducks*" is an acceptable variation of the team's nickname.
