TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes and Chihuahuas meet for the first of four series on the year and two in the Duke City ... Albuquerque is coming off a 4-2 series loss to the Space Cowboys in Sugar Land ... Bradley Blalock is slated to start for the Isotopes while Ryan Bergert is scheduled to toe the rubber for El Paso.

SHUTOUT: Albuquerque was shutout Sunday for the second time in 2025 (also: march 28 at Sacramento) ... The club has been limited to two runs or fewer seven times in 2025.

BIG INNING: The Isotopes surrendered six runs in the third frame Sunday, tied for the second-most runs allowed in a frame in 2025 (also: April 5 vs. Salt Lake, third inning).

GRAND SLAM: Starter Jack O'Loughlin relented a grand slam in the fourth frame Sunday to Collin Price, the first slam permitted by the Isotopes since Max Muncy's on August 4, 2024, at Las Vegas in the eighth inning.

BASES JUICED: Ryan Rolison issued a bases-loaded walk in the fourth frame Sunday, the eighth by Albuquerque in 2025—the third-most in professional baseball (most: Jupiter, 13).

HITS: The Isotopes registered just one hit Sunday afternoon, the fewest hits in a nine-inning game since May 30, 2021, at Sugar Land, when the club was also held to one knock.

XBH: Albuquerque did not tally an extra-base hit Sunday for the second time this season (also: April 1 vs. Salt Lake), ending a 10-game extra-base streak.

RISP: The Isotopes went 0-for-5 with runners in scoring position Sunday, the third game this series and sixth on the year without recording a hit with runners in scoring position.

KEEP IT CLEAN: The Isotopes' seven miscues on the year are the fewest in the Pacific Coast League and tied for the fourth-fewest in Triple-A.

DINGERS: Albuquerque has homered in 11 of their first 15 games to begin the season ... The club has 23 homers on the year, tied for the most in MiLB (also: Oklahoma City).

BULLPEN: The Isotopes bullpen's 4.09 ERA (72.2 IP, 33 ER) is the third-lowest in the Pacific Coast League.

2024 VS. EL PASO: In 2024, the Isotopes won the season series against El Paso, 14-13, including taking five of nine in the Duke City and winning the only six-game series in Albuquerque, 4-2, from June 11-16 (El Paso took two of three to begin the season).

HEADED TO DENVER: Braxton Fulford recieved his first call-up to the Big Leagues yesterday ... Registered a single Sunday to extend his hit streak to eight games. During stretch is slashing .483/.545/.1.069 with two doubles, five homers and 10 RBI.

ON-BASE STREAK: Braxton Fulford has reached base in 11-straight games, slashing .429/.512/..943 with three doubles, five homers, five walks and 10 RBI.

PCL LEADERS: At the time of his call-up, Braxton Fulford ranked among PCL leaders in slugging (1st, .868), OPS (1st, 1.345), homers (T-3rd, five), average (4th, .395), OBP (4th, .477) and total bases (T-6th, 33).

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard drew a walk Sunday and has reached base in nine-straight games, every contest he's played this year.

DUKE CITY HR RECORD: Sam Hilliard has 78 home runs in an lsotopes uniform across five seasons (2019, 21, 22, 24 and 25). He is one blast away from tying Mike Busch (1993-96) for most among all Albuquerque Triple-A players.

ISOTOPES RBI RECORD: Hilliard has 219 RBI with Albuquerque, which ranks third among career leaders in team history. Jordan Patterson (2016-18) is second with 229 RBI.

WARMIN' UP: Warming Bernabel collected an RBI double Saturday, his third extra-base hit in his last five games (two doubles and one homer).

YF: After going 7-for-18 with three homers from April 6-10, Yanquiel Fernandez is hitless in his last two contests (0x7).

MR. VOLUNTEER: Over his first five games with the Isotopes in 2025, Jordan Beck is just 2-for-22 with seven punchouts.

RITTER: Ryan Ritter is 2-for-15 with one homer and three RBI over his last four games, average dropped from .344 to .277.

ALL-TIME ONE HITTERS: The Isotopes were limited to one hit on Sunday for the 10th time in the club's history with nine of the 10 coming on the road.

EL PASO TIES: Connor Joe played 26 games with the Isotopes in 2021, batting .326 with nine homers and 25 RBI ... Veteran first baseman Matt Adams played for the Isotopes on a rehab assignment in 2021, and is El Paso's bench coach ... Albuquerque catcher Austin Nola appeared in 19 total games for the Chihuahuas in 2021 and 2023... Albuquerque native Carlos Olivas is now the Chihuahuas' head athletic trainer.

Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his fourth season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
