Last Game, Sunday: Lugnuts 5, Dragons 3. In front of 4,016, **Luis Morales** dazzled with six scoreless two-hit innings, striking out six, and **Will Simpson** delivered an RBI double in a three-run first inning and a two-run single in the second inning, helping the Lugnuts beat the division-leading Dragons for the second straight day and clinch a series split, pulling within four games of the division title.

What a Game! On Sunday, the Triple-A Las Vegas Aviators beat Albuquerque, 21-5, behind seven home runs – **Max Muncy** went 5-for-5 with three homers himself, including a grand slam, and **Colby Thomas** hit an inside-the-park and an outside-the-park home run, combining with fellow former Nuts **Ryan Noda** and **Jordan Diaz** for a span of three homers in four pitches.

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense is 1st in the Midwest League in batting average (.251), at-bats (3,395), base hits (851), total bases (1,298) and triples (35); 2nd in runs (512), doubles (167) and OPS (.721); and 3rd in slugging percentage (.382) and on-base percentage (.339).

Heart & Hustle: 2021 Lugnuts utilityman **Max Schuemann** was named the A's nominee for the 2024 MLB Heart & Hustle Award on Thursday. From the Heart & Hustle website: "Created by the Major League Baseball Players Alumni Association in 2005, the Heart & Hustle Award is voted on by Alumni and active Major League players and is presented annually to an active player who demonstrates a passion for the game of baseball and best embodies the values, spirit and traditions of the game."

To the Show: 2017 & 2019 Lugnuts infielder **Luis De Los Santos** made his Major League debut for the Blue Jays last Wednesday, July 31, thus becoming the 6th former Lugnut to debut this season and the 190th all-time Lugnut to go from Lansing to the Majors.

Prospecting: The Nuts have six MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Ryan Lasko** (No. 16), pitcher **Kade Morris** (No. 20), infielder **Will Simpson** (No. 26), pitcher **Will Johnston** (No. 27) and outfielder **Jared Dickey** (No. 28).

The Future is Here: Lugs right-hander **Luis Morales**, tomorrow's starting pitcher, tossed 2/3 of an inning in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, striking out Jeral Pérez and Deyvison De Los Santos alongside an HBP and BB. Morales was the A's sole representative in the prospect showcase, and the fifth all-time current Lugnut to play in the game.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2016: It was a very bad day for Fort Wayne catcher Marcus Greene, Jr., who committed two passed balls and two run-scoring throwing errors (of four total TinCaps errors), helping the Lugnuts win 7-4 at Cooley Law School Stadium.

2018: Urgency was of the utmost importance for the Lugnuts, working to beat an incoming storm. Fort Wayne prospect Luis Patiño held the Lugnuts hitless through the first five innings, but the Lugs broke through with four runs in the sixth at Parkview Field, taking a 4-2 lead with menacing clouds massing in the Summit City. The TinCaps tied the game with two runs in the sixth, only to see Jalen Washington's third passed ball bring in Jesus Navarro in the seventh for a 5-4 Nuts lead. After a perfect Orlando Pascual seventh, the skies opened and the game was called after a 35-minute delay.

No-Hit History: On June 13, tossed five hitless innings, walking two and striking out six, before handing the baton to Grant Judkins (2 2/3) and then Colton Johnson (1 1/3) as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 no-hitter of the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the 4th no-hitter in franchise history and the first home no-hitter since April 2003.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands thus all root for Boston-area teams.

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Path to Lansing: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings... opened 2023 pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of **California League Pitcher of the Week** with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... dominated in Lugnuts debut May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win.
