**RIDERS SPLIT SERIES AFTER SUNDAY LOSS IN AMARILLO:**

The Frisco RoughRiders lost 9-7 in their Sunday series finale on the road in Amarillo to split the series three games apiece with the Sod Poodles. Frisco (8-7) took its only lead of the game in the second inning, when catcher **Julian Brock** plastered a towering two-run home run over the left field wall to make it 2-1. Amarillo (5-10) responded with three runs in the bottom of the frame to retake the lead 4-2 against Frisco's starter **David Davalillo** (0-2). After going quiet in the middle innings, the Riders reignited with a **Corey Joyce** RBI double in the seventh inning to draw back down 7-4 and made it a one-run game when Brock smoked a two-RBI double for a 7-6 deficit. Down by three in the ninth inning, the RoughRiders got singles from **Frainer Chavez** and Joyce, but had a runner thrown out at third base to end the game after Brock dropped a single in to center field.

**YELLOW CITY OFFENSIVE ATTACK:**

The RoughRiders showed out on offense in Amarillo last week in a 3-3 split. As a team, Frisco hit .318/.410/.592/1.002 with 14 home runs and 54 runs scored (9.0 runs per game). They finished all over the MiLB leaderboards in the week, finished T-1st in home runs (14), 7th in runs (54), T-4th in doubles (17), 7th in SLG (.592) and 8th in OPS (1.002). As part of the week, the Riders have the longest active home run streak in Minor League Baseball, homering in 10-straight games (they are 4-6 in those games). In Amarillo, **Marcus Lee Sang** (.500 (10-for-20)/.583/.950/1.533), **Corey Joyce** (.476 (10-for-21)/.522/.857/1.379) and **Orlando Martinez** (.407 (11-for-30)/.467/.815/1.282) all hit over .400 with 2 home runs in the series.

**LEE SANG IT AND BANG IT:**

**Marcus Lee Sang** was dominant last week for the Riders. In five games, he slashed .500 (10-for-20)/.583/.950/1.533 with 3 doubles, 2 home runs and 6 RBIs. In a two-home run game last week, he hit a laser that was 113 mph off the bat and a moonshot over the batters' eye, which went an estimated 466 feet. The former Phillies farmhand is now hitting .320/.382/.500/.882 in 13 games to start the season.

**CHAVEZ IN CHARGE:**

RoughRiders infielder **Frainer Chavez** has been on fire at the plate. Last Thursday in Frisco, Chavez tied a career high with 4 hits, going 4-for-5, followed that up with a two-hit game on Friday, including a home run, and another blast on Sunday. In his 15 games, he has reached in all 15, and is hitting .306 (19-for-62)/.413/.548/.961 with 3 doubles, 4 home runs, 10 RBIs, 11 walks and just 12 strikeouts. The five-year RoughRider is 9th in the league in 1st in runs (17), T-4th in home runs (4), 7th in total bases (34), 8th in OPS (.961) and T-7th in hits (19).

**KEEP YOUR FRIENDS CLOSE AND YOUR ENEMIES CLOSER:**

The RoughRiders have played plenty of close games to start the season. Though they are 8-7, they are 8-4 in 9-innings games and 0-3 in games that have gone to extra innings. Frisco is just 3-5 in one-run games this year and all three losses in Amarillo came by two runs or fewer. Frisco's +19 run differential is the second-best in the league (behind Midland's +33), despite having the fourth-best record. Their pythagorean record (predicted record based on total runs scored and allowed, created by Bill James) is 9-6 through 15 games.

**YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:**

Through 15 games the RoughRiders are 1st in Double-A with 159 hits. They are third in Double-A in batting average (.293) and T-3rd in runs (100, 6.7 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. The Riders are 2nd in the Texas League in homers (22) while they are 2nd in SLG (.477) and 1st in OPS (.848). For perspective, the Yankees led MLB last year with a .787 team OPS. The Riders have 5 qualified hitters batting over .300 (see table), accounting for 23 percent of all Texas League batters hitting over .300 (22 total). No other team in all of Minor League Baseball has more than 5 players with at least 30 ABs and a .300 batting average.

**QUITE THE DEBUT:**

RoughRiders infielder **Corey Joyce** collected two hits, including a three-run home run, in his first Frisco start on Wednesday. After being signed as a MiLB free agent on April 8th, he joined the Riders on April 14th. In six total games, he is hitting .476 (10-for-21)/.522/.857/1.379 with 2 doubles, 2 home runs and 9 RBIs. With Double-A Knoxville in the Cubs organization last year, he hit just two home runs in 92 games with a .272/.393/.347/.740 slashline. The longtime Tigers farmhand was a 12th-round pick by Detroit in 2019 and played for them through 2024.

**VS. TULSA:**

The Riders went just 2-4 against Tulsa in their only meeting last year and this series marks one of two times the Ranger and Dodger affiliates will clash in 2026, including a three-game series out of the All-Star Break from July 17th-19th. In their 30 games head-to-head in the last five seasons, Frisco is just 13-17 against Tulsa. The Drillers have hit 33 home runs in the 30 games and Frisco's pitching staff owns a 5.92 ERA. In those five seasons, **Frainer Chavez** leads the RoughRiders in hits with 17 against Tulsa while slashing .309 (17-for-55)/.385/.345/.730 in 18 games. **Blaine Crim** clubbed a team-best 5 home runs and 17 RBIs in 11 games against Tulsa from 2021-22 while **Ian Moller** paced the club with a .455 (5-for-11) average against the Dodger affiliate last year.

-Mills Godwin High School in Virginia, where he helped guide the Eagles to a VHSL state finals berth during his 2019 junior season. Same high school as former RoughRiders pitcher and current Major Leaguer **Reed Garrett**.

-College of Southern Idaho. Was named Region 18 Pitcher of the year and NJCAA All-American after leading the country with 16.0 K/9. His junior season, he went 8-3 with a 2.04 ERA and set single-season record with 118 K at CSI over his 66.1 IP.

-Before being drafted by the Rangers, he was committed to transfer to Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU) for baseball.

-Enjoys fishing, playing basketball and eating sushi in his free time.

### 2026 SEASON

-No. 23 prospect in the Rangers organization.

-Made one relief appearance on Friday, 4/3 before starting the home opener on 4/7.

### 2025 SEASON

-Dominated for High-A Hub City, owning a 1.15 ERA over 15 outings.

-Among those who threw at least 50 innings in the South Atlantic League, he led the league in ERA (1.15) and batting average against (.147), while he was third in strikeout rate (33.6%), second in WHIP (0.84), and second in LOB rate (82.3%).

-As a starting pitcher with Hub City, he went 0-2 with a 0.74 ERA over nine starts while holding opponents to a .128 batting average. As a reliever, he owned a 2.00 ERA in six appearances.

-In his last nine games (six starts) with Hub City, he owned a 0.83 ERA, striking out 48 to 12 walks in 32.2 innings while allowing just a .118 batting average.

### 2024 SEASON

-Spent all season with Low-A Down East Wood Ducks as a swingman. As a starter, owned 7.01 ERA while he garnered a 3.00 ERA as a reliever.

## CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

## THOMAS ST. CLAIR

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

## JASON HART

Years with Rangers: 13

Years with RoughRiders: 9

Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.
