TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes wrap up their longest road trip of the year, as they take on the Modesto Nuts (SEA), the two-time defending Cal League Champions, in the last game of a six-game set and game 12 of a 12-game, 13-day road trip. The Quakes are back home on Tuesday, June 3rd to face San Jose. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE NUTS: Today's game is the sixth of 12 against the Nuts and the last of six at John Thurman Field. In 2024, the Quakes went just 2-10 against the Nuts, 1-5 here in Modesto. In 2023, they went 3-6, just 1-5 here in Modesto. The last time the Quakes won a series here in Modesto was in 2021, when they went 4-2.

LAST GAME: The Quakes got incredible pitching on Saturday night at John Thurman Field, as they scored a 7-1 victory over the Modesto Nuts, giving them three of the first five games in the series. Sterling Patick (1-2) earned his first pro win, allowing just one run on two hits over five innings, while striking out a career-best six. Samuel Sanchez and Connor Godwin each worked two scoreless innings, as the three pitchers combined to hold Modesto to a season-low two hits on the night. Offensively, Eduardo Quintero had his third straight three-hit game, including his league-leading ninth homer of the year. Rancho also got two hits and two RBIs from both Mairo Martinus and Jose Meza, with Meza slugging his third homer of the year. The Quakes are now 10 games up with just 16 to play in the first half.

CLOSE ONES: The Quakes have not played in many close games this year, with Friday night's game being just the seventh one-run game all year and the first since May 9th. Rancho is 4-3 in one-run games and 2-1 in two-run games.

UP-AND-DOWN ROAD TRIP: This road trip has not been nearly as consistent as the Quakes have played overall in 2025, as they've won just five of the first 11 games. After suffering just their second series-loss of the year in Stockton (2-4), the Quakes have now won three of five games here in Modesto. Their series-record is 6-2 on the year with both losses coming at Stockton. Rancho's offense is still tops in the league at .270 with a league-best 43 homers in 50 games. Their ERA (3.73) is second only to San Jose (3.27). Their defense has a fielding percentage of just .962 (#7) and has committed the second-most errors in the league with 67 in 50 games.

THE BIG Q: Eduardo Quintero has three straight three-hit games in this series, but has been playing at an MVP-caliber level all year. He's currently leading the league in homers (9), fifth in the league in RBIs (35), fifth in on-base percentage (.435) second in average (.341) and tied for first in hits (60). He also leads the league in slugging (.619) and is now first in OPS at 1.054. MLB Pipeline rates him as the Dodgers' eighth-best prospect.

SO LONG, MODESTO: 2025 marks the final season of professional baseball in Modesto, CA. In 2026, the franchise rights will be moved to Ontario, CA. The city of Modesto has had professional baseball and has been a member of the California League since 1946. Modesto has won 11 Cal League titles, including the last two (2023-2024). They have played at John Thurman Field since 1955 and have gone by the Nuts, the Athletics, the Red and the Colts.

HYUN-SEOK JANG: 21-year-old right-hander Hyun-Seok Jang makes his 11th start of the year, his second against Modesto. In his last outing overall, he allowed two runs on just two hits over four innings, while matching a career-high with seven strikeouts in a no-decision on Tuesday here in Modesto. Jang, who signed with the Dodgers in August of 2023 out of South Korea, was regarded as the top pitching prospect coming out of Korea in 2023 and is rated by MLB Pipeline as the Dodgers' 17th best prospect.

MATT TIBERIA: 22-year-old right-hander Matt Tiberia makes his ninth start of the year and his first against the Quakes. In his last outing, he allowed two runs on four hits over five innings in a win at Inland Empire on May 25th. Tiberia was drafted by Seattle in the 18th round of the 2024 draft out of Lynn University in Boca Raton, Florida.
