### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### BAM BAM CAM

Shortstop **Cam Devanney** won yesterday's game, with a walk-off two-run homer, his team-leading 4th home run of the year.

Devanney is the International League leader in home runs (4) and total bases (20), while tied 2nd in runs batted in (7) ... he also leads the league in slugging percentage (1.111) and is 3rd in OPS (1.561).

Last season, Omaha tied a Storm Chasers-era record with 9 walk-off wins, including 1 walk-off home run ... Devanney did not drive in a winning run last year, but did score the winning run twice.

Cam's walk-off homer yesterday was the 32nd in the Modern Omaha era (since 2005) ... it was the Storm Chasers' 3rd walk-off win over Louisville since 2021.

#### RIDING THE CYCLE

Wednesday, Omaha outfielder **Drew Waters** hit for the cycle, the Storm Chasers' first since 2014 and just the fourth cycle in modern Omaha history (since 2005).

Waters legged out an infield single in the 1st inning ... he tripled in a run in the 3rd ... in the 4th, his third at-bat of the day, Waters sped around the bases for an inside-the-park homer, a three-run shot that increased Omaha's lead to 7-2 ... after striking out in the 6th, he had one more chance to finish his cycle in the 8th and connected on an RBI double to complete the cycle.

The last Triple-A Omaha player to hit for the cycle was **Jimmy Paredes**, on May 12, 2014 vs. New Orleans ... he started that game 0-for-2, but hit a grand slam in the 4th inning, tripled in the 6th, doubled in the 7th and singled in the 8th.

Additional cycles in modern Omaha history include **Lorenzo Cain** on May 14, 2011 @ Colorado Springs and **Scott Thorman** on August 29, 2010 vs. Iowa.

Prior to Wednesday, Waters had come one hit shy of the cycle 15 times, including 6 times alone in 2024 ... once he needed a single, 8 times he needed a triple and 6 times he needed the home run ... he had the double in all 15 instances, which wound up being the final hit he needed on Wednesday.

In Waters' cycle, his home run was an inside-the-parker ... the last time that happened in Major League Baseball history was over 80 years ago, on July 3, 1943, by **Leon Culberson** of the Boston Red Sox.

#### SEASON 56

Omaha began the 56th season in franchise history last week against the I-Cubs at Principal Park in Des Moines, Iowa ... this is the 14th season in the Storm Chasers era.

Omaha is coming off a 2024 campaign in which they went 89-59 (.601 winning percentage) to finish 1st in the 20-team International League during the regular season, before going on to win the International League Championship Series.

The 2024 Chasers set a franchise wins record for wins in a season, passing the 86-win 1990 Omaha Royals that won the Triple-A Classic (national championship).

#### WE ARE THE CHAMPIONS

Omaha enters 2024 as the defending champions of the International League.

Winners of the 1st half (49-24 record), Omaha hosted the 2nd-half Champion Columbus Clippers (Cleveland Triple-A affiliate) in the International League Championship Series ... after dropping Game 1 to Columbus 3-2, Omaha came back to win Game 2 in 11 innings, 5-4, before winning Game 3 by a score of 7-3.

2024 marked Omaha's 8th league championship as a Triple-A Club, having won 4 American Association titles (1969, 1970, 1978, 1990), 3 Pacific Coast League championships (2011, 2013, 2014) and now an International League title ... Omaha is the first club to win a league championship in 3 different Triple-A leagues.

#### BE LIKE MIKE

Manager **Mike Jirschele** returns in 2025 for his 17th season managing the Triple-A Omaha franchise, in the 3rd year of his 3rd stint with the club, with an all-time record of 1154-1156 in Omaha ... this is his 34th season in the Royals organization.

In 2024, "Jirsch" was named the International League Manager of the Year, his first such award with Omaha, leading the IL Champs to a league-best 89-59 record in the regular season, setting a franchise record with 89 wins.

Jirschele previously led the Triple-A Omaha club from 1995 to 1997 and 2003 through 2013, winning the PCL league title in 2011 and a Triple-A National Championship in 2013 ... he was Kansas City's 3rd Base Coach from 2014 to 2019.

#### THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

Across the first 4 games of the season, the Storm Chasers have stolen 10 bases, tied for the second-most steals of any Triple-A team, trailing Jacksonville (14).

Omaha has gone 10-for-10 on the basepaths, one of five MiLB teams that has not been caught and the only club with more than 8 steals without being caught.

**John Rave** leads the team with 3 steals, while **Tyler Tolbert** and **Nick Loftin** each have 2 stolen bases.

## TYSON GUERRERO SCOUTING REPORT

### MLB Pipeline

Scouting grades: Fastball: 50 | Curveball: 50 | Slider: 60 | Changeup: 45 | Control: 50 | Overall: 40

Guerrero pitched for three different Washington colleges in his home state, but it was a solid season for the Washington Huskies that caught the Royals' attention and led them to select the lefty in the 12th round of the 2021 Draft. He was limited early in his pro career because of injuries but jumped onto the radar with two consistent seasons. Guerrero returned to Double-A in 2024 and posted a 3.69 ERA across 102 1/3 innings and 22 games (all starts). He jumped to Triple-A at the end of August and didn't finish well, allowing 21 earned runs in 20 2/3 innings with 14 walks and 14 strikeouts in his final five starts.

Armed with a four-pitch mix, Guerrero sits 91-93 mph with a fastball that runs up to 96. He has two breaking balls, an 83-84 mph slider and a 77-78 mph curveball, the latter of which has downer action and flashes plus on some nights. The slider with sweeping action is probably his best secondary right now and tunnels off his fastball well. His changeup is fringe average and still developing after an inconsistent year. Guerrero is usually a strikethrower who keeps the ball in the ballpark.

Guerrero has more of a smaller build, but his stuff would probably tick up in the bullpen. There's likely more opportunity there for him as a multi-inning reliever as he gets closer to Kansas City. But he'll continue to start and be part of the Royals' Triple-A depth in 2025 while he works on that fourth pitch. The club passed on adding him to the 40-man roster over the offseason, but he didn't get picked up by a team in the Rule 5 Draft. Guerrero gets high marks for his composure on the mound.

### Baseball America

A 12th-round pick in 2021, Guerrero spent most of his fourth pro season at Double-A Northwest Arkansas. He heads to the mound with four average-or-better pitches. His 91-94 mph fastball has natural sinking action. Both of his breaking balls are swing-and-miss offerings, especially his slider. Guerrero throws an average changeup but doesn't throw enough strikes to be more than a swingman or reliever.
