# RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (21-9) **Visalia Rawhide (14-16)**





RHP Hyun-Seok Jang (0-1, 4.12 ERA) vs. RHP Junior Sanchez (0-0, 4.82 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes continue a six-game road trip tonight, with game four of a six-game series against the Visalia Rawhide (AZ). The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, May 13th, taking on the Inland Empire 66ers in a six-game series. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE RAWHIDE: Today's game is the fourth of 24 head-to-head meetings and the fourth of 15 here at Valley Strong Ballpark. Last season, the Quakes went 14-16 against the Rawhide, 7-8 here in Visalia.

**LAST GAME:** The Quakes absolutely dominated the Visalia Rawhide on Thursday night, winning by a final of 13-0 at Valley Strong Ballpark. Eduardo Quintero led off the game with a home run, then provided the final run in the ninth with another solo blast, giving him a team-best six round-trippers on the year. Rancho homered a season-high four times, with Samuel Munoz (2) and Jose Meza (2) also going deep. Four Quakes' pitchers combined on the seven-hit shutout, with Sterling Patick, Cody Morse, Jholbran Herder (3-0) and Octavio Becerra leading the way. Visalia starter Lorenzo Encarnacion (3-1) took the loss, after allowing five runs over four innings.

**OWNING IT:** Last night's win got the Quakes back on track, after they saw their three-game winning-streak end on Wednesday. Rancho has now won 12 of their last 14 games overall and continue to sport the league's best record at 21-9. The 13-run margin of victory was Rancho's largest of the year, surpassing their 14-2 victory last week against Stockton. After starting the year 0-3 on the road, Rancho has now won nine of their last 12 away from LoanMart Field. **ZED, ZERO, NADA:** The Quakes now have three shutouts over their last five games and a total of four here in 2025, tied for most in the league. Entering Friday's action, Rancho's team ERA is down to 3.26, now first in the league. Rancho's staff also leads the league in strikeouts with 351, 48 more than the next closest team (Fresno with 303).

**SUBSTANTIAL ROSTER MOVES:** On Thursday, the Quakes promoted two of their most valuable arms to High-A Great Lakes. Starting pitcher Sean Paul Linan, who leads all of Minor League Baseball in strikeouts with 50 strikeouts over just 29.2 innings will be making his first trip to High-A. Reliever Alex Makarewich, who has not allowed an earned run over his first 13 innings and has 27 strikeouts over 13 innings, will also be heading to High-A for the first time. Taking one of those respective spots on the roster will be RHP Shawndrick Oduber, who joins the team from the ACL, where he made just one appearance (two scoreless innings).

**WEEKLY AWARDS SWEEP:** The Quakes had a great home stand and the Cal League's weekly awards reflect that. Quakes' starting pitcher Sterling Patick (five perfect innings against Stockton) was named the Pitcher of the Week, while Mike Sirota (7-for-20, 2 HR, 5 RBI, 7 R, 4 BB, .458 OBP, 1.208 OPS) was named Hitter of the week.

HYUN-SEOK JANG: Right-hander Hyun-Seok Jang makes his seventh start of the year, his first against Visalia. In his last outing overall, he allowed just one hit and one walk, striking out five over 4.1 innings in a no-decision against Stockton on May 3rd. He is unscored upon over his last two starts (7.1 innings). Jang went 1-2 with an 8.14 ERA over 13 games (10 starts) and 24.1 innings pitched in the ACL last year, before finishing the year with five starts in Rancho, where he went 0-1 with a 2.19 ERA over 12 innings pitched. Jang, who signed with the Dodgers in August of 2023 out of South Korea, was regarded as the top pitching prospect coming out of Korea in 2023 and is rated by MLB Pipeline as the Dodgers' 17th best prospect.

JUNIOR SANCHEZ: 19-year-old right-hander Junior Sanchez makes his sixth appearance and third start of the year, his first against Rancho. In his last game overall, he allowed one run on four hits over five innings in a no-decision against Fresno on May 2nd. Sanchez signed with the Diamondbacks in January of 2023 out of the Dominican Republic. **BROADCAST HOME:** Catch all the 2025 action with the "Voice of the Quakes" Mike Lindskog, from the ease of your phone, smart device or computer.
