Last Night: Nuts 7, TinCaps 4. Lansing starter Reid Birlingmair allowed four hits and one run in seven innings, his team-leading fifth quality start of the year, and the Nuts scored runs in bunches early -- three in the 2nd inning and two apiece in the 3rd and 4th innings -- to top the TinCaps. Left fielder Jonny Butler reached base all four plate appearances with three walks and an RBI single.

On Deck: Following the Sunday conclusion of this series, the Lugnuts will return home to Jackson Field to wrap up the 2021 season with a six-game series against archrival West Michigan from Tuesday, September 14, through Sunday, September 19

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field TM, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

Alumni Report: 2017 Lugnuts star Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., drilled his 42nd home run of the season in the Blue Jays' 4-2 win over the Yankees last night, Toronto's eighth consecutive triumph. Vladdy Jr. ranks 2nd in the Major Leagues in batting average (.319), tied for 2nd in home runs (42), 4th in RBIs (100), 3rd in on-base percentage (.409), 3rd in slugging percentage (.607), 2nd in OPS (1.016), 1st in hits (165), 1st in total bases (314) and 1st in runs scored (107).

Number 200: Yesterday marked the Lugnuts' 200th all-time victory over the Fort Wayne Wizards/TinCaps franchise. They are the second team that the Lugnuts have won 200 games against all-time, joining the South Bend Silver Hawks/Cubs, whom the Nuts defeated for the 200th time on June 4, 2021. Next up, the West Michigan Whitecaps, whom the Lugnuts beaten 199 times and will play in a six-game series starting this coming Tuesday

Rocking Double-A: Right-hander Colin Peluse tossed six scoreless innings in his second start for the Midland RockHounds last night, continuing his impressive Double-A arrival. In two games with the RockHounds, Peluse has now totaled 11 scoreless innings, allowing five hits and no walks while striking out 12.

Winning Big: The Nuts have defeated Fort Wayne eight times in 15 meetings this year and, thanks to yesterday's seven-run output, have scored at least six runs in seven of those wins. On the other hand, the Nuts have scored at least six runs in only one of the club's seven losses to the TinCaps, compared to scoring just one run in four of those games.

Seven Strong: Last night's seven-inning stint by Reid Birlingmair marked the second time this year that a Lugnuts pitcher tossed seven innings in a game, with Birlingmair joining Jack Cushing from Game 2 of a doubleheader at Great Lakes on July 9. For Birlingmair personally, it matched a professional high first set on July 24, 2019, in a 5-1 Beloit Snappers victory over the Burlington Bees at Community Field. Current Lugnut Lester Madden, Jr., played left field and batted eighth that day for Beloit, going 1-for-4 with an RBI and a caught-stealing.

Overcoming the Whiffs: In the winning cause, the Lugnuts' offense struck out a season high 17 times last night. Austin Beck finished 0-for-5 with five strikeouts, a season high for a Nuts batter, tying the franchise single-game record (set many times before). Drew Swift, Lawrence Butler and Shane Selman fanned three times apiece.

Reid All About it: Starting pitcher Reid Birlingmair ranks third best in the High-A Central with a .233 batting average allowed. The right-hander from UIC has not missed a start all year, making his 20th start of the season tonight. He comes in with four quality starts, tying for the team lead, including one (six innings of one-hit shutout ball) at Fort Wayne.

Tough Actin' Acton: Reliever Garrett Acton had not appeared in a game since August 22 due to dental reasons, but did not miss a beat in his return to the mound against the Dragons, striking out the side in the eighth inning on Friday night and following up with the save in Game 1 on Sunday, recording the final two outs, including a game-ending K. Acton has now whiffed 27 batters (while walking just three) in 14 innings with the Lugnuts after a call-up from Low-A Stockton. In his last 34 innings, spanning two levels and beginning on June 4, Acton has allowed just 14 hits and five runs (1.32 ERA), with 55 strikeouts against only nine walks. Acton was signed as an undrafted free agent in 2020 after serving as a record-breaking closer at the University of Illinois, where he set the school record for saves

Withers vs. Cancer: Reliever Brandon Withers is working with Vs. Cancer, with an official Pledgelt.org page to raise money to battle against Pediatric Brain Cancer with every strikeout he records in September. So far: two appearances this month, 3 2/3 innings total, 6 strikeouts recorded, including four in 1 2/3 hitless innings in Game 2 on Sunday

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2003: Game 2 of the Midwest League Championship Series. The Lugnuts defeated the Snappers, 3-2, moving within one victory of the title. Right fielder J.J. Johnson left the game with an injured shoulder after running into the right-field wall making a threat-squashing catch in the seventh inning, stranding two runners aboard.

2015: It was the Lugnuts' first walk-off win all year, and it came on a Ryan McBroom sac fly in the bottom of the 9th, helping the Nuts sweep Great Lakes out of the playoffs, 5-4. The Loons had scored two runs with two outs in the top of the ninth to take the lead, only to see the Nuts rally behind back-to-back one-out doubles from Danny Jansen and Chris Carlson, followed by walks to Richard Ureña and Jason Leblebijian from Tommy Bergjans. The Nuts advanced to face West Michigan.

New Talent Infusion: The Lugnuts have five 2021 Athletics acquisitions on their roster in infielders Brett Harris (drafted in the 7th round, Gonzaga) and Drew Swift (8th round, Arizona State), outfielder Jonny Butler (14th round, North Carolina State), and pitchers Kyle Virbitsky (17th round, Penn State) and Jack Owen (undrafted free agent, Auburn).

Root, Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Miami Marlins and Oakland Athletics. Only nine of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Salt Lake, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting: Blake McFarland, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor who competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode.

Major League Lugnuts: Six former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season - pitcher Ty Tice '18 (Toronto, now with Arizona), outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher Tayler Saucedo '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher Conner Greene '15 (Baltimore), pitcher Kirby Snead '16-'17 (Toronto) and infielder Otto Lopez '19 (Toronto). Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Snead most recently debuted, appearing in relief for the Blue Jays on July 28.

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut Bo Bichette came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, Max Schuemann broke Samad Taylor's franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed: On June 20, Stevie Emanuels broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs: On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

International Appeal: Seven nations are represented on the Lugnuts' roster: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (Anthony Phillips) and Venezuela (Javier Godard).

Welcome to the Pros: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels, Jack Owen, Kyle Virbitsky and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, infielder Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg have all made their professional debut with the Lugnuts this season.

So Many Starters: The Lugnuts have used 19 different starting pitchers this season, namely Brady Basso, Osvaldo Berrios, Reid Birlingmair, Charlie Cerny, Jeff Criswell, Jack Cushing, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Jorge Juan, Rafael Kelly, Bryce Nightengale, Jack Owen, Colin Peluse, Leudeny Pineda, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka, Kyle Virbitsky and Brock Whittlesey.

Three Nuts Go to Washington: On July 30, catcher Drew Millas and pitchers Richard Guasch and Seth Shuman were traded by the Athletics to the Washington Nationals in exchange for catcher Yan Gomes and utilityman Josh Harrison.

Last Outing: Leal started Game 1 of a doubleheader on Sept. 5 at Dayton... allowed a single, an HBP and an RBI single to the first three batters, then recorded 12 outs in a row, beginning with a double play and a pick-off to end the 1st... 40 pitches, 28 strikes required for four masterful innings... Lugnuts won the game, 5-1, on their way to a doubleheader sweep.

Command Artist: Of 406 total batters faced in his Minor League career, Leal has walked just ten -- two intentionally (both on June 23, 2021, at Cedar Rapids) -- while striking out 121.

2021:

- Began the season with Stockton, tossing three scoreless innings in relief on Opening Day, May 4 at Modesto.

- First three appearances with the Ports were all in relief, totaling 7 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 12 K.
 Received first start in series opener at Visalia, May 18: 4 IP, 4 H, 3 R (2 ER), 0 BB, 4 K.

- Worked six innings apiece in final two starts with Stockton, June 1 vs. Lake Elsinore (3 H, 0 R, 1 HBP, 0 BB, 5 K) and June 8 vs. San Jose (8 H, 3 R, 2 HR, 0 BB, 3 K.

- In all, walked just 1 batter of 106 total batters faced in the High-A West, spanning 26 2/3 innings.

- Joined the Lugnuts on June 15 with relief ace Jack Weisenburger's promotion to Double-A Midland... made Lugnuts debut that same day, starting the series opener vs. Great Lakes... gave up a second-inning two-run double to Justin Yurchak but that was it: 4 1/3 IP, 7 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 5 K... removed after walking James Outman, yielding to Brady Basso with runners at 1st and 2nd and one out... Basso stranded the runners... Lugnuts went on to win, 9-7, with two runs in the bottom of the 7th. - Originally slated to start opener on June 22 at Cedar Rapids, but game was postponed due to rain... moved into piggybacking on opener Bryce Nightengale's start in Game 1 of June 23 doubleheader... held the Kernels to only one hit (Trey Cabbage double) and no walks in first four innings of relief ... in bottom of the 7th inning with the game tied 0-0, allowed a second double to Cabbage, who moved to third on a Jair Camargo flyout to right ... issued a pair of intentional walks to load the bases, then struck out Michael Helman for the second out... got in front of No. 9 batter Gabriel Maciel 1-and-2, but served up walk-off grand slam in 4-0 Lugnuts loss... struck out seven batters in 4 2/3 innings in defeat.

- Started June 29 vs. Dayton and suffered the loss: 4 2/3 IP, 9 H, 6 R, 1 BB, 6 K, allowing two home runs in Lugnuts' 10-8 series-opening defeat... gave up two-run homer to Eric Yang in the 2nd inning and two-run homer to Juan Martinez in the 3rd inning... departed with bases loaded in the 5th and watched reliever Sam Romero allow two of the inherited runners to score. - Started July 6 at Great Lakes: 5 IP, 9 H, 5 R, 0 BB, 7 K, 3 HR... allowed home runs in three straight innings, 2nd-4th, hit by Brandon Lewis, Ryan Ward and Deacon Liput... Lugnuts lost, 8-2, in eight rain-shortened innings.

- Started July 18 vs. Lake County, pitching three scoreless innings, allowing two hits, walking none and striking out four... needed only 51 pitches, 35 strikes... departed in scoreless game... Captains won, 4-2.

- Started July 25th at West Michigan, allowing one run on three hits in three innings... walked one, struck out five on 59 pitches, 38 strikes... Lugnuts were shut out, 3-0, with Adam Wolf tossing six hitless innings, 9 K's.

- Returned from a stint on the Injury List lasting August 11-26, starting August 26 against West Michigan and tossing two perfect innings, striking out three... 25 pitches, 21 strikes.

Started Game 2 of September 2's doubleheader vs. Dayton, allowing seven hits in three innings but only one run, a Victor Ruiz solo home run leading off the 2nd inning... departed with the Lugnuts leading 2-1, only to see Shohei Tomioka allow three runs in the 4th, leading to a Lugnuts 5-3 loss to the Dragons... 52 pitches, 37 strikes.

School Days: Attended MacArthur High School, where he was named 2015 Pitcher of the Year... attended Wharton County Junior College (the Pioneers; Wharton, TX) in 2016-2017... as a freshman: 71 1/3 IP, 60 K, 18 BB, 5.17 ERA... as a sophomore: 76 1/3 IP, 75 K, 5.07 ERA... as a junior, transferred to Louisian Tech and was named 2018 Second Team All-Louisiana honors and ABCA/Rawlings Second Team All-Region, leading Bulldogs in innings (87 1/3) and ranking second in Conference USA in WHIP (0.90), 14th in the nation... scheduled to be Tech's Saturday starter as a senior, but underwent foot surgery a week before the season was scheduled to start... finished as No. 2 in Division 1 among active players in lowest walks per nine innings (1.20)... posted career K/BB ratio of 135 K / 19 BB in 142 2/3 innings.

Draft Day: Taken 1154th overall in the 38th round, 2019, and signed for \$1,000... scout: Kelcey Mucker... after David was drafted by Oakland, Bulldogs head coach Lane Burroughs said, "He is the epitome of what hard work and dedication to one's craft looks like. This young man came into our program and changed his body, overcame a significant foot injury and absolutely attacked the game with a relentless work ethic. He found a way to get better every day, and is one of the best I've ever seen at commanding the baseball. He is what our program is all about. Tremendous character and makeup, great student, selfless and just a wonderful teammate. He is the ultimate competitor and undoubtedly will go down as one of the best to ever step foot on the mound for the Bulldogs.

Pro Debut 2019: Debuted in A's system on June 27 in AZL... did not walk his first batter until 10th appearance, 20 innings in... promoted to Stockton for final appearance of the year, August 31 at San Jose... base stealers went just 2-for-4 in attempts against him... left-handed batters hit 3-for-44 (.068) with 0 walks and 19 K's... right-handers batted 22-for-102 (.216) with 4 walks and 32 K.
