FRES-NOTES

VAN SICKLE EARNS WEEKLY HONOR: Fresno left-hander Bryson Van Sickle was named California League Pitcher of the Week after turning in two dominant appearances against Visalia. The 25-year-old worked 7.0 scoreless innings over the two outings, allowing just two hits while striking out 11. Van Sickle enters the Inland Empire series with a 1.83 ERA and 0.86 WHIP in six appearances since joining the Grizzlies on May 19. He has not allowed a run in 14.2 consecutive innings dating back to May 30.

FAMILIAR FACES, NEW OPPONENT: The Grizzlies and Inland Empire meet for the first time in 2026 after the Mariners shifted their California League affiliate from Modesto to Inland Empire during the offseason. While the jersey has changed, many familiar players remain from last year's Nuts club. Fresno went 8-7 at Chukchansi Park against Modesto in 2025 and posted a 14-10 combined record against Mariners-affiliated Single A team last year. Overall, the Grizzlies are 25-28 all-time against Inland Empire, including a 17-20 mark on the road and 8-8 at home. This is only the fourth year that an Inland Empire team has come to Chukchansi Park.

POWER SURGE FROM THE BOTTOM OF THE ORDER: Kyle Fossum and Luis Mendez have provided an offensive spark over the last week. Fossum is hitting .360 with three home runs and 10 RBI in seven games against Visalia this season and is coming off his second multi-homer game of the year on Saturday. Mendez, meanwhile, smashed his first homer of 2026 in the series finale at Visalia. Fossum has six homers in his last 31 games after opening the season with one through his first 16 contests, while Mendez's recent extra-base production has helped lengthen the Fresno lineup.

FAST STARTS: The Grizzlies have done much of their offensive damage early this season. Fresno has scored 104 runs in the first two innings combined, including 63 in the second inning alone, their highest-scoring frame of the season. The Grizzlies have outscored opponents 104-88 through the first two innings and have scored at least one run in either the first or second inning in 42 of their first 63 games.
